Monopoly My First Monopoly Board Game Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Monopoly My First Monopoly is an engaging board game designed for young players aged 4 and up. It features a unique double-sided game board offering two distinct levels of play, making it an excellent educational tool for families. This manual provides comprehensive instructions for setting up and playing both game levels, ensuring a fun and educational experience for all participants.

2. COMPONENTS

Before starting, ensure all components listed below are present in your game box. The game is designed for 2 to 6 players.

- 1 Double-Sided Game Board
- 6 Character Tokens (Penguin, Duckling, Car, Scottie, Hazel, Rex)
- 20 Level 1 Chance Cards
- 20 Level 2 Chance Cards
- 72 'Sold' Tokens (12 for each character)
- Monopoly Banknotes (various denominations)
- 1 Die
- Instruction Manual (this document)




Figure 2.1: All game components laid out, including the two-sided game board, character tokens, Chance cards, Monopoly money, and the die.

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to prepare for gameplay:

- 1. Choose a Game Level:** Decide whether to play Level 1 (for younger children, focusing on counting and matching) or Level 2 (for older children, introducing basic reading and simple math). Place the game board with the chosen side facing up.
- 2. Place Chance Cards:** Shuffle the appropriate set of Chance cards (Level 1 or Level 2) and place them face down on the designated space on the board.
- 3. Distribute Money:** Each player receives a starting amount of Monopoly banknotes. Refer to the specific rules for Level 1 or Level 2 for exact amounts.
- 4. Select Tokens:** Each player chooses one of the six character tokens and places it on the 'START' space.
- 5. Prepare 'Sold' Tokens:** Keep the 'Sold' tokens nearby, organized by character, for when properties are acquired.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (HOW TO PLAY)

General Gameplay

Players take turns rolling the die and moving their token clockwise around the board. The actions taken depend on the space landed on. The goal is to acquire properties and collect money from other players.




Figure 4.1: A child moving a game token during play.

Level 1: Counting and Matching (Ages 4+)

This level is designed for younger players to learn basic counting and matching skills. The rules are simplified to focus on these concepts.

- **Movement:** Roll the die and move your token the corresponding number of spaces.
- **Property Acquisition:** When you land on an unowned property, you can buy it by paying the bank. Place one of your 'Sold' tokens on the property to mark it as yours.
- **Landing on Owned Property:** If you land on a property owned by another player, you pay them the amount indicated on the space.
- **Chance Spaces:** Draw a Level 1 Chance card and follow its instructions.
- **Winning:** The game ends when all properties are owned. The player with the most money wins.

Level 2: Reading and Simple Math (Ages 6+)

This level introduces more traditional Monopoly elements, focusing on basic reading, simple arithmetic, and strategic thinking.

- **Movement:** Roll the die and move your token.
- **Property Acquisition:** When you land on an unowned property, you can buy it for the price listed. Place one of

your 'Sold' tokens on the property.

- **Landing on Owned Property:** If you land on a property owned by another player, you must pay them rent. The rent amount is indicated on the property space.
- **Chance Spaces:** Draw a Level 2 Chance card and follow its instructions, which may involve paying or collecting money, or moving to a different space.
- **Winning:** The game continues until one player goes bankrupt. The remaining player with the most money and properties wins.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your Monopoly My First Monopoly game:

- **Storage:** Always store all game components back in the original box after play. Keep the box in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe the game board and plastic tokens with a soft, dry cloth if they become dusty. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Handling:** Handle game cards and money carefully to prevent bending, tearing, or creasing.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their solutions:

- **Missing Components:** If any game components are missing upon opening the box, please contact the manufacturer's customer support for assistance.
- **Rules Disputes:** In case of disagreement over rules, refer to this instruction manual for clarification. For house rules, ensure all players agree before starting the game.


