INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the FORZA Alu60 Football Goal is designed to be straightforward. Follow these steps carefully:

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the aluminum frame periodically with a damp cloth and mild detergent to remove dirt and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Net Care:** The net is waterproof, but regular inspection for tears or damage is recommended. Replace damaged nets promptly.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the goal in a dry, sheltered area to protect it from extreme weather conditions. The quick-release bar allows for compact storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Goal feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose connections or uneven ground.	Check and tighten all bolts and fasteners. Ensure the goal is placed on a flat, level surface.
Net is sagging or loose.	Net clips are loose or net is stretched.	Re-secure net clips. If the net is damaged or excessively stretched, consider replacing it.
Difficulty disassembling the goal.	Quick-release mechanism stuck or components are stiff.	Ensure the quick-release bar is fully disengaged. Apply a small amount of lubricant to moving parts if necessary.
