Always wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, eye protection, and protective clothing, when operating the mini bike. Ensure all riders meet the manufacturer's recommended age of 16 months and up, and adhere to the maximum weight capacity of 150 lbs. This unit is not for sale in California due to EPA regulations.

SETUP AND INITIAL CHECKS

The Massimo MB100 Mini Bike arrives largely pre-assembled. Before first use, perform the following checks:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the mini bike from its packaging. Inspect for any visible damage from shipping.
2. **Handlebar Installation:** Attach the handlebars securely according to the included quick start guide.
3. **Fluid Levels:** Check engine oil and fuel levels. Fill with appropriate gasoline as specified in the engine manual.
4. **Tire Pressure:** Verify tire pressure is within the recommended range.
5. **Brake Functionality:** Test both front and rear brakes to ensure they engage properly.
6. **Chain Guard:** Ensure the chain guard is intact and securely fastened to prevent clothing from getting caught in the chain.
7. **Wiring:** Confirm all visible wiring connections are secure and undamaged.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Starting the Engine

1. Ensure the fuel valve is open.
2. Set the choke lever to the "ON" or "START" position (if the engine is cold).
3. Turn the engine switch to the "ON" position.
4. Pull the recoil starter handle firmly until the engine starts.
5. Once the engine is running, gradually move the choke lever to the "OFF" or "RUN" position.

Riding the Mini Bike

The MB100 features an automatic chain drive, meaning there are no gears to shift. Simply apply throttle to accelerate.

- Sit comfortably on the seat with both feet on the foot pegs.
- Gently twist the throttle to begin moving. Increase throttle for more speed.
- Maintain a safe speed, especially on uneven terrain.
- Use the handlebars to steer.

Stopping the Engine

- To slow down, release the throttle and apply the brakes smoothly.
- To stop the engine, press the easy access kill switch located on the handlebar.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your MB100 Mini Bike. Refer to the engine manufacturer's manual for detailed service schedules.

- **Engine Oil:** Check oil level before each ride and change as recommended.
- **Air Filter:** Clean or replace the air filter regularly, especially when riding in dusty conditions.
- **Spark Plug:** Inspect and clean the spark plug periodically. Replace if worn.
- **Chain:** Keep the drive chain clean, lubricated, and properly tensioned. Inspect for wear or damage.
- **Brakes:** Check brake pads for wear and ensure brake levers operate smoothly. Adjust as needed.
- **Tires:** Monitor tire pressure and inspect for cuts or punctures.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and fasteners for tightness.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine does not start	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No fuel or stale fuel• Choke not set correctly• Engine switch off• Faulty spark plug• Carburetor issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fill with fresh gasoline• Adjust choke lever• Turn engine switch to ON• Inspect/replace spark plug• Consult a qualified mechanic for carburetor inspection
Loss of power during operation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Low fuel level• Clogged air filter• Spark plug issues• Engine overheating	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Refuel• Clean or replace air filter• Inspect/replace spark plug• Allow engine to cool; check oil level
Chain falls off or is loose	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Improper chain tension• Worn chain or sprockets	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjust chain tension according to manual• Inspect and replace worn components
