Canon EOS C70 Cinema Camera Instruction Manual

Model: EOS C70

1. INTRODUCTION

The Canon EOS C70 Cinema Camera combines features from the Cinema EOS series with the EOS R series, delivering exceptional image quality and professional video capabilities in a compact and mobile form factor.

This camera is suitable for documentary, newsgathering, and corporate video production.

Key features include:

- Dual SD Card Slots for multiple recording options.
- High Frame Rate recording: 4K 120p and 2K Crop 180p.
- RC-V100 Support and LANC Compatibility.
- Electronic Image Stabilization (EIS) with Coordinated Control.
- Dual Pixel CMOS Autofocus with Touch AF and Face Detection.

2. SETUP

2.1 What's in the Box

The Canon EOS C70 package typically includes the camera body only. Lenses and other accessories are sold separately.

2.2 Battery Installation

The camera uses Lithium Ion batteries. Ensure batteries are fully charged before use. Insert the battery into the designated battery compartment until it clicks securely into place.

2.3 Lens Attachment

The EOS C70 features a built-in RF-lens mount. To attach an RF lens, align the red dot on the lens with the red dot on the camera's lens mount. Rotate the lens clockwise until it locks into position. For EF or EFS lenses, an adapter is required.

2.4 Memory Card Insertion

The camera is equipped with dual SD card slots. Open the memory card compartment cover and insert compatible SD cards (V90, UHS Speed Class 3 recommended for high-bitrate recording) into the slots until they click. Close the cover securely.

3. OPERATING

3.1 Power On/Off

Locate the power switch on the camera body. Toggle it to the 'ON' position to power on the camera. To power off, toggle it back to the 'OFF' position.

3.2 Basic Controls

The EOS C70 features various buttons and dials for intuitive control:

- **Record Button:** Initiates and stops video recording.
- **ND Filter Dial:** Adjusts the built-in 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10-stop internal ND filter.
- **Assignable Buttons:** Customizable buttons for quick access to frequently used functions.
- **Joystick/Control Dial:** For menu navigation and setting adjustments.

3.3 Recording Video

The camera supports various recording formats and frame rates, including 4K 120p and 2K Crop 180p. Select your desired resolution and frame rate through the camera's menu system. Press the red record button to start and stop recording.

3.4 Autofocus System

Utilize the Dual Pixel CMOS Autofocus with Touch AF and Face Detection for precise and reliable focusing. Tap on the touchscreen to select your focus point or enable face detection for automatic tracking of subjects.

3.5 Internal ND Filters

The built-in ND filter system allows for quick adjustment of exposure in bright lighting conditions without changing aperture or shutter speed. Use the ND filter buttons to cycle through the available stops (2, 4, 6, 8, 10-stop).

3.6 Connectivity

The EOS C70 offers multiple connectivity options:

- **HDMI:** For external monitor output.
- **USB:** For data transfer and external device connection.
- **Wi-Fi:** For remote control and file transfer via a compatible app.
- **LANC:** For remote control accessories.

- **Connectivity Issues:** For Wi-Fi, ensure the camera and device are within range and correctly paired. For wired connections, check cables and ports.
