1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your AKORD K80 Commode. 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Be careful when handling heavy parts during assembly. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.
- Ensure the furniture is correctly assembled according to the provided instructions to prevent instability and potential injury.
- Do not allow children to climb on or play with the commode.

- Place the commode on a flat, stable surface.
- If wall anchoring hardware is provided, it is strongly recommended to secure the commode to a wall to prevent tipping.

5. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The AKORD K80 Commode requires assembly. Please follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly manual included in your package. Ensure you have adequate space and the necessary tools (typically a screwdriver and hammer) before starting.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Verify all parts against the parts list in the assembly manual.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Begin by assembling the main frame of the commode, connecting the side panels to the top and bottom panels using the provided hardware.
3. **Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the drawer slides to the interior side panels as indicated in the manual.
4. **Assemble Drawer:** Construct the drawer box, ensuring all connections are secure. Install the remaining drawer slides onto the drawer box.
5. **Install Shelves:** Insert the shelf supports into the pre-drilled holes and place the shelves into position.

6. **Attach Doors:** Mount the hinges to the doors and the commode frame, then attach the doors. Adjust hinges for proper alignment.
7. **Insert Drawer:** Carefully slide the assembled drawer into its designated compartment.
8. **Attach Back Panel:** Secure the back panel to the commode frame using small nails or screws.
9. **Final Checks:** Ensure all screws are tightened and the commode is stable. If wall anchoring hardware is included, install it now.

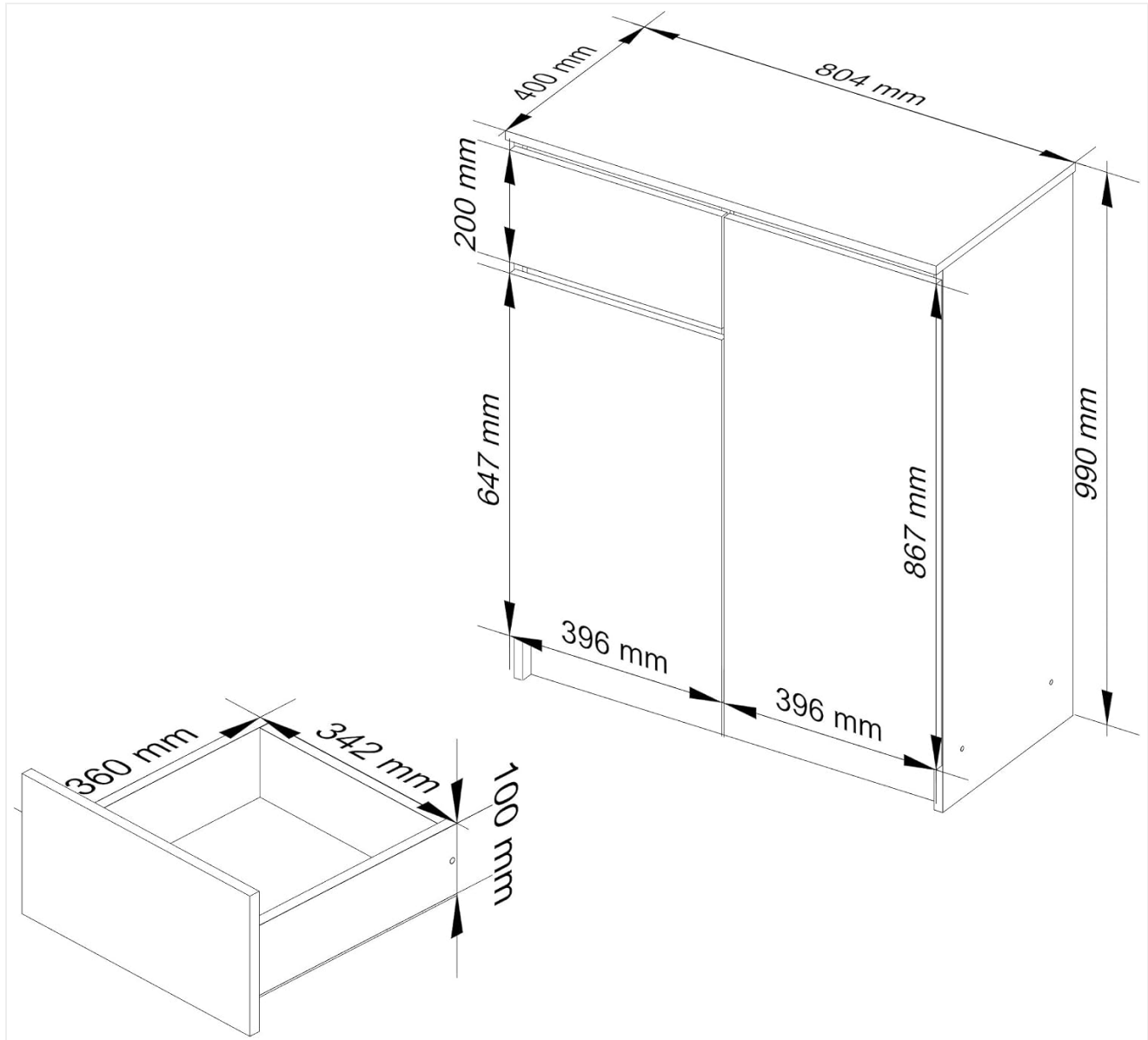


Image 5.1: Internal view of the commode, illustrating the shelf placement and drawer compartment.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The AKORD K80 Commode is designed for straightforward use.

- **Doors:** The two doors open outwards to reveal storage compartments with adjustable shelves. Gently pull the door handles to open and push to close.
- **Drawer:** The single drawer operates on smooth slides. Pull the drawer handle to open and push firmly to close. Avoid overloading the drawer to ensure smooth operation and prevent damage.
- **Storage:** Utilize the shelves and drawer for organizing clothing, linens, office supplies, or other household items. Distribute weight evenly across shelves and within the drawer.

7. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your AKORD K80 Commode.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stronger contaminants, use a mild furniture cleaning agent. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any spills to prevent staining or moisture damage to the composite wood.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fittings to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to

maintain stability.

- **Sunlight:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, which can cause fading or discoloration of the finish.

- **Doors Not Aligning:** Adjust the hinges on the doors. Most hinges allow for minor adjustments to align the doors properly. Refer to the assembly manual for specific hinge adjustment instructions.
- **Missing Parts:** If you discover missing parts during assembly, do not proceed. Contact AKORD customer support for assistance.
