1. INTRODUCTION

The Curaprox CS Kids Toothbrush, Model 5500, is designed for children aged 4 to 12 years. It features 5,500 ultra-soft Curen® filaments to provide gentle yet effective cleaning for developing teeth and gums. This manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your child's toothbrush.

2. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the toothbrush from its packaging.
2. **Initial Rinse:** Before the first use, rinse the toothbrush head thoroughly under clean running water.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Proper brushing technique is crucial for effective oral hygiene. Guide your child to follow these steps:

- **Apply Toothpaste:** Apply a pea-sized amount of fluoride toothpaste suitable for children to the bristles.
- **Positioning:** Hold the toothbrush at a 45-degree angle to the gum line, with half of the bristles on the tooth surface and half on the gum.
- **Brushing Motion:** Move the toothbrush in small, gentle circles. Avoid harsh scrubbing.
- **Cover All Surfaces:** Ensure all tooth surfaces are cleaned, including the outer, inner, and chewing surfaces. The compact brush head is designed to reach all areas of the mouth.
- **Duration:** Brush for at least two minutes, twice a day (morning and evening).

- **Gentle Pressure:** The rounded handle and ultra-soft bristles encourage gentle pressure, preventing damage to gums and enamel.

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Rinse After Use:** After each brushing session, rinse the toothbrush head thoroughly under running water to remove any toothpaste residue and debris.
- **Storage:** Store the toothbrush upright in a holder, allowing it to air dry. Avoid covering the brush head, as this can promote bacterial growth.
- **Replacement:** Dentists recommend replacing toothbrushes every three to four months, or sooner if the bristles become frayed or worn. Worn bristles are less effective at cleaning.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Bristles Fraying Quickly:** If the bristles show signs of fraying or splaying prematurely, it may indicate that too much pressure is being applied during brushing. Encourage your child to use a lighter touch.
- **Ineffective Cleaning:** Ensure the brushing technique described in Section 3 is being followed correctly. A worn toothbrush should be replaced.
