1. Introduction

This compact microwave oven features a 0.7 cubic foot capacity and 700 watts of cooking power, designed for quick and convenient heating. Its retro aesthetic, combined with modern features like an LED digital display and pre-programmed settings, makes it a stylish and functional addition to any kitchen.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury to persons, or exposure to excessive microwave energy when using your appliance, follow basic safety precautions, including the following:

- · Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open as this can result in harmful exposure to microwave energy.
- Do not place any object between the oven front face and the door or allow soil or cleaner residue to accumulate on sealing surfaces.
- Do not operate the oven if it is damaged. It is particularly important that the oven door closes properly and that there is no damage to the door (bent), hinges and latches (broken or loosened), or door seals and sealing surfaces.
- The oven should not be adjusted or repaired by anyone except properly qualified service personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the microwave.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in closed containers since they are liable to explode.
- Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is used by or near children.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

Your microwave oven is designed for ease of use and features a classic retro design. Key components include:

- Chrome Door Handle: For opening and closing the microwave door.
- Control Panel: Features an LED digital display, function buttons, and a rotary dial.
- Rotating Glass Carousel: Ensures even cooking by rotating food during operation.
- Easy Clean Interior: Designed for simple cleaning and maintenance.

4. SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and accessories. Inspect the microwave for any damage, such as dents or a misaligned door. Do not operate if damaged.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the microwave on a flat, stable surface, such as a countertop. Ensure there is adequate space for ventilation around the unit. The back of the microwave includes a stopper to maintain proper distance from a wall for airflow.
- 3. Power Connection: Plug the microwave into a grounded electrical outlet.
- 4. **Initial Clock Setting:** Upon first use or after a power outage, the LED display will show '0:00'. Refer to the operating instructions for setting the clock.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your microwave oven offers various functions for convenient cooking and heating.

5.1. Basic Operation

- Setting Cook Time: Use the rotary dial to set the desired cooking time.
- **Instant Start:** Press the rotary dial to instantly start cooking for 30 seconds. Each subsequent press adds 30 seconds to the cooking time.
- Pause/Cancel: Press the 'PAUSE/CANCEL' button to temporarily stop cooking or to clear the current setting.

5.2. Power Levels

The microwave features 5 power levels to suit different cooking needs. Press the 'MICRO POWER' button repeatedly to cycle through the available power levels (e.g., P-100 for 100% power, P-80 for 80% power, etc.).

5.3. Express Cooking

The 'EXPRESS' button allows for quick cooking cycles. Press the 'EXPRESS' button to cycle through preset express cooking times, typically in 30-second increments up to 1 minute 30 seconds (1:30).

5.4. Preset Cooking Settings

Your microwave includes 12 pre-programmed cooking settings for popular foods. Rotate the dial to select from options like baked potato, chicken, defrost steak, coffee, popcorn, and more. The display will show codes like A-01, A-02, etc., corresponding to specific food types. Consult the full manual for a detailed list of these settings.

5.5. Defrost Function

Use the 'PRESET/CLOCK DEFROST' button to access the defrost function. This allows you to defrost food based on time or weight. Refer to the detailed manual for specific instructions on using the defrost settings.

5.6. Child Lock Feature

To activate the Child Lock, press and hold the 'PAUSE/CANCEL' button for approximately 3 seconds. The display will indicate that the child lock is active. To deactivate, press and hold the 'PAUSE/CANCEL' button again for 3 seconds.

Oven will not start	Door is not closed securely.	Close the door completely.	
	Power cord is not plugged in.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into an outlet.	
	Circuit breaker tripped or fuse blown.	Check your household circuit breaker or fuse box.	
Food is not heating	Incorrect cooking time or power level set.	Adjust cooking time and power level as needed.	
	Door is not closed securely.	Close the door completely.	
Turntable is not rotating	Turntable is not properly seated.	Ensure the glass carousel and support ring are correctly positioned.	
	Obstruction under the turntable.	Remove any debris or food particles from beneath the turntable.
