1. Introduction and Overview

The VTech VM5254 Digital 5-inch Video Baby Monitor System provides a secure and reliable way to monitor your baby. It features a 1080p video camera and a large 5-inch LCD parent unit. Key functionalities include an adaptive multicolor nightlight, lullabies, soft sounds, two-way talk, and nursery temperature monitoring. The system is designed for clear visibility during both day and night with automatic night vision.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Ensure all items are present in your package:

- Parent Unit (with 5-inch LCD screen)
- Baby Unit (camera)
- · Power adapter for Parent Unit
- · Power adapter for Baby Unit
- · Instruction Manual

3. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Please read and follow all safety instructions before using this product to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons:

- Keep the product out of reach of children.
- Do not place the baby unit or cords within 3 feet of the crib.
- Use only the power adapters provided.
- Do not expose the product to water or moisture.

- Avoid placing the product near heat sources.
- Ensure proper ventilation for both units.

4. SETUP

4.1 Powering the Baby Unit (Camera)

- 1. Connect the small plug of the baby unit power adapter to the power jack on the back of the baby unit.
- 2. Plug the large end of the power adapter into a wall outlet.
- 3. The baby unit will power on automatically.

4.2 Powering the Parent Unit

- 1. Connect the small plug of the parent unit power adapter to the power jack on the side of the parent unit.
- 2. Plug the large end of the power adapter into a wall outlet.
- 3. Press and hold the **POWER** button on the parent unit until the screen turns on.
- 4. The parent unit comes with a built-in rechargeable battery. For optimal performance, charge the battery for at least 12 hours before initial use.

4.3 Positioning the Baby Unit

Place the baby unit in a location that provides a clear view of your baby in the crib. Ensure the unit is at least 3 feet away from the crib to prevent entanglement hazards with the power cord. The camera angle can be adjusted for the best view.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Parent Unit Controls

- POWER: Turns the parent unit on or off.
- TALK: Press and hold to speak to your baby through the baby unit.
- MENU/SELECT: Accesses the menu options or confirms a selection.
- Arrow Buttons (▲ ▼ ◄ ►):Navigate through menu options or adjust camera pan/tilt.
- VOL +/-: Adjusts the listening volume.
- **ZOOM:** Magnifies the image on the screen.
- VIEW: Switches between cameras if multiple are paired (not applicable for single camera system).
- EXIT/LCD ON/OFF: Exits menu or turns the LCD screen on/off while audio monitoring continues.

5.2 Monitoring Your Baby

Once both units are powered on and linked, the parent unit will automatically display the video feed from the baby unit. The **LINK** indicator on the parent unit will be green when a connection is established.

5.3 Two-Way Talk

To speak to your baby, press and hold the **TALK** button on the parent unit. Release the button to hear your baby.

5.4 Night Vision

The baby unit is equipped with infrared LEDs for automatic night vision. In low light conditions, the unit will automatically switch to black and white night vision mode, allowing you to see your baby clearly in the dark.

5.5 Adaptive Nightlight and Lullabies

The baby unit features an adaptive multicolor nightlight and can play lullables and soft sounds. Refer to the parent unit menu for options to control the nightlight color and brightness, and to select and play lullables.

5.6 Temperature Monitoring

The parent unit displays the temperature of the nursery, as detected by the baby unit's sensor. This allows you to ensure your baby's room is at a comfortable temperature.

6. FEATURES

The VTech VM5254 monitor includes the following features:

- 1080p Full HD video for clear viewing on the 5-inch LCD parent unit.
- · Adjustable camera angle for optimal positioning.
- 32 frequency channels for secure transmission between camera and monitor.
- Up to 1,000 ft. range for flexible monitoring within your home.
- · Adaptive multicolor nightlight integrated into the baby unit.
- Lullabies and soothing sounds playable from the baby unit.
- Two-way talk functionality for communication with your baby.
- Nursery temperature monitoring displayed on the parent unit.
- · Automatic night vision for clear viewing in low light conditions.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning the Units

Wipe the surfaces of the baby unit and parent unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use cleaning sprays or liquid cleaners. Ensure the units are completely dry before reconnecting to power.

7.2 Battery Care (Parent Unit)

The parent unit uses a rechargeable Lithium-lon battery. To prolong battery life:

- Charge the battery fully before first use.
- · Avoid extreme temperatures.
- If storing the unit for an extended period, charge the battery periodically.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your VTech VM5254 monitor, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No link/Poor signal	Ensure both units are powered on. Move the parent unit closer to the baby unit. Avoid placing units near large metal objects or other electronic devices that may cause interference.

Problem	Possible Solution
No picture/sound on parent unit	Check if the parent unit is turned on and charged. Ensure the baby unit is powered on. Adjust the volume on the parent unit.
Picture is black and white	This indicates night vision mode is active due to low light conditions. This is normal operation.
Short battery life on parent unit	Ensure the battery is fully charged. Reduce screen brightness. Consider replacing the battery if it's old and no longer holds a charge effectively.
Static or interference	Move the units away from other electronic devices (e.g., cell phones, Wi-Fi routers). Adjust the position of the baby unit.


