Please read this manual carefully before using your appliance and keep it for future reference. Always follow basic safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the appliance is connected to a properly grounded power outlet with the correct voltage (220 Volts). Do not use extension cords or adapters.
- **Ventilation:** Maintain adequate ventilation around the appliance to prevent overheating. Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Handling: The appliance is heavy (48 kg). Use caution and proper lifting techniques when moving it.
- Flammable Materials: Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this
 appliance.
- Children Safety: Keep children away from the appliance, especially when the door is open.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW


The Candy CHCS 514EW is a freestanding combined refrigerator, designed with the refrigerator compartment located above the freezer compartment. This configuration offers convenient access to frequently used items in the refrigerator while providing ample storage for frozen goods.

Key Components

- Refrigerator Compartment: Located at the top, featuring glass shelves and a crisper drawer for fresh produce.
- Freezer Compartment: Located at the bottom, equipped with multiple drawers for organized frozen food storage.
- Door Bins: Adjustable bins on the inside of both doors for bottles, jars, and smaller items.

Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials, including protective films and tapes.
- Inspect the appliance for any transit damage. Report any damage to your retailer immediately.

Placement

- · Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface. Adjust the leveling feet if necessary to ensure stability.
- Allow sufficient space around the appliance for proper air circulation (at least 10 cm at the back and sides, and 30 cm above).
- Avoid placing the appliance near heat sources (e.g., ovens, radiators) or in direct sunlight.

The appliance dimensions are approximately 151 cm (height) x 55 cm (width) x 58 cm (depth). Ensure your chosen location accommodates these measurements with adequate clearance.

Electrical Connection

- Plug the appliance into a dedicated 220 Volt, 50 Hz, AC power outlet.
- Ensure the power cord is not pinched or damaged.

First Use

- Clean the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth and mild detergent.
- After plugging in, allow the appliance to operate for at least 2-3 hours before loading food, to ensure it reaches the correct temperature.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Temperature Control

The refrigerator and freezer temperatures are controlled by a single thermostat. Adjust the dial inside the refrigerator compartment to set the desired cooling level. Higher numbers typically indicate colder temperatures.

- Recommended Setting: For general use, a medium setting is usually sufficient.
- Adjusting: Turn the thermostat dial clockwise for colder temperatures and counter-clockwise for warmer temperatures.

Low Frost Technology

This appliance features Low Frost technology in the freezer compartment. This system significantly reduces frost buildup by up to 20% compared to standard direct cooling freezers, minimizing the need for frequent manual defrosting and improving energy efficiency.

Food Storage Guidelines

- Refrigerator: Store fresh foods, dairy products, and beverages. Use the crisper drawer for fruits and vegetables.
- Freezer: Store pre-packaged frozen foods and items for long-term preservation. Ensure food is properly sealed to prevent freezer burn.
- Do not place hot food directly into the refrigerator or freezer. Allow it to cool down first.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Interior: Clean regularly with a solution of warm water and mild detergent. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Remove shelves and drawers for easier cleaning.
- Exterior: Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Door Seals: Clean door seals regularly to ensure a tight seal and prevent energy loss.
- Condenser Coils: Periodically clean the condenser coils at the back of the appliance (if accessible) to maintain efficiency.

 Unplug the appliance before cleaning.

Defrosting

The refrigerator compartment features an automatic defrost system. Frost that forms on the back wall will melt periodically and drain away.

For the freezer compartment, thanks to Low Frost technology, manual defrosting is required less frequently. When the frost layer reaches about 3-5 mm thickness, it is recommended to defrost manually. To do so:

- 1. Unplug the appliance.
- 2. Remove all food items and place them in a cool place.
- 3. Leave the freezer door open to allow frost to melt naturally. Place towels at the bottom to absorb water.
- 4. Once defrosted, clean and dry the interior thoroughly before plugging the appliance back in and returning food.

Power Outage

- During a power outage, keep the doors closed to maintain the internal temperature for as long as possible.
- Avoid opening the doors unnecessarily.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please check the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not operate.	No power supply.	Check if the power plug is properly inserted and the circuit breaker is not tripped.
Appliance is not cooling sufficiently.	Door not closed properly; thermostat setting too high; excessive food load; poor ventilation.	Ensure door is sealed; adjust thermostat to a colder setting; do not overload; ensure adequate space around appliance.
Excessive noise.	Appliance is not level; objects touching the back wall.	Adjust leveling feet; ensure nothing is touching the appliance.
Water on the floor.	Defrost drain blocked or drip tray overflowing.	Clear the drain hole; empty and reposition the drip tray.
