SETUP

The Scrub Daddy Damp Duster comes pre-moistened and ready for immediate use. For subsequent uses, or if the duster has dried out, simply re-moisten it with water before each use to soften the foam. No additional chemicals are required for its operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Preparation:** If the duster is dry, hold it under running water until the foam softens. Squeeze out any excess water so it is damp, not dripping wet.
2. **Dusting:** Gently wipe the desired surface with the damp duster. The rippled design will effectively capture and hold dust, pollen, pet hair, and other debris.
3. **Versatile Use:** This duster is suitable for various surfaces including Venetian and wooden blinds, vents, radiators, skirting

boards, railings, mirrors, and more.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Solution
Duster is hard and stiff.	This is normal when the duster is dry. Simply re-moisten it with warm water until the foam softens before use.
Dust is not being picked up effectively.	Ensure the duster is adequately damp. If it's too dry, it may not trap dust as efficiently. Rinse and re-moisten if necessary.
