IRONCK 6-Tier Floor Standing Bookshelf (Model 1035020) Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the IRONCK 6-Tier Floor Standing Bookshelf. This manual provides detailed instructions for assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure safe and proper use of your new furniture. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- This product includes safety features such as strengthen screws and a tipover resistance device.
- Always use the included tipover resistance device to secure the bookshelf to a wall. This prevents accidental tipping, especially in households with children or pets.
- Do not exceed the weight limit of 22 pounds (10 kg) per shelf. The maximum total weight capacity for the entire unit is 132 pounds (60 kg).
- Distribute weight evenly across shelves. Place heavier items on lower shelves.
- Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as necessary.
- Do not climb on or allow children to play on the bookshelf.
- Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children.
- Assemble the unit on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.

SETUP: ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the IRONCK 6-Tier Bookshelf is designed to be straightforward with clear instructions and labeled parts. We recommend assembling with a partner for easier handling of larger components.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Clear a spacious, clean, and soft area for assembly to prevent damage to the furniture and your floor.

2. **Identify Parts:** Unpack all components and identify them using the provided parts list and diagrams. Each part is typically labeled with a sticker.
3. **Attach Cam Locks and Dowels:** Insert cam locks and wooden dowels into the designated holes on the side panels and shelves as per the instruction diagram. Ensure they are fully seated.
4. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the side panels to the top and bottom panels using the cam locks and screws. Tighten securely.
5. **Insert Shelves:** Slide the fixed shelves into the grooves or attach them to the pre-drilled holes on the side panels. Secure with screws or cam locks as indicated.
6. **Install Back Panels:** Attach the back panels to the rear of the bookshelf. Ensure they are aligned and secured with the provided small nails or screws. The back panels are designed to slot in for added stability.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once the main structure is complete, re-check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are fully tightened. Do not overtighten.
8. **Attach Anti-Tip Device:** Secure the bookshelf to a wall using the included tipover resistance device. This is a critical safety step. Mark the desired location on the wall, drill pilot holes if necessary, and attach the bracket to both the bookshelf and the wall stud.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The IRONCK 6-Tier Bookshelf is designed for organizing and displaying books, decorative items, and other household goods. Follow these guidelines for optimal use:

- **Weight Distribution:** Place heavier items on the lower shelves to maintain stability. Distribute items evenly across each shelf.
- **Load Capacity:** Each shelf can support up to 22 pounds (10 kg). The total maximum weight capacity for the entire unit is 132 pounds (60 kg). Do not exceed these limits.
- **Placement:** Position the bookshelf on a flat, level surface. Avoid placing it in areas with high humidity or direct sunlight, which can affect the material over time.
- **Cleaning:** Refer to the Maintenance section for proper cleaning procedures.



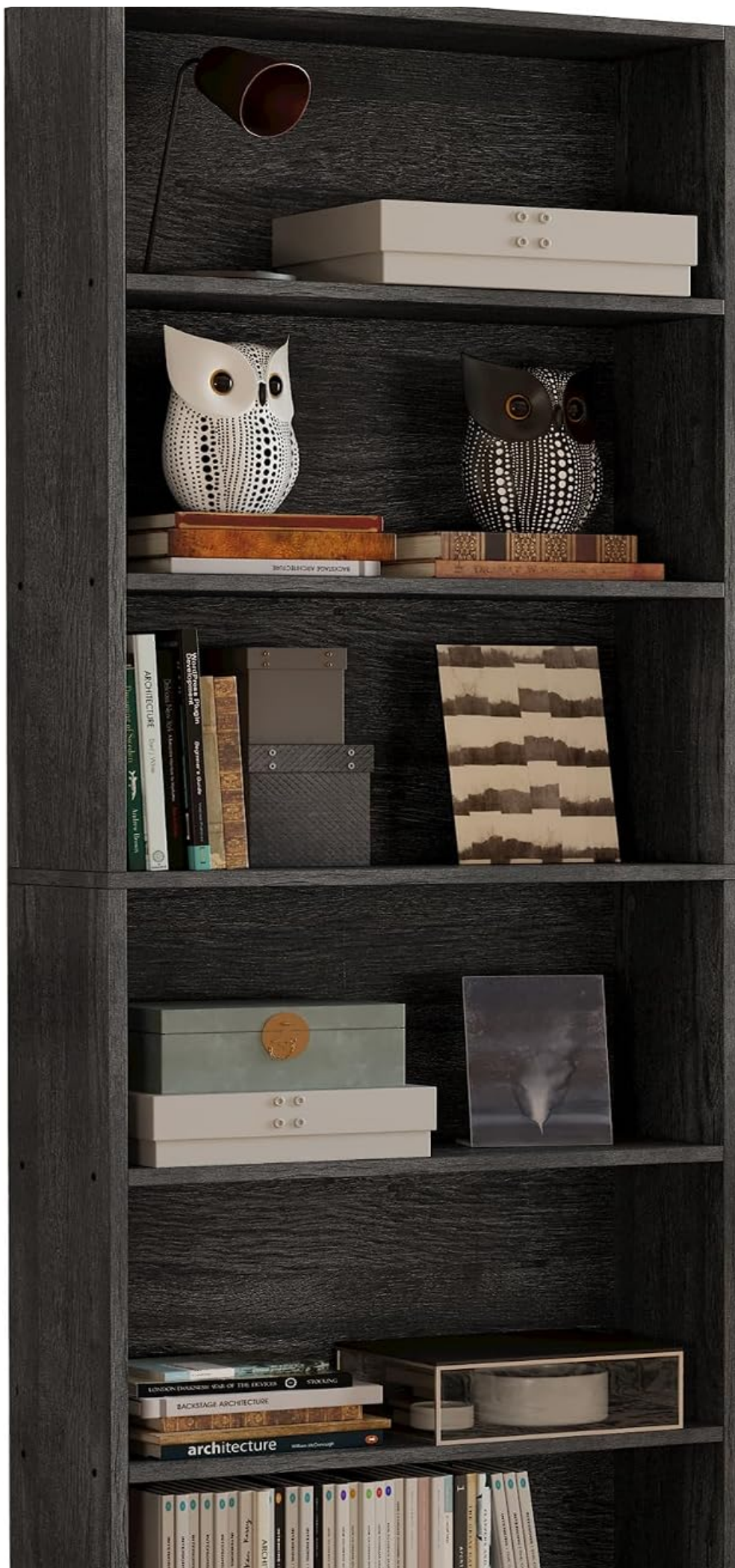




Image: The IRONCK 6-Tier Bookshelf in a living room, showcasing its storage capacity and design.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your IRONCK bookshelf.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe with a dry cloth to remove dust and light dirt. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any spills with a dry or slightly damp cloth to prevent staining or water damage.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Protect the furniture from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight to prevent warping, fading, or cracking.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your IRONCK 6-Tier Bookshelf, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bookshelf is wobbly or unstable.	Loose fasteners; uneven floor; anti-tip device not installed.	Ensure all screws are tightened. Place the bookshelf on a level surface or use shims if needed. Install the anti-tip device securely to a wall stud.
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; dowels/cam locks not fully inserted.	Review the assembly instructions carefully, ensuring each part is oriented correctly. Check that all dowels and cam locks are fully seated before tightening.
Shelf sags or bows.	Exceeded weight capacity; uneven weight distribution.	Reduce the weight on the shelf. Redistribute items to ensure even loading and place heavier items on lower shelves. Do not exceed 22 lbs per shelf.
Scratches or minor surface damage.	Accidental impact; abrasive cleaning.	For minor scratches, a furniture repair marker or wood filler matching the finish may be used. Avoid abrasive materials for cleaning.
