INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Amazon Basics Wireless Presenter, Model 2804. This device is designed to enhance presentations with its wireless control, green laser pointer, and integrated timer function.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Amazon Basics Wireless Presenter (Model 2804)
- USB Receiver (stored within the presenter)
- User Manual (this document)

SETUP

1. Charging the Presenter

The presenter is equipped with a built-in rechargeable 400mAh lithium battery. Before initial use, or if the battery indicator shows low power, charge the device using a standard USB charging port (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).

- 1. Locate the charging port on the side of the presenter.
- 2. Connect a micro-USB cable (not included) to the charging port and the other end to a power source.
- 3. The battery indicator on the presenter's display will show charging status.

2. Connecting the USB Receiver

The wireless presenter uses a 2.4 GHz USB receiver for connection to your computer. The receiver is stored magnetically within the presenter for convenience.

- 1. Gently pull the USB receiver from its storage slot at the bottom of the presenter.
- 2. Insert the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
- 3. The presenter is plug-and-play; no additional drivers are required for most operating systems.

3. Powering On the Presenter

Locate the ON/OFF slider switch on the side of the presenter and slide it to the "ON" position.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Amazon Basics Wireless Presenter features intuitive one-touch controls for effective presentation management.

Button Functions:

- ON/OFF Slider: Powers the presenter on or off.
- Previous Button (<): Navigates to the previous slide or page.
- Next Button (>): Navigates to the next slide or page.
- Laser Button (Star icon): Activates the green laser pointer. Release to turn off.
- Full Screen Button (Play icon): Initiates or exits full-screen presentation mode.
- Black Screen/Exit Button (Square icon): Toggles a black screen during a presentation or exits the presentation.
- Set Timer Button: Used to set the presentation timer.
- Start/Pause Button: Starts, pauses, or resets the presentation timer.

Using the Timer Function:

The integrated timer helps you manage your presentation time effectively.

- 1. Press the **Set Timer Button** to enter timer setting mode.
- 2. Use the **Previous (<)** and **Next (>)** buttons to adjust the desired presentation time.

- 3. Press the **Set Timer Button** again to confirm the time.
- 4. Press the **Start/Pause Button** to begin the countdown during your presentation.
- 5. The presenter may provide vibrational feedback when the timer expires (refer to display for specific indications).

MAINTENANCE

Charging the Battery:

To ensure optimal performance, regularly charge the built-in lithium battery. The battery indicator on the display will show the current charge level. A full charge provides extended use.

Cleaning:

Wipe the presenter with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the device in water.

Storage:

When not in use, store the USB receiver inside the presenter's magnetic slot to prevent loss. Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Presenter not responding.	 Presenter is off. Low battery. USB receiver not properly connected. Out of range. 	 Ensure the ON/OFF slider is in the "ON" position. Charge the presenter's battery. Ensure the USB receiver is fully inserted into a working USB port. Try a different USB port. Move closer to the computer (within 2.4 GHz wireless range).
Green laser not working.	Presenter is off.Laser button not pressed.Low battery.	 Ensure the presenter is powered on. Press and hold the Laser Button (star icon). Charge the presenter's battery.
Timer function not working.	Timer not set or started.	Follow the "Using the Timer Function" steps in the Operating Instructions.
Presenter buttons do not control slides.	 Software not in presentation mode. Compatibility issue. 	 Ensure your presentation software (e.g., PowerPoint, Keynote) is in slideshow mode. Verify your operating system is compatible (Windows 11, 10, 8, 7, Vista, XP, 2000; Mac OS 10.4X or later; Android 4.0).


