1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your SOUNDKITS Double Din Car Stereo. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and safety. This multimedia receiver offers a 7-inch HD capacitive touchscreen, Bluetooth connectivity, phone mirroring, AM/FM radio, and support for various media inputs.



2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all items listed below are included in your package:

- 7 inch Double Din Car Stereo Bluetooth Unit
- Rearview Camera & Backup Camera Cable
- IR Remote & Steering Wheel Control Remote
- Harness & Mounting Kits

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Seamless Bluetooth Connectivity:** Automatic streaming and hands-free calling with a built-in microphone.
- **Phone Mirroring Option:** Cast your Android (version 11 or below) or iOS (iPhone XR, 8 Plus or below) smartphone screen via USB for navigation, messages, video, and music.
- **High Resolution LCD Display:** 1024*600 HD capacitive touchscreen with brightness adjustment,

supporting 1920 x 1080P video playback.

- **HD Rearview Camera Input:** Includes a backup camera with 19.6ft wire for safe reversing.
- **Multiple Audio Inputs:** USB, SD card, and AUX-in for lossless music playback. Supports MP3 and WMA file formats.
- **AM/FM Radio:** Access 30 preset stations for news, music, and sports.
- **Customizable EQ:** Adjust bass and treble for optimal sound quality.
- **Steering Wheel Control (SWC):** Compatible with existing steering wheel controls for convenient operation.
- **7-Color Backlight:** Customizable bezel color to match your car's interior.
- **Universal Double Din Size:** Compatible with most cars (verify dashboard size before ordering).

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

4.1 Physical Dimensions

The stereo unit has universal dimensions of 7" (L) x 3.89" (D) x 2.36" (H). Ensure your dashboard opening is compatible. Aftermarket accessories (dash kit) may be required for a proper fit in some vehicles.

4.2 Wiring Diagram

Refer to the wiring diagram for correct connections. Incorrect wiring can damage the unit or your vehicle's electrical system. The system operates on 12V DC. If your vehicle uses a different voltage, a step-down converter is necessary.

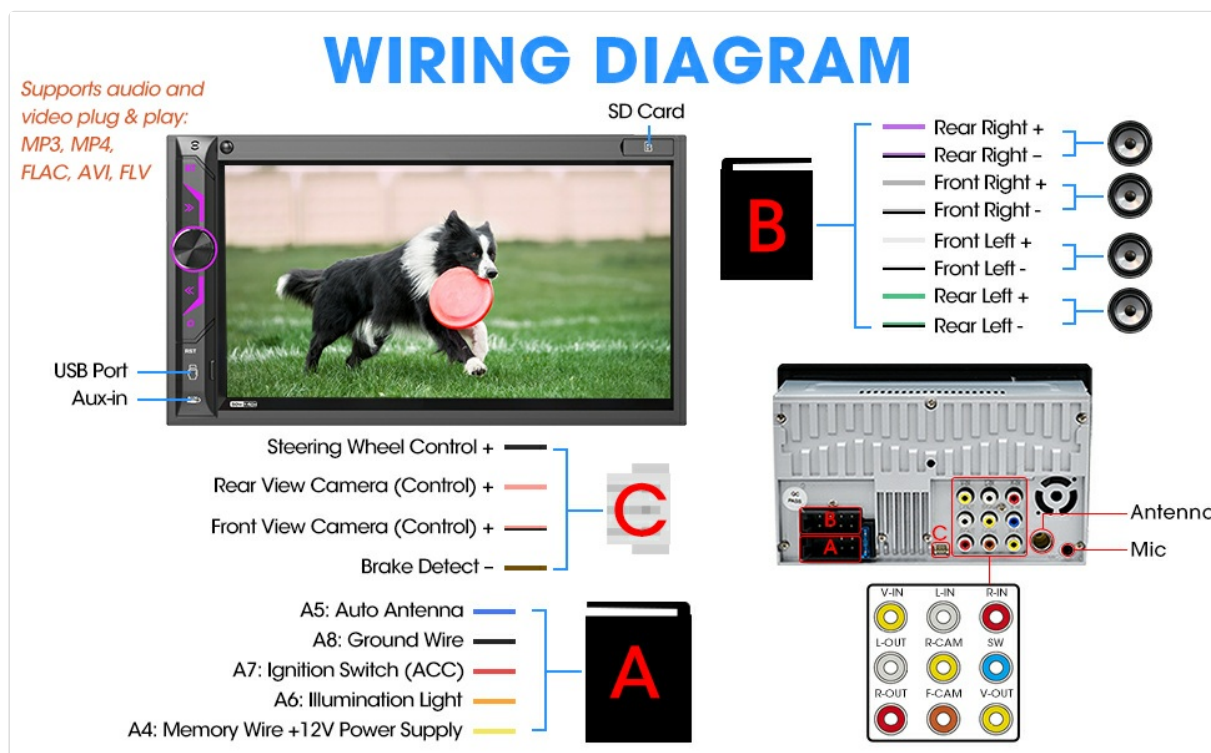


Image 4.1: Detailed wiring diagram showing connections for power, speakers, USB, AUX-in, steering wheel control, and camera inputs.

4.3 Backup Camera Installation

Connect the included rearview camera to the R-CAM port on the stereo. The camera's power wire (red) should connect to the reversing light's positive pole (+12VDC), and the black wire to the negative pole. This ensures the camera activates automatically when the vehicle shifts into reverse.

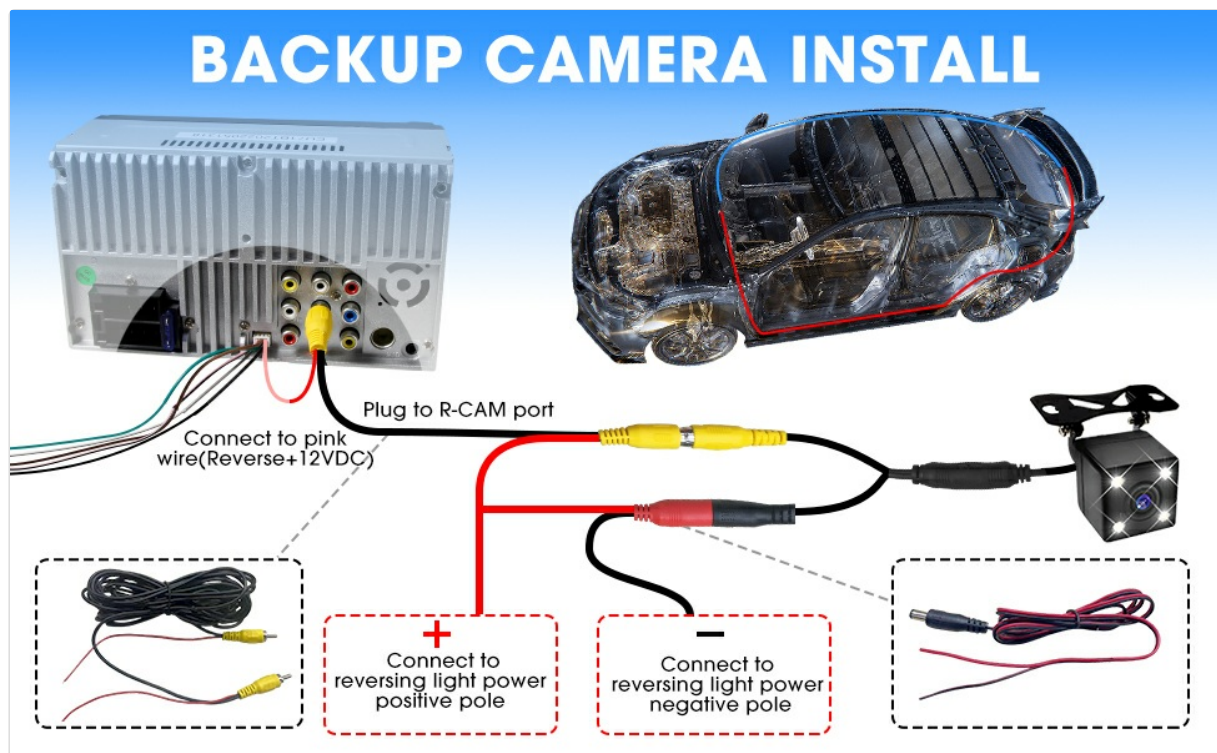


Image 4.2: Visual guide for connecting the backup camera to the car stereo and vehicle's reversing light system.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Bluetooth Connectivity

To pair your device, navigate to the Bluetooth menu on the stereo. Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone and select the stereo from the list of available devices. Once paired, the stereo will automatically connect to your phone upon startup for hands-free calls and audio streaming.

5.2 Phone Mirroring

Connect your smartphone to the stereo via a USB cable. Access the 'Phonelink' or 'Mirrorlink' function on the

stereo. Your phone's screen will be mirrored, allowing access to navigation, videos, and other applications directly on the stereo display. This feature supports iPhone XR, iPhone 8 Plus or below, and Android 11 or below.

5.3 Radio (AM/FM)

Select the 'Radio' icon from the main menu. Use the touchscreen to scan for stations or manually tune to a frequency. You can save up to 30 favorite stations for quick access.

5.4 Media Playback (USB/SD/AUX)

Insert a USB drive or SD card into the designated port, or connect an external audio device via the AUX-in jack. The stereo will automatically detect the media and allow you to browse and play audio/video files.

5.5 Steering Wheel Control (SWC)

If your vehicle supports steering wheel controls, you can configure them through the stereo's settings menu. This allows you to control volume, track changes, and other functions without taking your hands off the wheel.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the touchscreen. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check the manufacturer's website for any available software updates to ensure optimal performance and compatibility.
- **General Care:** Avoid exposing the unit to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, or excessive moisture.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Check all power connections, including the main power harness and ignition wire. Ensure the vehicle's fuse for the stereo is intact.
- **No Sound:** Verify speaker connections are secure. Check the volume level and mute settings. Ensure the correct audio source is selected.
- **Bluetooth Pairing Issues:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both the stereo and your phone. Delete previous pairings and try again. Ensure your phone's OS version is supported.
- **Phone Mirroring Not Working:** Confirm your phone's operating system version is compatible (Android 11 or below, iPhone XR/8 Plus or below). Use the original USB cable. Ensure the 'Phonelink' or 'Mirrorlink' app is selected on the stereo.
- **Backup Camera Not Displaying:** Check the camera's power connection to the reverse light and the RCA video cable connection to the stereo. Ensure the pink reverse trigger wire is correctly connected to the vehicle's reverse light signal.
- **Poor Radio Reception:** Check the antenna connection. Ensure the antenna is properly installed and not obstructed.





