Practical and robust, this handle-less chest measures 120 cm wide and 121 cm high. It is designed to be resistant to abrasion and mechanical damage. The spacious drawers facilitate easy organization of various items, helping to maintain room tidiness.

Its modern and versatile design complements various decor styles, integrating seamlessly into any room. The stable structure provides an efficient storage solution without excessive space consumption.

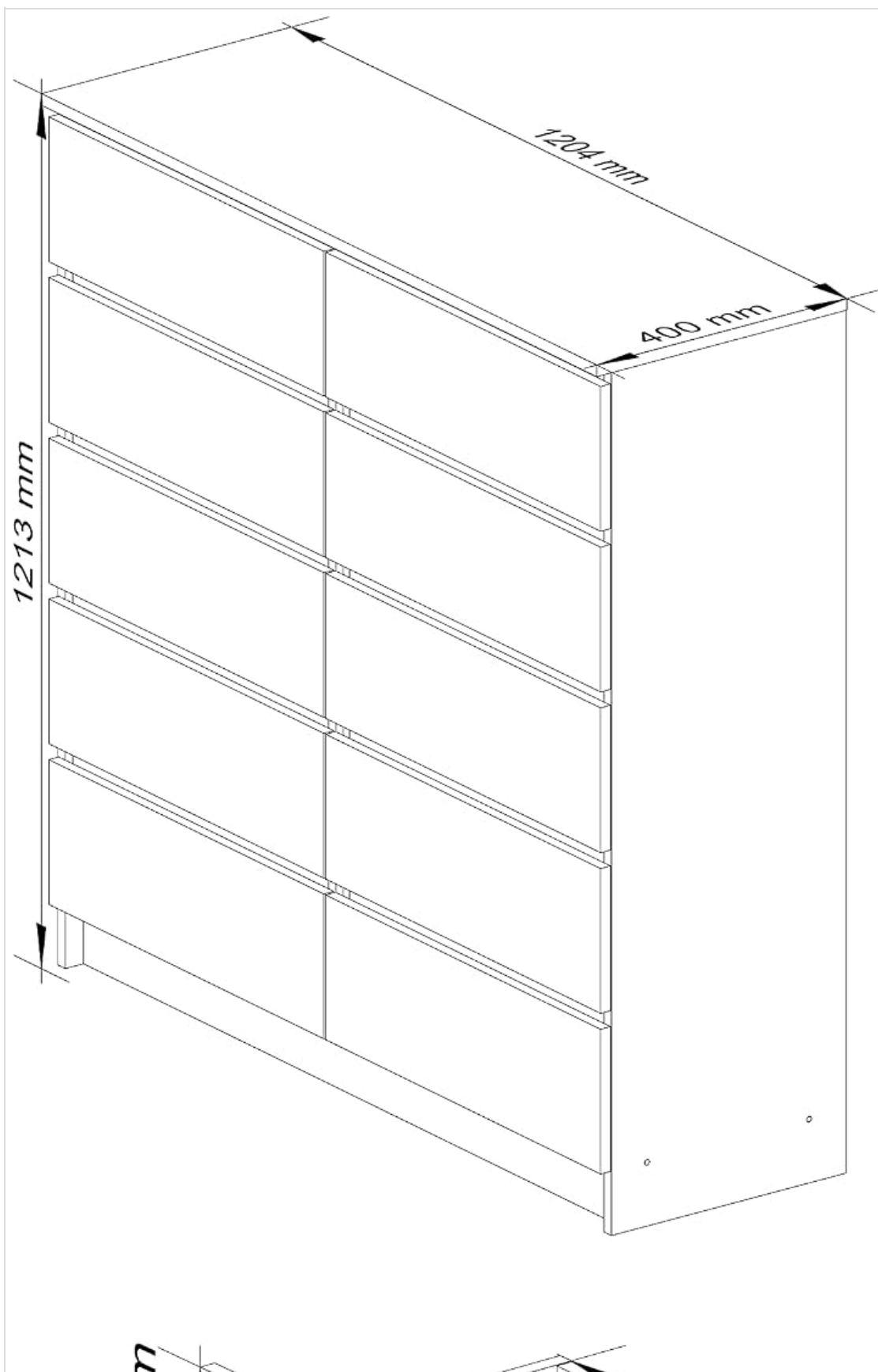
SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

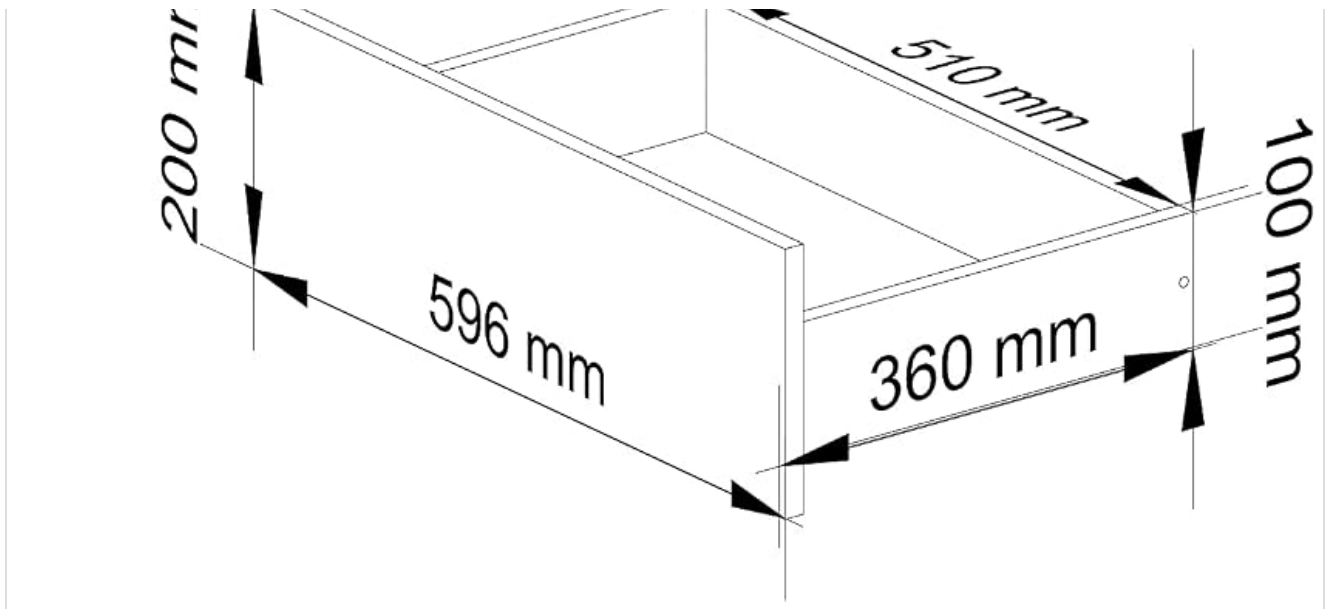
The AKORD K120 chest is delivered unassembled and includes clear instructions for straightforward assembly. Please follow these general steps for proper setup:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and hardware from the packaging. Verify that all components listed in the included parts list are present and undamaged.
2. **Identify Parts:** Refer to the assembly diagram to identify each panel, screw, and fitting. Lay them out in an organized manner to simplify the process.
3. **Assemble Frame:** Begin by assembling the main frame of the chest according to the step-by-step instructions provided. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten screws until the entire frame is stable.
4. **Install Drawer Runners:** Attach the metal drawer runners to the side panels of the chest, ensuring they are

level and correctly oriented for smooth drawer operation.

5. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct each of the ten drawers. Pay close attention to the orientation of the drawer fronts and backs. Install the corresponding drawer runners onto each assembled drawer.
6. **Insert Drawers:** Carefully slide each assembled drawer into its designated slot within the chest frame. Test each drawer for smooth movement.
7. **Secure to Wall (Optional but Recommended):** For safety and stability, especially in households with children or pets, it is highly recommended to secure the chest to a wall using the anti-tip hardware provided. Follow the specific instructions for wall mounting.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The AKORD K120 chest is designed for straightforward use. Each of the ten drawers operates independently on metal runners, ensuring smooth opening and closing.

- **Opening Drawers:** To open a drawer, gently pull the front panel outwards. The metal runners will guide the drawer smoothly.
- **Closing Drawers:** To close a drawer, push the front panel inwards until it is flush with the chest frame. Ensure no items are obstructing the drawer's path.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute items evenly within the drawers to prevent excessive strain on the runners and maintain the chest's stability. Avoid placing excessively heavy items in a single drawer.
- **Top Surface Use:** The top surface can be used to display decorative items, store frequently accessed objects, or support a television. Ensure the weight placed on the top surface does not exceed the chest's stability limits.



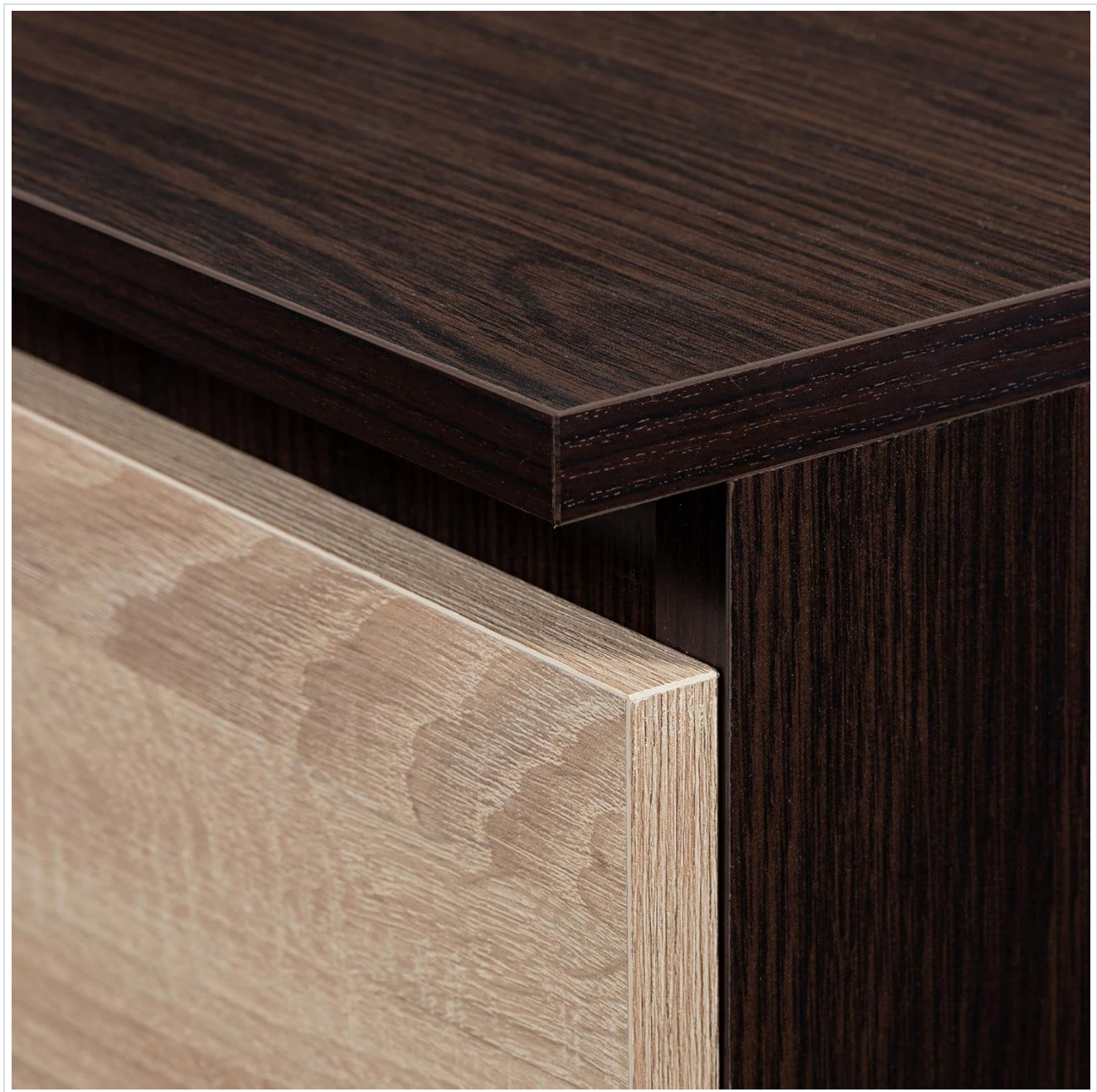

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will help preserve the appearance and functionality of your AKORD K120 chest.

- **Cleaning:** The laminated surface is resistant to water, stains, and scratches. It can be easily cleaned with a dry or damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the finish.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the surfaces with a soft, dry cloth to prevent buildup.
- **Drawer Runners:** Periodically check the metal drawer runners for any debris or dust that might impede smooth operation. If necessary, clean the runners and apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to ensure continued smooth gliding.
- **Hardware Check:** Occasionally inspect all screws and fittings to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading or discoloration of the furniture finish. Position the chest away from direct sunlight or use window coverings.

- **Humidity Control:** Maintain a stable room temperature and humidity level to prevent warping or cracking of the wood-based materials.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty during assembly	Instructions unclear, parts misidentified, or insufficient force applied.	Review the assembly manual carefully. Ensure all parts are correctly identified and oriented. If a step requires significant force, ensure it is applied correctly and gradually. Consider seeking assistance if needed.
Drawers do not slide smoothly	Drawer runners misaligned, debris in runners, or screws protruding.	Check that the drawer runners on both the drawer and the chest frame are perfectly aligned. Clean any dust or debris from the runners. Ensure all screws are fully tightened and not protruding, which could obstruct movement.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Chest feels unstable or wobbly	Loose connections or uneven floor.	Tighten all assembly screws. Ensure the chest is placed on a level surface. If the floor is uneven, use furniture pads or shims to stabilize the chest. Always use the provided anti-tip hardware to secure the chest to a wall.
Missing parts or damaged components upon arrival	Manufacturing or shipping error.	Contact AKORD customer support immediately with your purchase details and a description of the missing or damaged parts. Do not attempt to assemble with incomplete or damaged components.
