FORIOUS FB-0302BD Waterfall Bathroom Faucet Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your FORIOUS FB-0302BD Waterfall Bathroom Faucet. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference. Proper installation and care will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your faucet.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always turn off the main water supply before beginning any plumbing work.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as safety glasses and gloves.
- If you are unsure about any installation steps, consult a qualified plumber.
- Ensure all connections are secure to prevent leaks.
- Do not overtighten nuts or connections, as this can damage components.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- FORIOUS Waterfall Faucet Body (Matte Black)
- Metal Pop-Up Drain with Strainer
- Hot and Cold Water Supply Hoses (3/8-inch)
- Mounting Hardware (gasket, washer, mounting nut)
- Deck Plate / Cover Plate (for 3-hole installation)

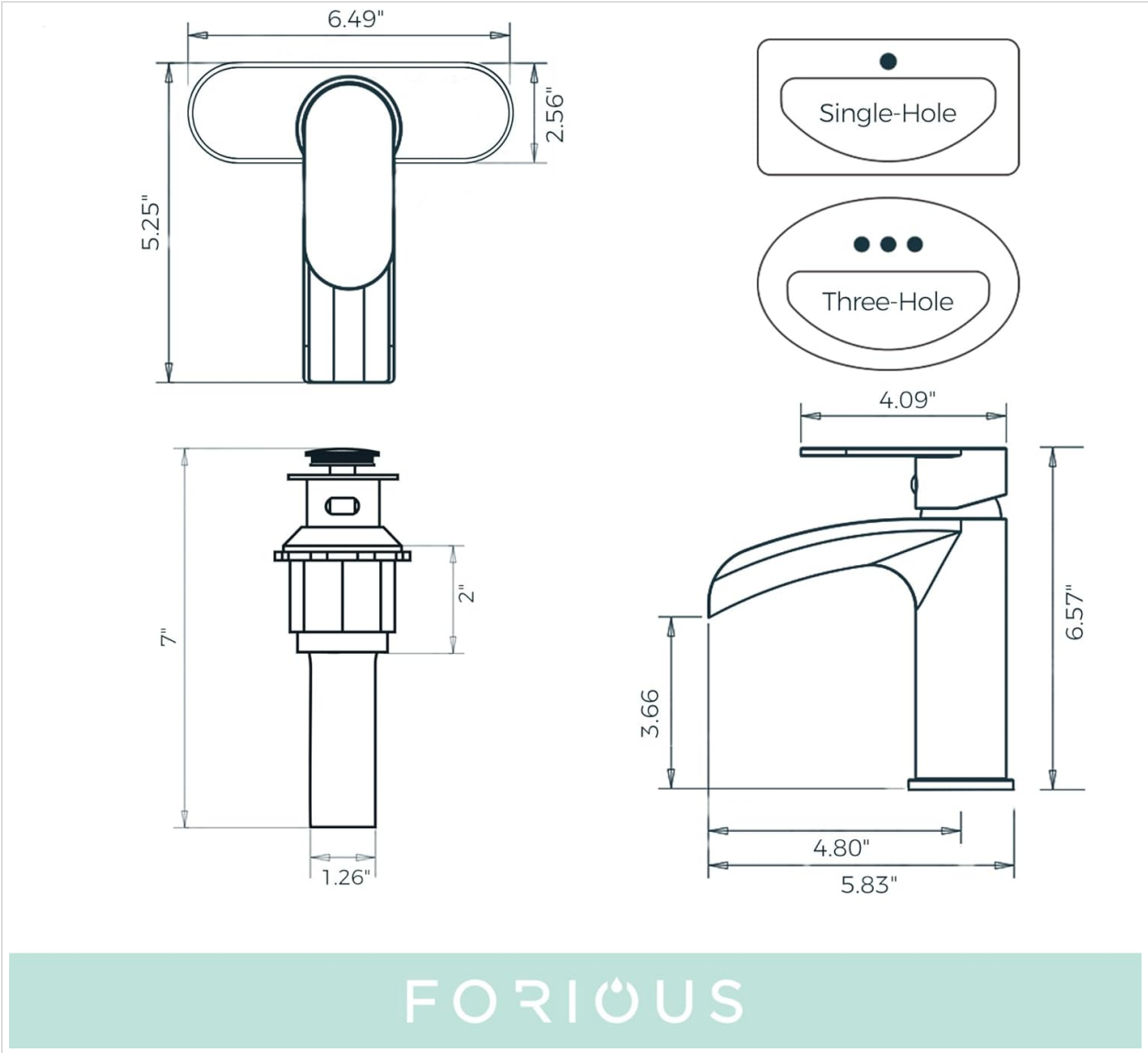


Image 3.1: Faucet and Pop-Up Drain components.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Tools Required (Not Included):

- Adjustable Wrench
- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Plumber's Putty or Silicone Sealant
- Flashlight (optional)
- Bucket and Towel

Pre-Installation Steps:

1. Turn off the hot and cold water supply valves under the sink. If no shut-off valves are present, turn off the main water supply to your home.
2. Open the existing faucet to drain any remaining water from the lines.
3. Remove the old faucet and clean the sink surface thoroughly.

Faucet Installation:

1. **Prepare the Faucet:** If your sink has three holes, place the deck plate (cover plate) over the holes. Ensure the rubber gasket is properly seated on the underside of the deck plate or faucet base.
2. **Insert Faucet:** Insert the faucet body through the center hole of the sink (and deck plate, if used). Ensure the faucet is oriented correctly.

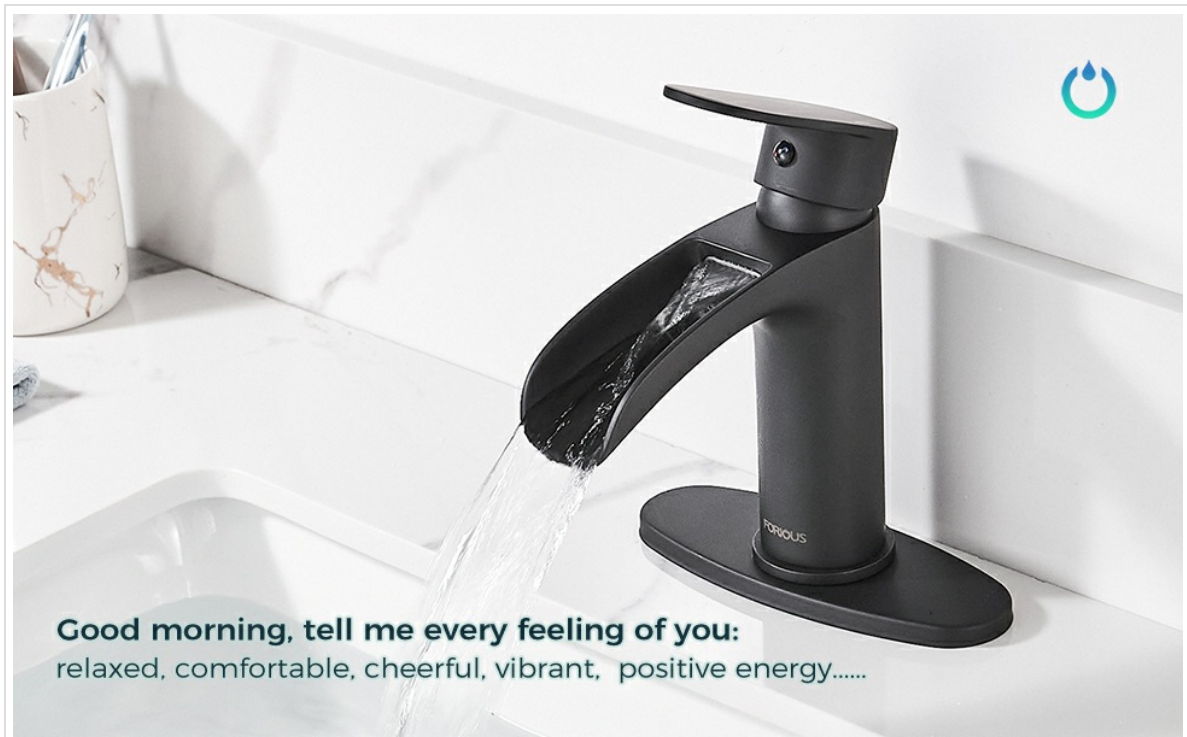


Image 5.1: Insert the faucet body through the sink hole.

3. **Secure Faucet:** From underneath the sink, slide the rubber washer, then the metal washer, onto the threaded shank of the faucet. Hand-tighten the mounting nut, then use an adjustable wrench to secure it firmly. Do not overtighten.

4. **Connect Water Hoses:** Connect the hot and cold water supply hoses to the corresponding inlets on the faucet body. The hoses are typically color-coded (red for hot, blue for cold). Hand-tighten, then use a wrench for a snug fit. Connect the other ends of the hoses to your hot and cold water supply valves.

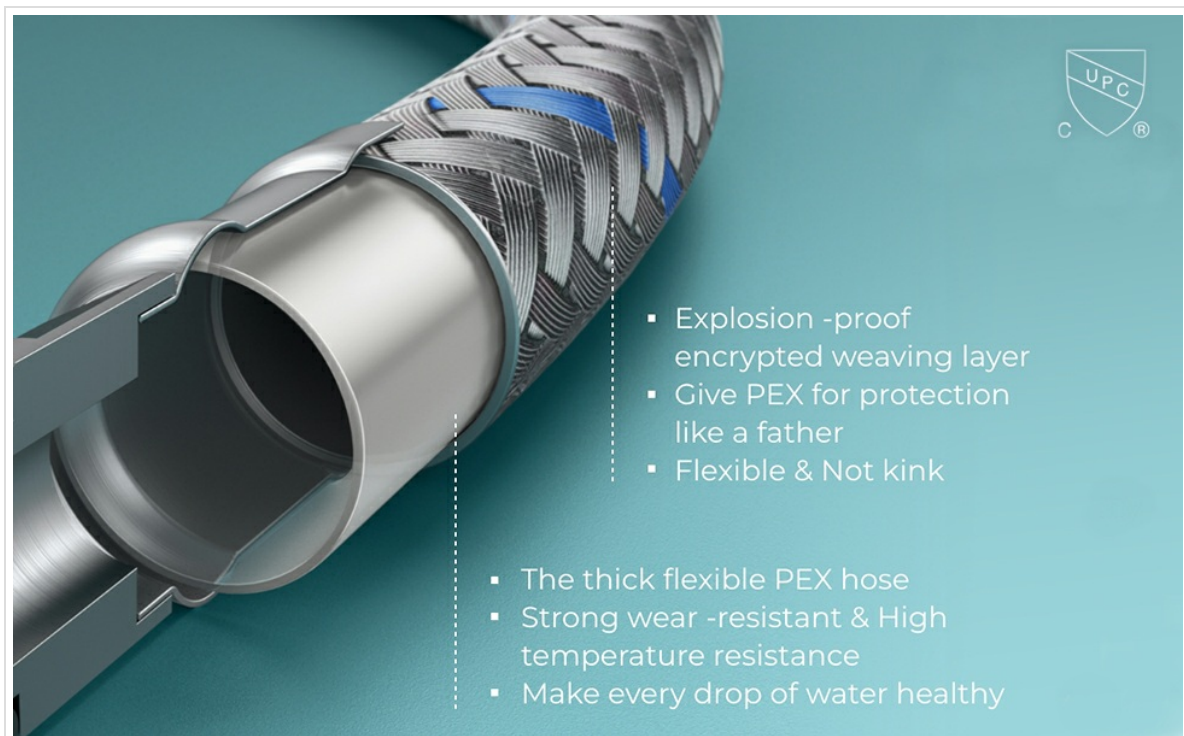


Image 5.3: Attach the hot and cold water supply hoses to the faucet and supply lines.

Pop-Up Drain Installation:

1. **Disassemble Drain:** Unscrew the nut and remove the washers from the drain body.
2. **Apply Sealant:** Apply a bead of plumber's putty or silicone sealant around the underside of the drain flange.
3. **Insert Drain:** Insert the drain body through the sink drain hole from above.

4. **Secure Drain:** From underneath the sink, slide the rubber washer, then the plastic washer, and finally the mounting nut onto the drain body. Hand-tighten the nut, then use a wrench to secure it firmly. Wipe away any excess sealant.

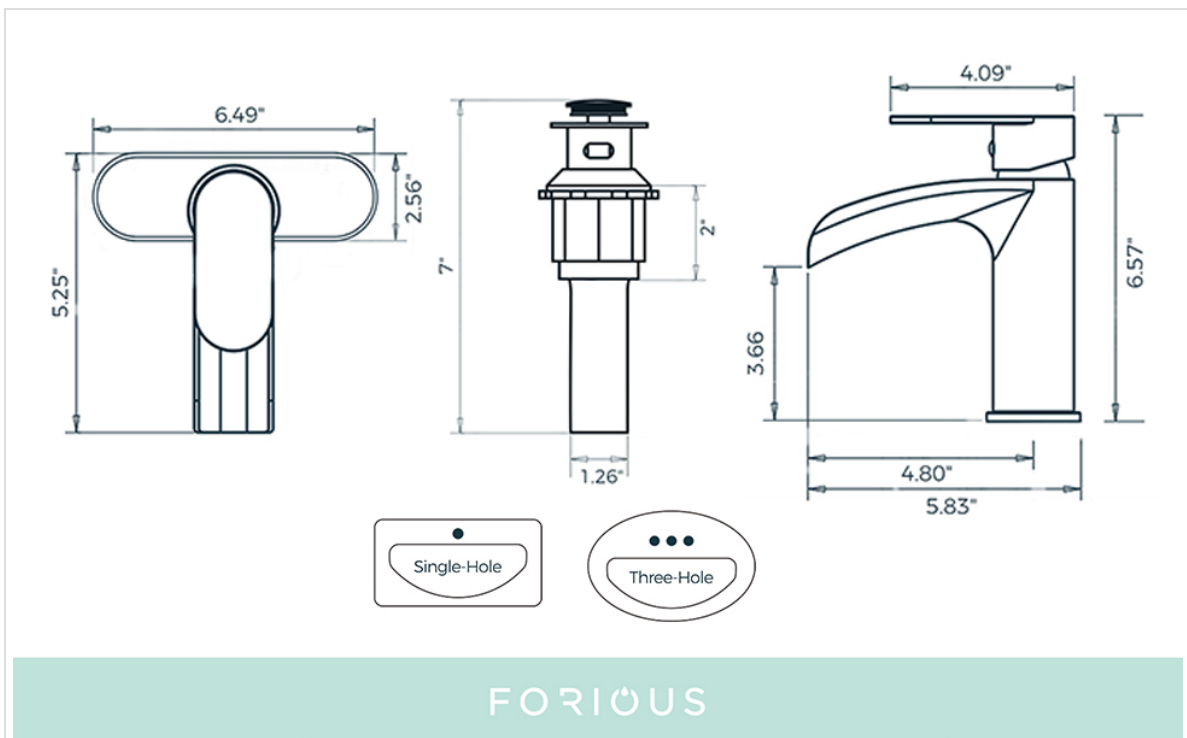


Image 5.5: Secure the pop-up drain assembly from below the sink.

Final Steps:

1. Slowly turn on the hot and cold water supply valves.
2. Check all connections for leaks. Tighten any leaking connections as needed.
3. Remove the detachable strainer from the pop-up drain and flush the faucet for a few minutes to clear any debris from the water lines. Reinstall the strainer.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The FORIOUS FB-0302BD faucet features a single lever handle for controlling both water flow and temperature.

- **Water Flow:** Lift the handle upwards to increase water flow. Push it downwards to decrease flow and turn off the water.
- **Temperature Control:** Move the handle to the left for hot water and to the right for cold water. Adjust the handle position between left and right to achieve the desired water temperature.

The water flow is gentle and concentrated, which effectively prevents splashing

7. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Faucet:

- To maintain the matte black finish, clean the faucet regularly with a soft, damp cloth.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads, as these can damage the finish.
- The multi-layer sprayed black surface is designed to be non-corrosive, non-rusting, and anti-scratch.

Ceramic Valve Core:

The faucet is equipped with a patented ceramic valve core, tested for 500,000 non-leakage cycles, ensuring long-term reliability. No user maintenance is typically required for the valve core itself.

Cleaning the Pop-Up Drain:

The metal pop-up drain includes a detachable anti-clogging strainer. Periodically remove the strainer and clean any accumulated debris to maintain proper drainage.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Flow	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Partially closed water supply valves.• Debris in water lines or faucet.• Clogged pop-up drain strainer.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure hot and cold water supply valves are fully open.• Flush the faucet by running water for several minutes.• Remove and clean the detachable strainer in the pop-up drain.

Leaks from connections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Loose connections. Damaged washers or seals. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Carefully tighten all connections with a wrench. Do not overtighten. Inspect washers and seals for damage and replace if necessary.
Water not turning off completely	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Debris in the ceramic valve. Worn ceramic valve cartridge. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flush the faucet thoroughly. If the issue persists, contact customer support for assistance.




