INTRODUCTION

The Napoleon Freestyle 365 Propane Gas Barbecue is a compact outdoor grill designed for efficient and enjoyable grilling. It features a robust construction with premium components, including a JETFIRE ignition system for reliable startups, porcelainized enamel cast iron cooking grids for even heat distribution and distinctive sear marks, and three stainless steel burners. The grill is equipped with an ACCUPROBE temperature gauge for precise temperature monitoring and convenient side shelves that fold for easy storage. Its rugged wheels ensure portability, making it suitable for various outdoor settings.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: For Outdoor Use Only.

- Always operate the grill in a well-ventilated area. Never use it in an enclosed space such as a garage, shed, or covered patio.
- Keep the grill clear of combustible materials, gasoline, and other flammable vapors and liquids. Maintain adequate clearance from walls and railings.
- Perform a leak test on all gas connections before initial use and after any cylinder change. Refer to the assembly instructions for detailed leak testing procedures.
- Do not store a spare propane cylinder under or near the grill.
- Ensure the grill is on a stable, level surface during operation.
- Keep children and pets away from the hot grill.
- Always wear protective grilling gloves when handling hot components.

The Napoleon Freestyle 365 grill includes the following main components:

- Grill Head
- Grill Base

- Cooking Grids (2)
- Side Shelf (2)
- Warming Rack
- User Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Napoleon Freestyle 365 grill is required. It is recommended to inspect all pieces carefully and check the content and parts of the box against the assembly booklet before beginning. While assembly can be completed by one person, it may take a couple of hours. For optimal ease, consider having a second person assist with certain steps.

The grill is designed with user convenience in mind, featuring folding side shelves for compact storage and rugged wheels for easy relocation. Ensure the grill is assembled close to its intended use location due to its weight (approximately 99 pounds).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Ignition

The Napoleon Freestyle 365 features the instant JETFIRE Ignition System. To ignite a burner, simply push and turn the corresponding control knob. This system shoots a jet of flame to light each main gas burner individually, ensuring quick startups every time.

Temperature Control

Accurately measure the temperature inside your grill for optimal cooking control using the integrated ACCUPROBE temperature gauge located on the lid. The three stainless steel burners provide heat that can be easily controlled by ergonomic knobs, allowing for precise temperature management across the cooking surface.

Cooking Grids

The grill is equipped with Napoleon's iconic porcelainized enamel cast iron cooking grids. These grids are designed to resist rust, provide even heat distribution, prevent food from falling through, and create distinctive sear marks. The warming rack located above the main cooking grids is ideal for keeping cooked food warm or for indirect cooking.




Figure 6: Key innovative features of the Napoleon Freestyle 365, including the integrated bottle opener and folding side shelves.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Napoleon Freestyle 365 grill.

- **Cooking Grids:** The porcelainized enamel cast iron cooking grids are easy to clean when warm. Use a standard BBQ brush to remove food residue after each use.
- **Exterior Surfaces:** Clean the enamel finish with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Grease Management:** Regularly check and clean the grease tray to prevent flare-ups and maintain hygiene.
- **Burners:** Periodically inspect burner ports for blockages and clean as necessary to ensure even flame distribution.
- **Storage:** When not in use, especially during off-seasons or extended periods, store the grill in a dry, protected area. Utilize the folding side shelves to minimize the footprint.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Napoleon Freestyle 365 grill.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Grill not heating properly or not getting hot enough.	Low gas supply, clogged burner ports, or issues with the regulator/hose.	Check propane tank level or natural gas supply. Clean burner ports. Ensure gas hose is not kinked and regulator is properly connected.
Difficulty keeping temperature low across all racks.	High heat output from burners, or grill design.	This model heats quickly. For lower temperatures, consider turning off one or more burners to create indirect heat zones.
Burners not igniting.	No gas flow, clogged igniter, or faulty igniter electrode.	Ensure gas supply is open. Check for obstructions around the igniter. If issues persist, consult the full user manual or contact customer support.
Uneven cooking.	Uneven heat distribution due to dirty burners or improper placement of food.	Clean burner ports. Ensure food is spread evenly across the cooking surface. Utilize the ACCUPROBE temperature gauge for monitoring.



