# Bellemave Twin Size Low Loft Bed with Slide Instruction Manual

Model: bed-frames

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Bellemave Twin Size Low Loft Bed with Slide. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure safe and proper operation of the product. Keep this manual for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in serious injury.

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product must be assembled by adults.
- **Two-Person Assembly Recommended:** For safety and ease of assembly, it is recommended that two adults assemble this bed.
- **Weight Capacity:** The bed has a weight capacity of 220 lbs (100 kg). Do not exceed this limit.
- **Mattress Thickness:** Use a mattress with a recommended thickness of 6-8 inches (15-20 cm).
- **Guardrails:** Ensure all guardrails are securely attached before use. Guardrails are designed to prevent falls.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the ladder for entry and exit from the bed. Ensure the ladder is stable and securely attached.
- **Slide Safety:** The slide is intended for single-person use at a time. Supervise children during slide use. Ensure the area around the slide exit is clear. The slide is removable and should be securely attached if in use.
- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and fasteners to ensure they are tight and secure. Retighten as necessary.
- **Placement:** Position the bed away from windows, cords, or other items that could pose a strangulation hazard.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts and hardware are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support immediately.

- Bed Frame Components (Headboard, Footboard, Side Rails, Support Beams)
- Bed Slats
- Ladder Components
- Slide Components
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, nuts, Allen wrench, etc.)
- Instruction Manual

*Note: A standard twin-size mattress is not included.*

## 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have two adults for assembly.

### 4.1 Preparation

- Clear a spacious area for assembly.
- Lay out all components and hardware.
- Identify each part using the provided diagrams (if applicable).
- Ensure all pre-drilled holes are clear of wood debris. If necessary, carefully scrape out any obstructions.

### 4.2 Assembly Steps

1. **Assemble the Bed Frame:** Connect the headboard, footboard, and side rails using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are snug but do not overtighten until the frame is fully assembled.
2. **Install Bed Slats:** Place the bed slats across the side rails and secure them according to the instructions. These provide mattress support.
3. **Attach Ladder:** The ladder can be attached to either side of the bed. Securely fasten the ladder to the bed frame using the designated hardware.
4. **Attach Slide:** Securely attach the slide to the bed frame. The slide is designed to be removable, allowing for flexible room arrangement. Ensure all connections are tight before use.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once the entire bed is assembled, go back and securely tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten to avoid stripping threads or damaging wood.

## 5. OPERATING AND USAGE

---

This section provides guidelines for the safe and effective use of your loft bed.

- **Bed Use:** The loft bed is designed for sleeping. Ensure the recommended mattress thickness of 6-8 inches is used to maintain proper guardrail height.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the ladder to access and exit the bed. Do not climb on other parts of the bed frame.
- **Slide Use:** The slide provides an alternative exit. Ensure the slide is securely attached before use. Only one person should use the slide at a time. Clear the landing area before sliding. The slide can be removed if not desired.
- **Under-Bed Space:** The spacious area beneath the loft bed can be utilized for storage or as a play area. Ensure any items stored or placed under the bed do not obstruct the bed's stability or pose a hazard.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your loft bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bed frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain stability and safety.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and humidity. Avoid direct sunlight exposure for prolonged periods to prevent fading or cracking.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all components are correctly assembled.
Missing parts or hardware.	Packaging error or lost during unpacking.	Carefully re-check all packaging materials. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
Difficulty inserting screws into holes.	Wood debris in pre-drilled holes.	Carefully clear any wood bits from the holes using a small tool or screwdriver.
Slide has a bump at the end.	Design of the slide's landing board.	This is part of the design. Advise users to be aware of the slight lip at the end of the slide.
