1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Trust TKM-250 USB Wired Keyboard and Mouse Deskset provides essential input functionality for your personal computer. This deskset features a full-size keyboard with spill-resistant keys and an ambidextrous mouse, designed for straightforward and reliable use.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to connect your Trust TKM-250 Deskset to your computer:

1. **Unpack the Deskset:** Carefully remove the keyboard and mouse from their packaging.
2. **Connect the Keyboard:** Locate an available USB port on your computer. Plug the USB connector of the keyboard into the USB port.
3. **Connect the Mouse:** Locate another available USB port on your computer. Plug the USB connector of the mouse into the USB port.
4. **System Recognition:** Your operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers for the keyboard and mouse. This process may take a few moments.
5. **Test Functionality:** Once installed, test the keyboard by typing and the mouse by moving the cursor and clicking.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Keyboard Usage

- **Typing:** Use the standard QWERTY layout for text input.
- **Function Keys (F1-F12):** These keys perform various functions depending on the application or operating system.
- **Numeric Keypad:** The dedicated numeric keypad on the right provides efficient data entry.
- **Adjustable Height:** The keyboard features adjustable feet on the underside to change the typing angle for improved comfort. Gently flip out the feet to raise the keyboard.

3.2 Mouse Usage

- **Left Click:** Primary action, typically used for selecting items or opening files.
- **Right Click:** Secondary action, typically used to open context menus.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Used for scrolling through documents and web pages. The scroll wheel can also be pressed for a middle-click function in some applications.

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Keyboard or Mouse Not Responding:**
 - Ensure the USB cables are securely plugged into the computer's USB ports.
 - Try plugging the keyboard and mouse into different USB ports.
 - Restart your computer.
 - Check your computer's device manager to ensure the devices are recognized and drivers are installed correctly.
- **Keys Not Working:**
 - If specific keys are not working, check for debris under the keycaps.
 - If the keyboard has experienced a spill, ensure it is completely dry.
- **Mouse Cursor Jumps or is Erratic:**
 - Ensure the mouse sensor is clean and free of dust or debris.
 - Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective surface or a mouse pad.
