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1. INTRODUCTION

The LANDOT Hot Air Hair Blow Dryer Brush is a versatile 3-in-1 styling tool designed to dry, straighten, and volumize hair in one step. Featuring negative ionic technology and a 60mm oval barrel, it aims to reduce frizz, enhance shine, and deliver salon-quality results for various hair types. This manual provides essential information for safe and effective use of your new appliance.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions before using this appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Use with 120V outlets only. Do not use a voltage converter or adapter in countries with 220V power supply.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Keep away from children.
- Always unplug the appliance when not in use.
- Do not use near bathtubs, showers, basins, or other vessels containing water.
- Do not block the air inlets or outlet during use.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is equipped with a thermostat that will cycle OFF should the heat of the dryer exceed the optimum drying level. If the dryer stops, turn the appliance OFF and allow it to cool down. Once the appliance cools, the thermostat will automatically reset and usage may resume.

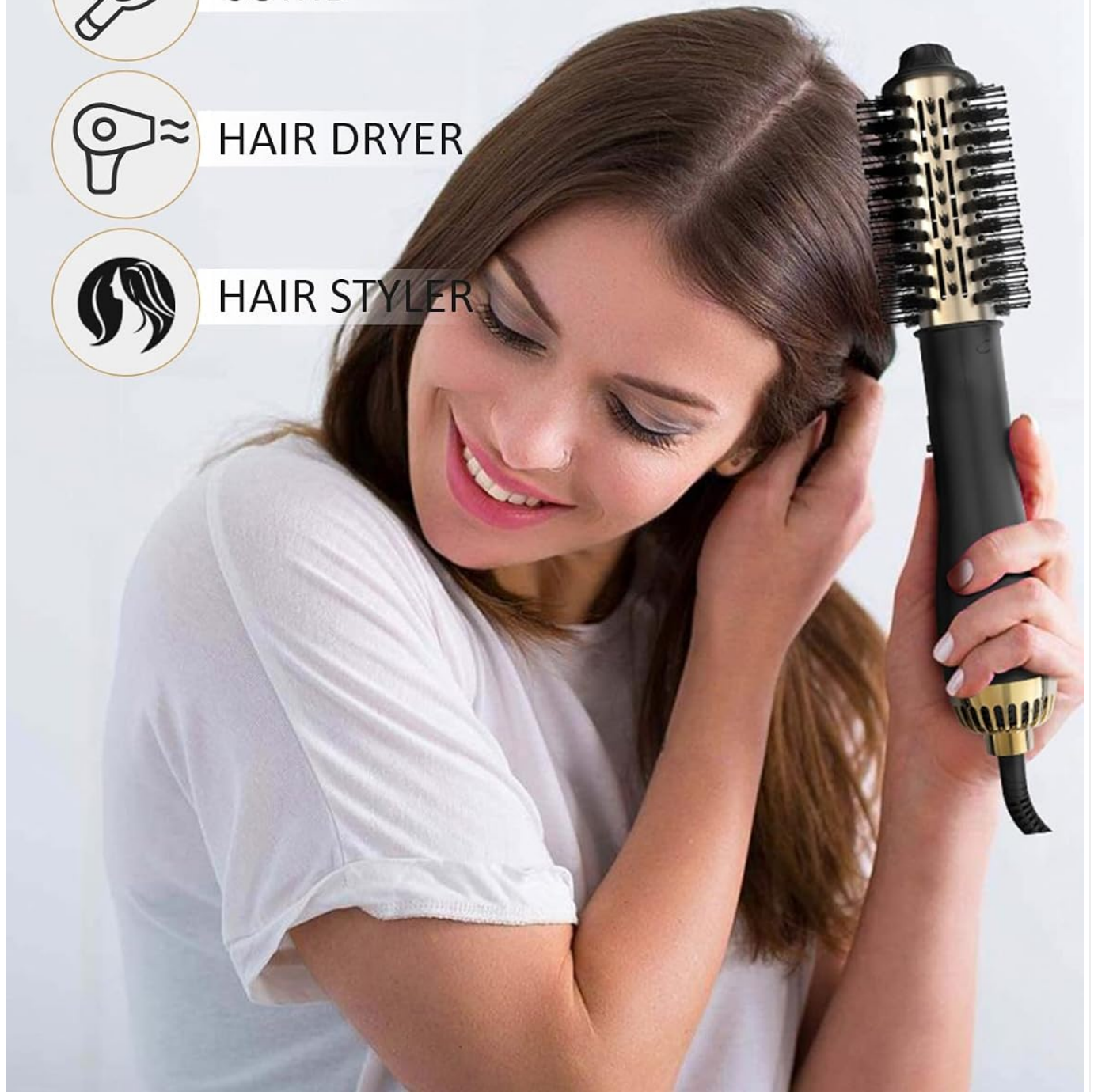

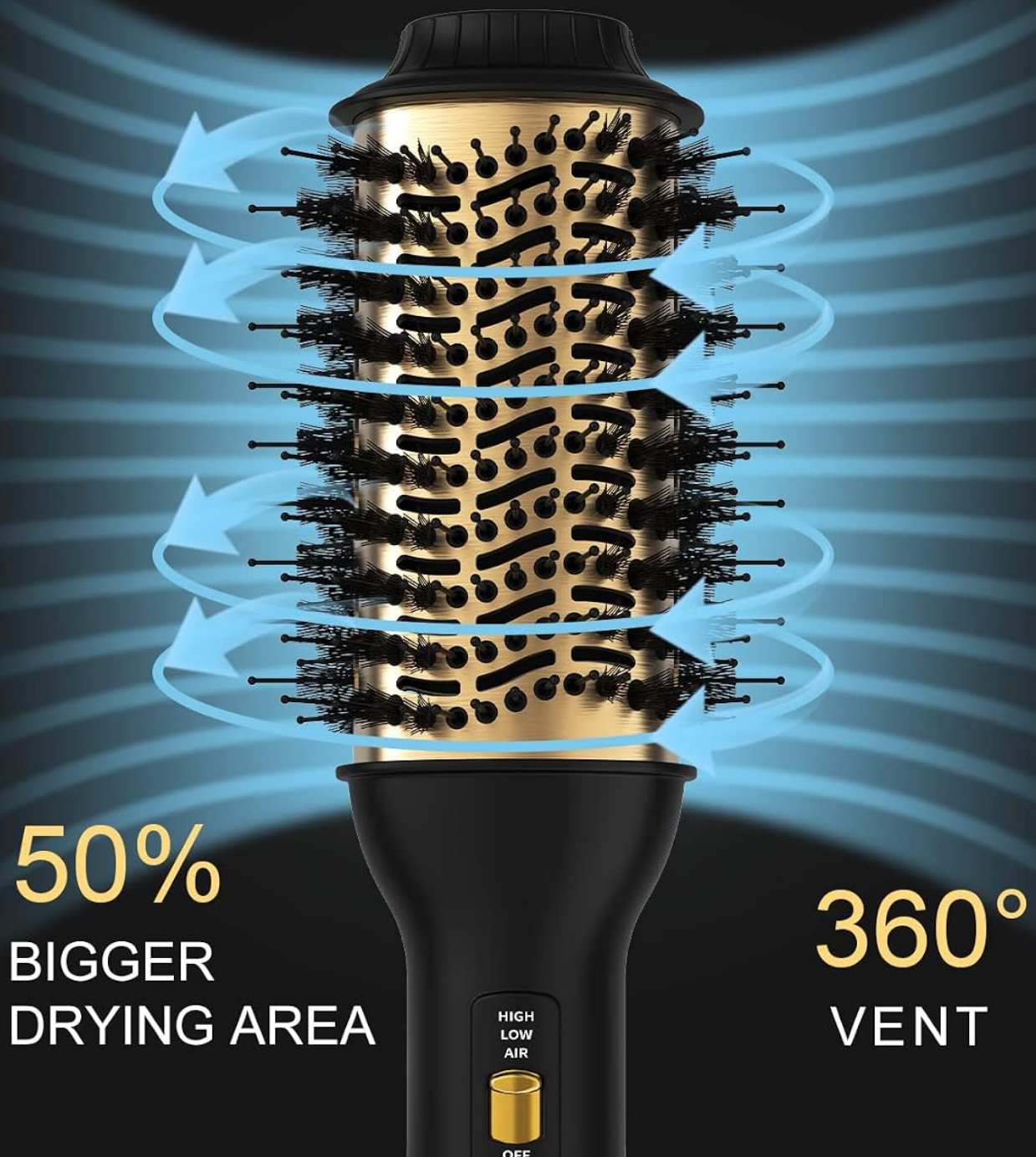


Image: An illustration of the hot air brush's oval barrel, highlighting its large drying area and 360-degree airflow vents for faster styling.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the Hot Air Hair Blow Dryer Brush from its packaging. Ensure all components are present and undamaged.
2. **Inspect:** Check the appliance for any visible damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Plug In:** Insert the power plug into a standard 120V electrical outlet. Ensure the outlet is compatible with the appliance's voltage requirements.
4. **Prepare Hair:** For best results, towel-dry your hair to remove excess water. The brush works best on damp, not soaking wet, hair.
5. **Section Hair:** Divide your hair into manageable sections using clips. This allows for more even drying and styling.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for optimal drying, straightening, and volumizing results:

1. **Turn On:** Slide the 4-position switch to your desired setting:
 - **AIR:** Natural wind with high air speed (for gentle drying or setting).
 - **LOW:** Low temperature with low air speed (for fine or damaged hair).
 - **HIGH:** High temperature with high air speed (for thick or coarse hair).
2. **Drying & Smoothing:** Place the brush near the roots of a hair section and slowly pull it downwards towards the ends. The combination bristles will gently grip hair to smooth and promote shine.
3. **For Voluminous Blow-Drys:** For extra lift at the roots, hold the hair dryer for 2-3 seconds under the roots.
4. **To Curl Ends:** To curl ends in, place the hair dryer under the ends and hold for 2-3 seconds before rotating inwards. To curl ends out, place the hair dryer over the ends and hold for 2-3 seconds before rotating outwards.
5. **Repeat:** Continue with remaining sections until desired look is achieved.
6. **Turn Off:** Turn the appliance OFF when styling is complete. Allow the unit to cool completely before storing.

6. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Always unplug the appliance from the mains after use and allow it to cool before cleaning.
- Wipe the outer surface of the appliance with a slightly moist cloth.
- Dust and lint can be removed from the air intake openings with a small brush or vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment.

Storage

- Always unplug when not in use.
- Allow the appliance to cool before storing.
- Always store in a dry location. Do not pull or twist the cord. Do not wrap the cord around the appliance as this may cause premature wear and breakage.
- Regularly check the power cord for wear and damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your LANDOT Hot Air Hair Blow Dryer Brush, refer to the table below for common

solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in correctly; Power outlet issue; Appliance damage.	Ensure plug is fully inserted; Test with another outlet; Contact customer support if still not working.
No airflow or weak airflow.	Air inlets/outlets blocked; Motor issue.	Clean air inlets/outlets from dust and lint; Contact customer support.
Hair is not drying effectively.	Hair too wet; Incorrect heat setting; Sections too large.	Towel-dry hair more thoroughly; Use HIGH heat setting for thicker hair; Work with smaller hair sections.
Hair is frizzy after styling.	Not using ionic technology effectively; Hair not fully dry.	Ensure brush is used slowly through sections; Ensure hair is completely dry.
