1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your BOIFUN Portable DVD Player, Model DP0168. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference. This portable DVD player features a 15.6-inch HD swivel screen, a 6-hour rechargeable battery, and supports various media formats and connectivity options.

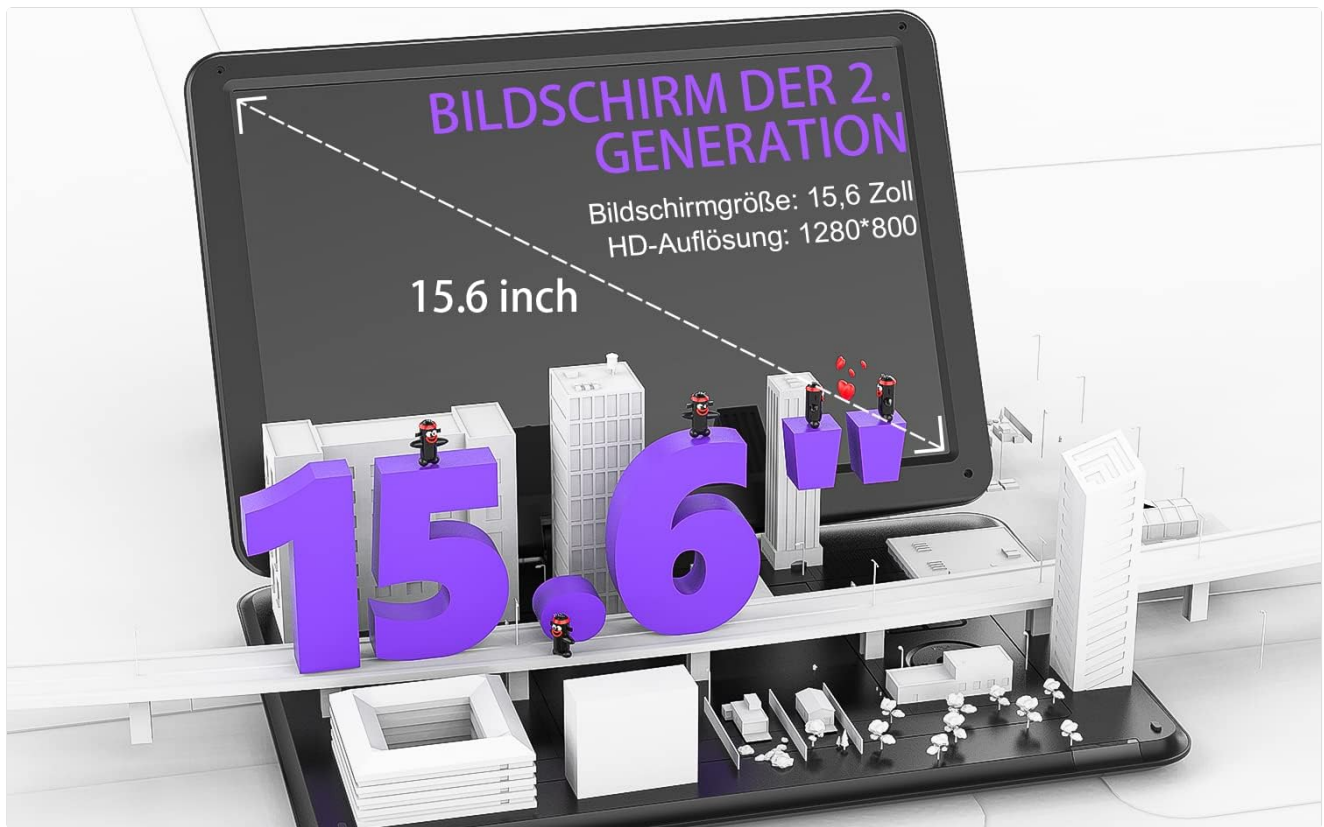

3. PRODUCT FEATURES OVERVIEW

3.1. High-Resolution Swivel Screen

The device features a 15.6-inch HD screen with a resolution of 1280x800 pixels. The screen can swivel 270 degrees and flip 180 degrees, offering versatile viewing angles.

3.2. Long-Lasting Battery

Equipped with a 5000mAh rechargeable lithium-polymer battery, providing up to 6 hours of continuous playback.

3.3. Multi-Format Support

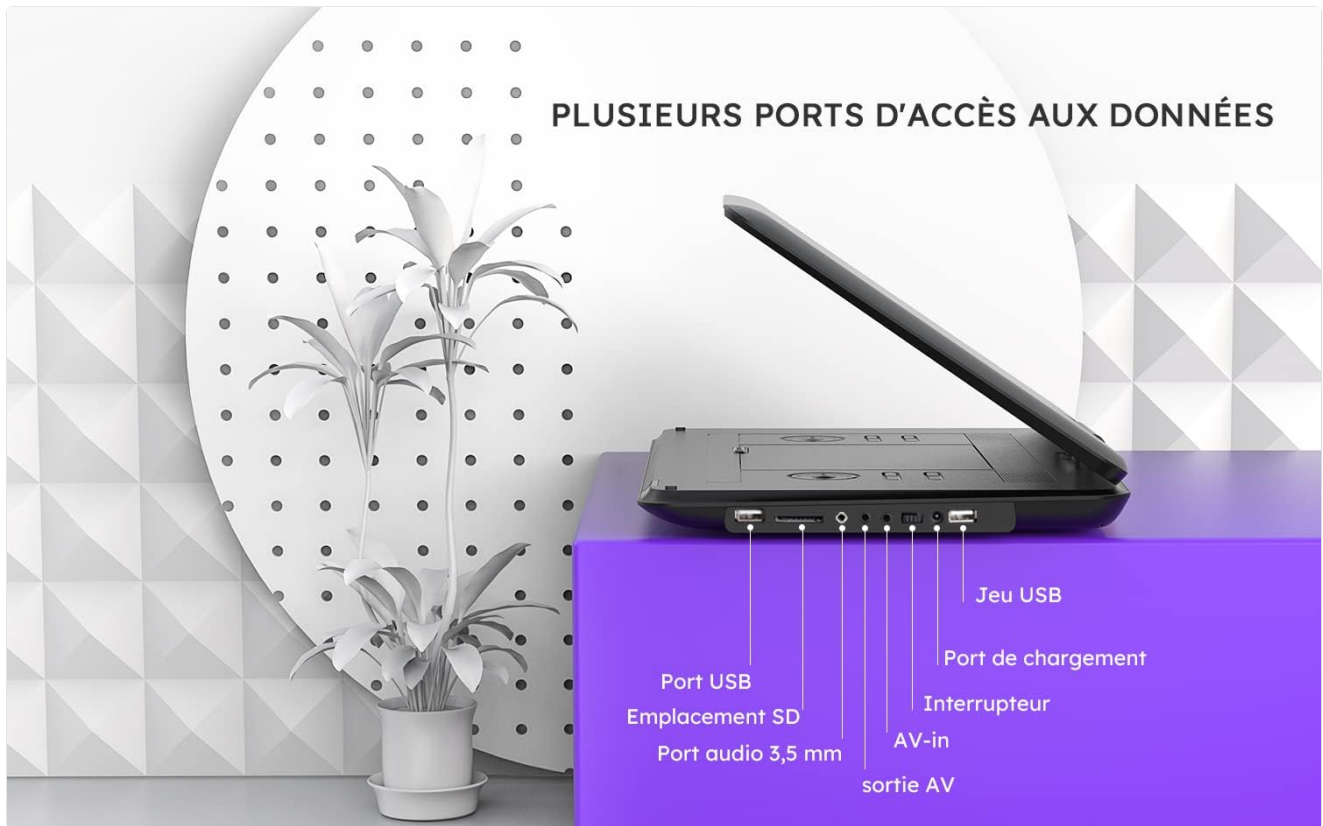
Supports direct playback of CD, DVD, DVD±R, CD-R(RW), SVCD-R(RW), DVD±RW, and VCD discs (Blu-ray discs are not supported). It also plays media files (VOB, AVI, MPEG, MP3, WMA, JPEG) from USB drives and SD cards (up to 32GB).



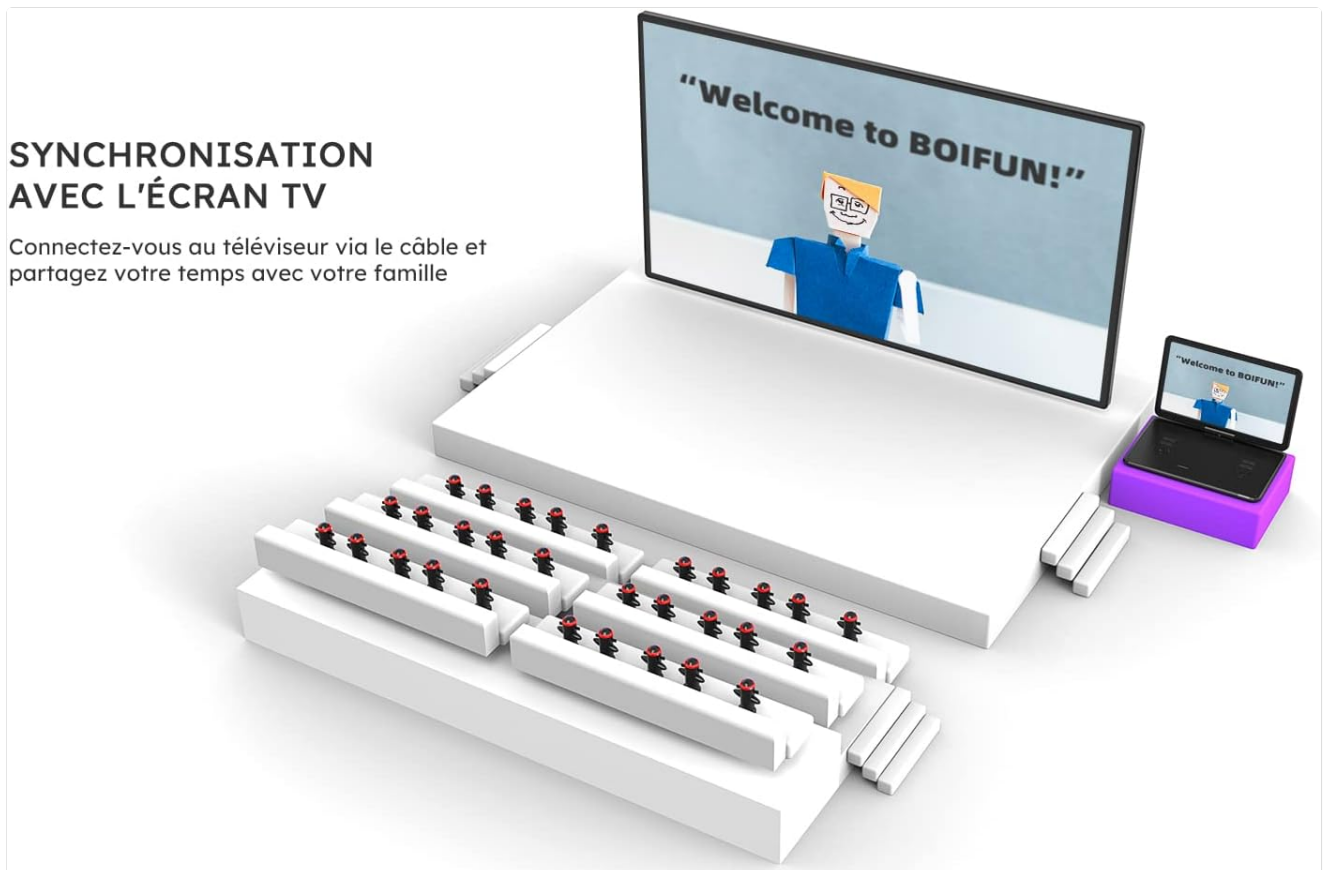
This portable DVD player supports multiple disc formats including DVD, VCD, CD, and various R/RW types, along with media files from USB and SD cards.

3.4. Connectivity and Ports

The player includes USB and SD card slots, a 3.5mm audio output, AV input, AV output, and a charging port. It supports synchronization with external TV screens.



The side of the DVD player features multiple ports for connectivity, including USB, SD card slot, 3.5mm audio jack, AV input/output, charging port, and the power switch.



The portable DVD player can be connected to a television, allowing content to be displayed on a larger screen for shared viewing experiences.

3.5. Anti-Shock Function

The Anti-Shock feature protects the disc playback process, reducing video interruption caused by movement or vibrations.

3.6. Resume Playback

The memory function allows the player to resume playback from the last watched point.



The resume playback function allows users to continue watching from where they left off, as depicted by the 'on' and 'off' states of the device.

4. SETUP

4.1. Charging the Device

1. Connect the provided AC power adapter to the DC IN port on the side of the DVD player.
2. Plug the adapter into a standard wall outlet.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate. A full charge typically takes approximately 4-5 hours.
4. For car use, connect the car charger to the DC IN port and your vehicle's cigarette lighter socket.

4.2. Inserting a Disc

1. Gently open the disc cover.
2. Place the disc onto the spindle with the label side facing up.
3. Press the center of the disc until it clicks into place.
4. Close the disc cover securely.

4.3. Using USB/SD Card

1. Insert a USB drive into the USB port or an SD card into the SD card slot.
2. The player will automatically detect the media or you may need to select the input source using the 'Source' or 'Mode' button.
3. Navigate through your files using the control buttons.

4.4. Connecting to a TV

1. Ensure both the DVD player and the TV are powered off.
2. Connect one end of the provided AV cable to the AV OUT port on the DVD player.
3. Connect the other end of the AV cable to the corresponding AV IN ports on your television (Yellow for Video, Red for Right Audio, White for Left Audio).
4. Power on both devices and select the correct AV input source on your TV.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Power On/Off

Slide the power switch located on the side of the player to the 'ON' position to power on. Slide to 'OFF' to power off.

5.2. Basic Playback Controls

- **Play/Pause:** Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to start or pause playback.
- **Stop:** Press the **STOP** button to stop playback.
- **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Press **FWD** or **REV** buttons to fast forward or rewind.
- **Next/Previous:** Press the **NEXT** or **PREV** buttons to skip tracks or chapters.

5.3. Volume Control

Use the **VOL+** and **VOL-** buttons on the player or remote control to adjust the volume. The player features dual speakers for enhanced audio.

5.4. Menu Navigation

Use the arrow buttons and the **OK** button on the player or remote to navigate through disc menus or file lists.

5.5. Screen Rotation

The screen can be rotated up to 270 degrees and flipped 180 degrees for optimal viewing in various positions.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Cleaning the Device

- Wipe the screen and exterior surfaces with a soft, dry cloth.
- For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the finish.

6.2. Disc Care

- Handle discs by their edges to avoid fingerprints.
- Store discs in their cases when not in use to prevent scratches.
- Clean dirty discs with a soft, lint-free cloth, wiping from the center outwards.

6.3. Battery Care

- Charge the battery fully before first use.
- Avoid completely draining the battery frequently to prolong its lifespan.
- If storing the device for an extended period, charge it to about 50% every few months.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Battery drained; Power adapter not connected; Power switch off	Charge the battery; Connect power adapter; Turn power switch to ON
No disc playback	Disc inserted incorrectly; Disc dirty/scratched; Unsupported disc format	Reinsert disc correctly; Clean or replace disc; Check disc format compatibility
No video from USB/SD	Unsupported file format; USB/SD card not inserted correctly; Corrupt files	Check file format compatibility; Reinsert USB/SD card; Try different files/card
No sound	Volume too low; Mute activated; External speakers not connected	Increase volume; Deactivate mute; Connect external speakers if desired
Image distorted/No image on TV	AV cable loose/incorrectly connected; Incorrect TV input selected	Check AV cable connections; Select correct AV input on TV

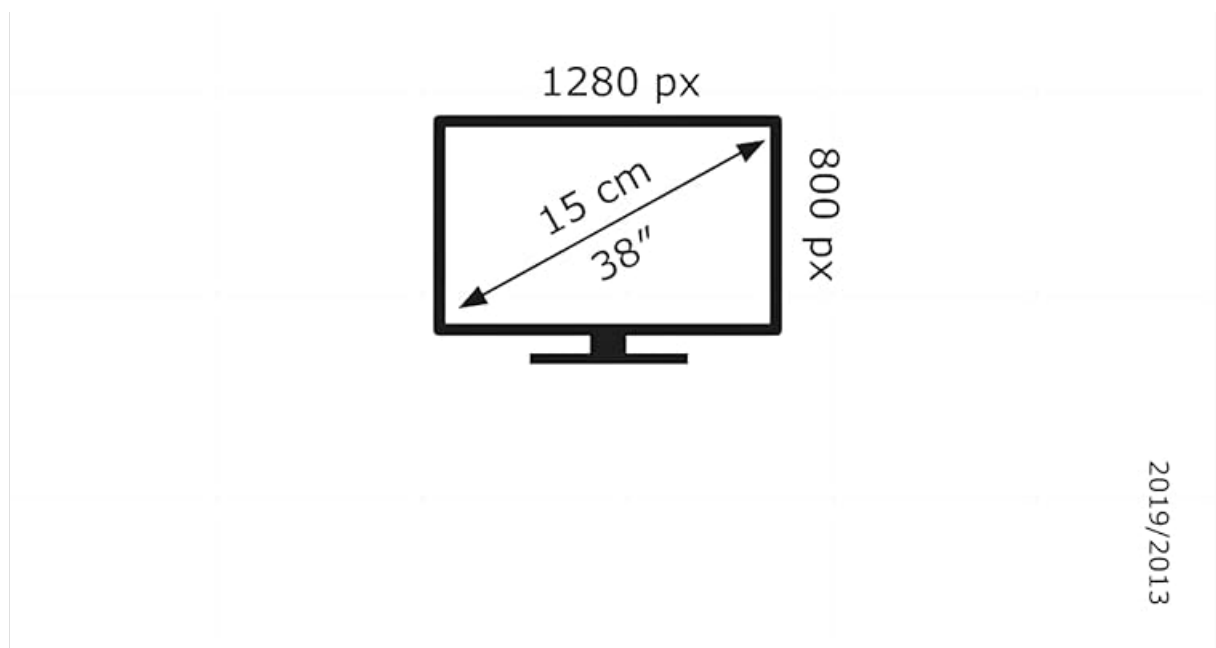
