3. SETUP & INSTALLATION

The Can-Am Ryker System Audio Bluetooth Kit features a plug-and-play design for simplified installation.

3.1 Mounting the Audio System

1. Identify the desired mounting location on your vehicle's handlebar.
2. Attach the mounting brackets to the handlebar using the provided hardware. Ensure a secure fit.
3. Position the audio system unit onto the mounted brackets.
4. Secure the audio system unit to the brackets using the appropriate screws and Allen wrench. Adjust the angle for optimal sound projection and rider comfort.

3.2 Wiring Connections

1. Locate the vehicle's battery. Ensure the ignition is off.
2. Connect the red wire from the audio system's wiring harness to the positive (+) terminal of the battery.
3. Connect the black wire from the audio system's wiring harness to the negative (-) terminal of the battery.
4. Route the wiring harness neatly and securely, away from moving parts, heat sources, and sharp edges, using zip ties if necessary.
5. Connect the main power connector from the wiring harness to the audio system unit.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The audio system is designed for intuitive control. Refer to the unit's display and buttons for navigation.

4.1 Power On/Off

- Press and hold the Power button (usually marked with a power symbol) to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Volume Adjustment

- Use the Volume Up (+) and Volume Down (-) buttons to adjust the audio output level.

4.3 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the audio system is powered on and in Bluetooth mode (indicated on the display).
2. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "Can-Am Audio" or a similar name from the list of devices to pair.
4. Once paired, you can stream audio from your device to the audio system.

4.4 Mode Selection

- Press the Mode button (usually marked with 'M') to cycle through available audio sources (e.g., Bluetooth, FM Radio, USB).

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your audio system.

- Keep the audio system clean by wiping it with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Periodically check all wiring connections for tightness and signs of wear or corrosion.
- Ensure the mounting hardware remains secure. Tighten any loose screws as needed.
- Protect the unit from extreme temperatures and prolonged direct sunlight when not in use.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Loose wiring connection, blown fuse, dead battery.	Check battery connections. Inspect the fuse in the wiring harness. Ensure vehicle battery is charged.
No audio output	Volume too low, incorrect source selected, Bluetooth not paired.	Increase volume. Press Mode button to select correct source. Re-pair Bluetooth device.
Poor sound quality	Weak Bluetooth signal, interference, damaged speaker.	Move device closer to the unit. Avoid sources of interference. Contact support if speakers are damaged.
Bluetooth not connecting	Device out of range, pairing mode not active, previous connection issue.	Ensure device is within 10 meters. Activate Bluetooth pairing mode on unit. Forget device on phone and re-pair.
