INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your AR Blue Clean MAXX 3000 Electric Pressure Washer. The MAXX3000-BNDLNC bundle includes the MAXX 3000 Pressure Washer and a 12-inch Quick Connect Extension Lance, designed for various exterior cleaning tasks. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the unit.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury. Pressure washers generate high-pressure water streams that can cause serious injury if not handled properly.

- Always wear appropriate eye protection (safety glasses or goggles) when operating the pressure washer.
- Do not direct the water stream at people, pets, or electrical devices.
- Ensure all connections are secure before starting the unit.
- Operate the pressure washer on a stable, level surface.
- Keep children and bystanders away from the operating area.
- Disconnect the power supply before performing any maintenance or cleaning.
- Do not operate the unit if the power cord or high-pressure hose is damaged.
- Use only manufacturer-approved accessories and replacement parts.

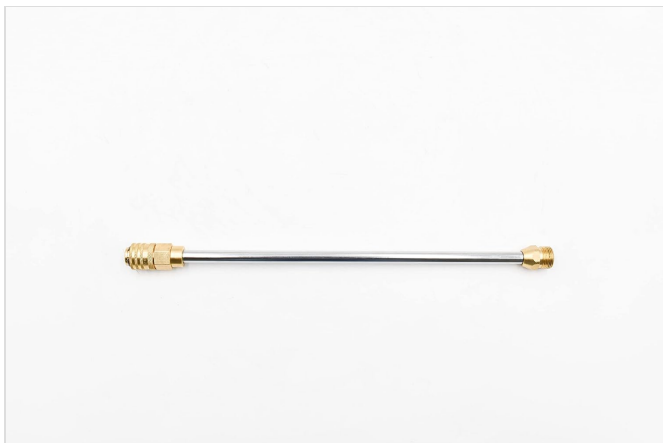


Image: The ergonomic trigger gun for controlling water flow and pressure.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack the Unit:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Assemble the Handle:** Attach the handle to the main unit if it is not pre-assembled. Ensure it clicks securely into place.
3. **Connect the High-Pressure Hose:**
 - Connect one end of the high-pressure hose to the pressure outlet on the main unit. Tighten securely by hand.
 - Connect the other end of the high-pressure hose to the inlet on the trigger gun. Tighten securely.
4. **Attach the Lance/Wand:** Insert the desired lance (standard or extension) into the quick-connect fitting on the trigger gun until it clicks into place.

5. **Connect Water Supply:**
 - Attach a garden hose (minimum 5/8 inch diameter) to the water inlet on the pressure washer. Ensure the connection is tight to prevent leaks.
 - Turn on the water supply completely.
 - Squeeze the trigger gun to purge air from the system until a steady stream of water emerges. This prevents air pockets from damaging the pump.
6. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a grounded 120V AC outlet. Ensure the outlet is protected by a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI).



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Select a Nozzle:** Choose the appropriate quick-connect nozzle for your cleaning task. Different nozzles provide different spray patterns and pressures.
 - **0° (Red):** Pin-point jet for tough spots (use with extreme caution).
 - **15° (Yellow):** Narrow fan for intense cleaning.
 - **25° (Green):** Medium fan for general cleaning.
 - **40° (White):** Wide fan for gentle cleaning.
 - **Soap (Black):** Low-pressure stream for applying detergent.
2. **Start the Pressure Washer:** Turn the power switch to the "ON" position. The motor will start when the trigger is squeezed and stop when released (Total Stop System).
3. **Begin Cleaning:** Hold the trigger gun firmly with both hands. Start spraying a few feet away from the surface and gradually move closer until the desired cleaning effect is achieved. Maintain a consistent distance for even cleaning.
4. **Applying Detergent (Optional):**
 - Fill the foam cannon with pressure washer safe detergent.
 - Attach the foam cannon to the trigger gun.
 - Ensure the black soap nozzle is installed.
 - Squeeze the trigger to apply detergent at low pressure.
 - Allow detergent to soak according to manufacturer's instructions, then rinse with a high-pressure nozzle.
5. **Shutting Down:**
 - Turn off the power switch.
 - Turn off the water supply.
 - Squeeze the trigger gun to release any remaining pressure in the system.
 - Disconnect the garden hose and high-pressure hose.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your pressure washer.

- **After Each Use:**
 - Drain all water from the pump, hoses, and accessories to prevent freezing in cold weather.
 - Clean the nozzles and clear any blockages.
 - Wipe down the unit with a damp cloth.
- **Water Inlet Filter:** Regularly inspect and clean the water inlet filter to prevent debris from entering the pump.
- **Storage:** Store the pressure washer in a dry, frost-free area. Coil the high-pressure hose and power cord neatly.

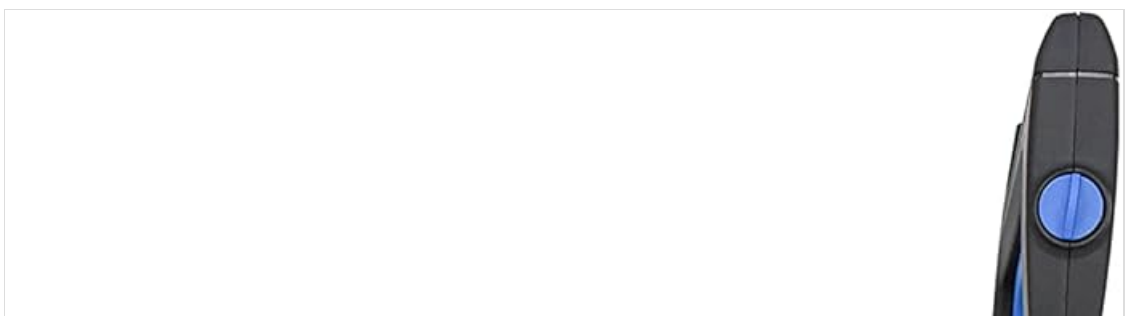




Image: Rear view of the pressure washer demonstrating integrated storage for the high-pressure hose and power cord.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motor does not start	No power supply; GFCI tripped; Power switch off.	Check power connection; Reset GFCI; Turn power switch ON.
Low pressure	Insufficient water supply; Clogged nozzle; Air in pump.	Ensure full water flow; Clean nozzle; Purge air from system.
Water leaks	Loose connections; Damaged O-rings.	Tighten all connections; Replace damaged O-rings.
Motor stops frequently	Overheating; Low voltage.	Allow unit to cool; Use a dedicated circuit.
