1. Introduction

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

2.1 Unboxing and Initial Setup

2.2 Folding and Unfolding




Image: A close-up view of the quick-fold lock release button, highlighting its location for easy folding and transport.

2.3 Battery Installation and Charging

The Lithium-ion battery is included and typically pre-installed. Ensure the battery is securely seated. Connect the charger to the charging port on the chair and then to a standard electrical outlet. The charging indicator will show the battery status. A full charge provides approximately 12.4 miles of range.

2.4 Adjustments

The WHILL Model F offers several adjustable features for user comfort:

- Controller and Arm Rest Height: Adjust to your preferred ergonomic position.
- Controller Side: The controller can be mounted on either the right or left side.
- Arm Height and Width: Adjust the armrests for optimal support. The width between armrests is adjustable from 18 to 20 inches.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Basic Controls

The power chair is operated using a joystick controller. Push the joystick in the desired direction to move. The further you push, the faster the chair will move, up to a top speed of 3.7 mph. Release the joystick to stop.

3.2 Remote Control via App

The WHILL Model F can be remotely controlled using the dedicated WHILL app on your smartphone. Download the app from your device's app store and follow the in-app instructions for pairing and control. This feature allows for convenient maneuvering of the chair when not seated.

3.3 Maneuverability and Performance

The Model F is designed for excellent maneuverability and performance:

- Turning Radius: Features a tight 30.7-inch turning radius, ideal for navigating narrow spaces.
- **Obstacle Climbing:** Capable of climbing over obstacles up to 1.4 inches high with its powerful dual motors.
- Weight Capacity: Supports a user weight capacity of up to 250 lbs.

4.3 Storage


When not in use, the WHILL Model F can be folded for compact storage. Store it in a dry, protected area away from extreme temperatures.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Chair does not power on	Battery not charged or improperly installed.	Ensure battery is fully charged and correctly seated. Check power button.
Chair moves slowly or erratically	Low battery, joystick malfunction, or obstacle.	Charge battery. Check for obstructions around wheels. If joystick is faulty, contact support.
Unusual noises during operation	Loose components or foreign objects.	Inspect for loose parts or debris. If noise persists, contact support.
