## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the IDMarket 350L Metal Garden Storage Chest. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new storage chest. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

This anthracite grey metal chest is designed to protect your outdoor accessories from rain and keep them dry. Its robust construction and lockable design offer secure storage for garden cushions, lounge chair mattresses, or children's outdoor toys.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

- **Read all instructions:** Before assembly and use, carefully read and understand all instructions provided in this manual.
- **Adult assembly required:** Assembly should be performed by at least two adults. Small parts may pose a choking hazard to children.
- **Wear protective gear:** During assembly, wear appropriate protective gear such as gloves to prevent cuts from metal edges.
- **Secure placement:** Place the storage chest on a flat, stable, and level surface to prevent tipping.
- **Avoid overloading:** Do not exceed the maximum recommended weight capacity of 100 kg.
- **Children and pets:** Keep children and pets away from the chest during assembly. Do not allow children to play inside the chest to avoid entrapment.
- **Lid operation:** The lid is equipped with gas struts for smooth opening and closing. Exercise caution when opening and closing to avoid pinching fingers.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation if storing items that may be affected by moisture.

- **Lock usage:** Always lock the chest when not in use to secure contents. Keep keys in a safe place.

### 3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Assembly of this storage chest requires careful attention to detail and may involve numerous screws. It is recommended to have at least two people for assembly.

#### 3.1. Package Contents

Before starting, verify that all components are present. Refer to the included assembly guide for a detailed list of parts and hardware.

- Metal panels (sides, front, back, bottom, lid)
- Gas struts (2 units)
- Lock mechanism and keys (2 units)
- Fasteners (screws, nuts, washers)
- Assembly guide

#### 3.2. Step-by-Step Assembly

1. **Prepare the area:** Choose a clean, flat, and spacious area for assembly. Lay out all components and hardware.
2. **Remove protective film:** Carefully remove the protective plastic film from all metal panels. This process can be time-consuming.
3. **Assemble the base:** Connect the bottom panel to the side and front/back panels using the provided screws. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten initially.
4. **Attach the side panels:** Securely fasten the remaining side panels to form the main body of the chest.
5. **Install the lid hinges:** Attach the lid hinges to the back panel of the chest.
6. **Mount the lid:** Carefully place the lid onto the hinges and secure it.
7. **Install gas struts:** Attach the gas struts to the designated points on the lid and the chest body. Ensure they are correctly oriented for smooth operation.

8. **Install the lock mechanism:** Attach the lock mechanism to the front panel of the chest, ensuring it aligns with the lid's locking point. Test the lock with the provided keys.

9. **Final tightening:** Once all components are in place, go back and securely tighten all screws. Do not overtighten to avoid damaging the metal.
10. **Positioning:** Place the assembled chest in its desired location. The roof dimensions are slightly larger than the container to prevent rain penetration.

## 4. OPERATION

---

### 4.1. Opening the Lid

To open the lid, unlock the chest using one of the provided keys. Gently lift the lid; the gas struts will assist in raising it smoothly and holding it open.

#### **4.2. Closing the Lid**

To close the lid, gently pull it down. The gas struts will control the descent, preventing it from slamming shut. Ensure no objects or body parts are in the path of the closing lid. Once closed, turn the key to lock the chest.

### **4.3. Storage Capacity**

The chest offers a generous 350-liter storage capacity, suitable for various outdoor items.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** Clean the exterior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild soap solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.
- **Rust prevention:** The chest is made of galvanized steel, which is rust-resistant. However, to maintain its condition, avoid prolonged exposure to standing water. If scratches occur, touch up with rust-inhibiting paint.
- **Hinge and strut inspection:** Periodically check the hinges and gas struts for any signs of wear or damage. Lubricate moving parts if necessary.
- **Lock care:** Keep the lock mechanism clean and lubricated with a graphite-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.
- **Winter storage:** While designed for outdoor use, consider storing the chest in a sheltered area during harsh winter conditions to prolong its lifespan.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

**Problem:** Lid does not open or close smoothly.

**Solution:** Check the gas struts for proper installation and any signs of damage. Ensure hinges are not bent or obstructed. Lubricate moving parts if stiff.

**Problem: Lock is stiff or difficult to operate.**

**Solution:** Apply a small amount of graphite lubricant into the keyhole and work the key several times. Ensure the lid is fully closed and aligned when attempting to lock.

**Problem: Water accumulation inside the chest.**

**Solution:** Verify that the chest is placed on a level surface. Check for any gaps or damage to the seals around the lid. Ensure the lid is fully closed. The roof is designed to overlap the container to prevent rain entry.

**Problem: Chest appears unstable or wobbly.**

**Solution:** Ensure the chest is placed on a firm, level surface. Re-check all assembly screws and tighten them if loose. Do not overtighten.
