## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove the Dust Bin:** First, detach the dust bin from your PRETTYCARE W200 or W300 vacuum cleaner according to your vacuum's specific instructions.
- 2. Locate the Old Filter:** Inside the dust bin, identify and carefully remove the existing filter.
- 3. Insert New Filter:** Place the new PRETTYCARE Replacement Filter Sponge into the designated slot within the dust bin. Ensure it fits snugly and is properly seated to prevent air leakage.
- 4. Reattach Dust Bin:** Reconnect the dust bin to your vacuum cleaner, ensuring it locks securely into place.

## OPERATING PRINCIPLES

The PRETTYCARE Replacement Filter Sponge is a critical component in your vacuum cleaner's filtration system. It is designed to capture microscopic dust, allergens, and other airborne particles, preventing them from being released back into your environment.

The filter utilizes a multi-layer, high-density material that can effectively trap particles as small as 0.1 microns, contributing to cleaner air and maintaining the vacuum's suction power.

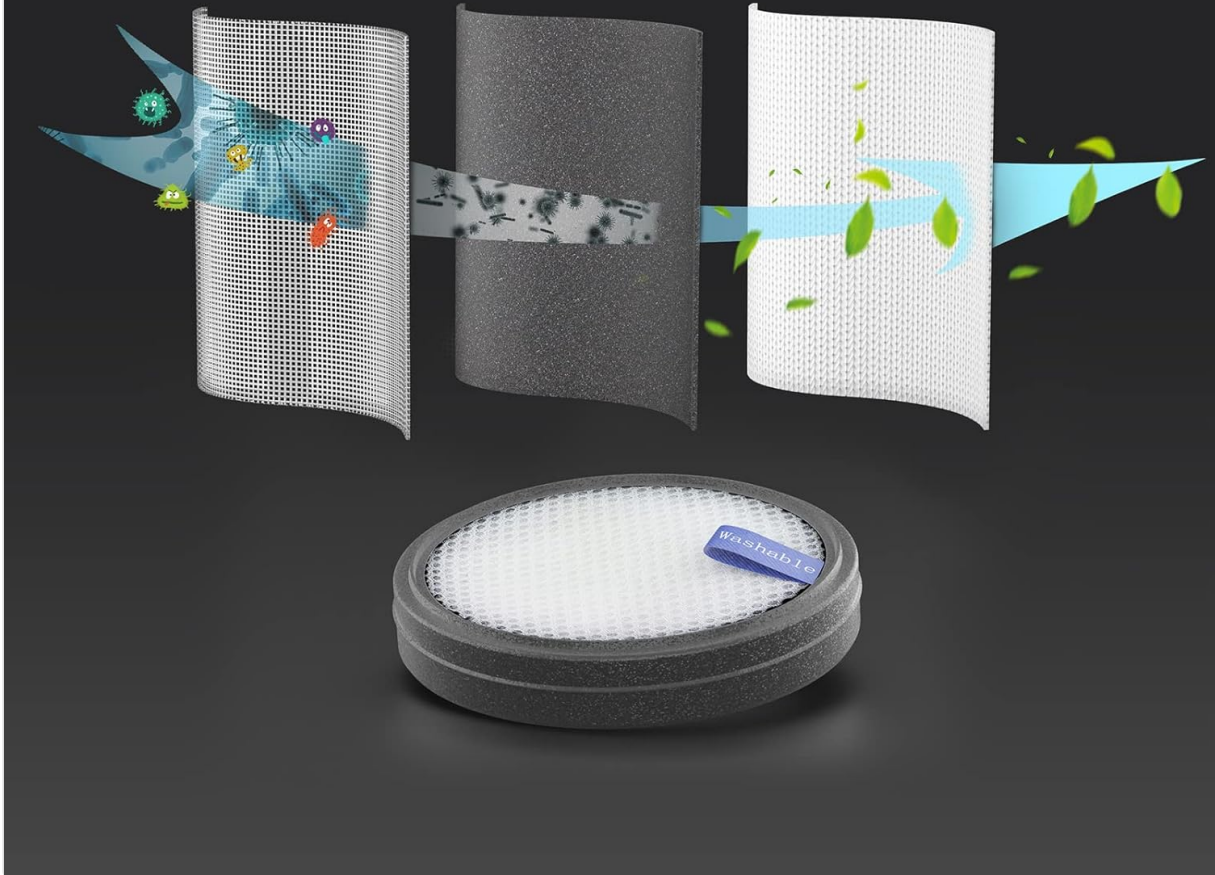


Image: A diagram illustrating the multi-layer filtration process, showing how the high-density filter cotton captures dust and particles down to 0.1 microns.

## MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance of your filter sponge ensures optimal performance and longevity of your vacuum cleaner.

### Cleaning the Filter

The PRETTYCARE Replacement Filter Sponge is washable and reusable. Follow these steps for cleaning:

- 1. Remove Filter:** Detach the dust bin and remove the filter as described in the "Setup and Installation" section.
- 2. Rinse with Water:** Rinse the filter under cool, running water until the water runs clear. Gently squeeze the filter to remove excess water and dislodge trapped debris. Do not use detergents or hot water.
- 3. Air Dry Completely:** Allow the filter to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting it into the vacuum cleaner. Ensure it is thoroughly dry to prevent mold growth and damage to the vacuum.

# Easy Cleaning

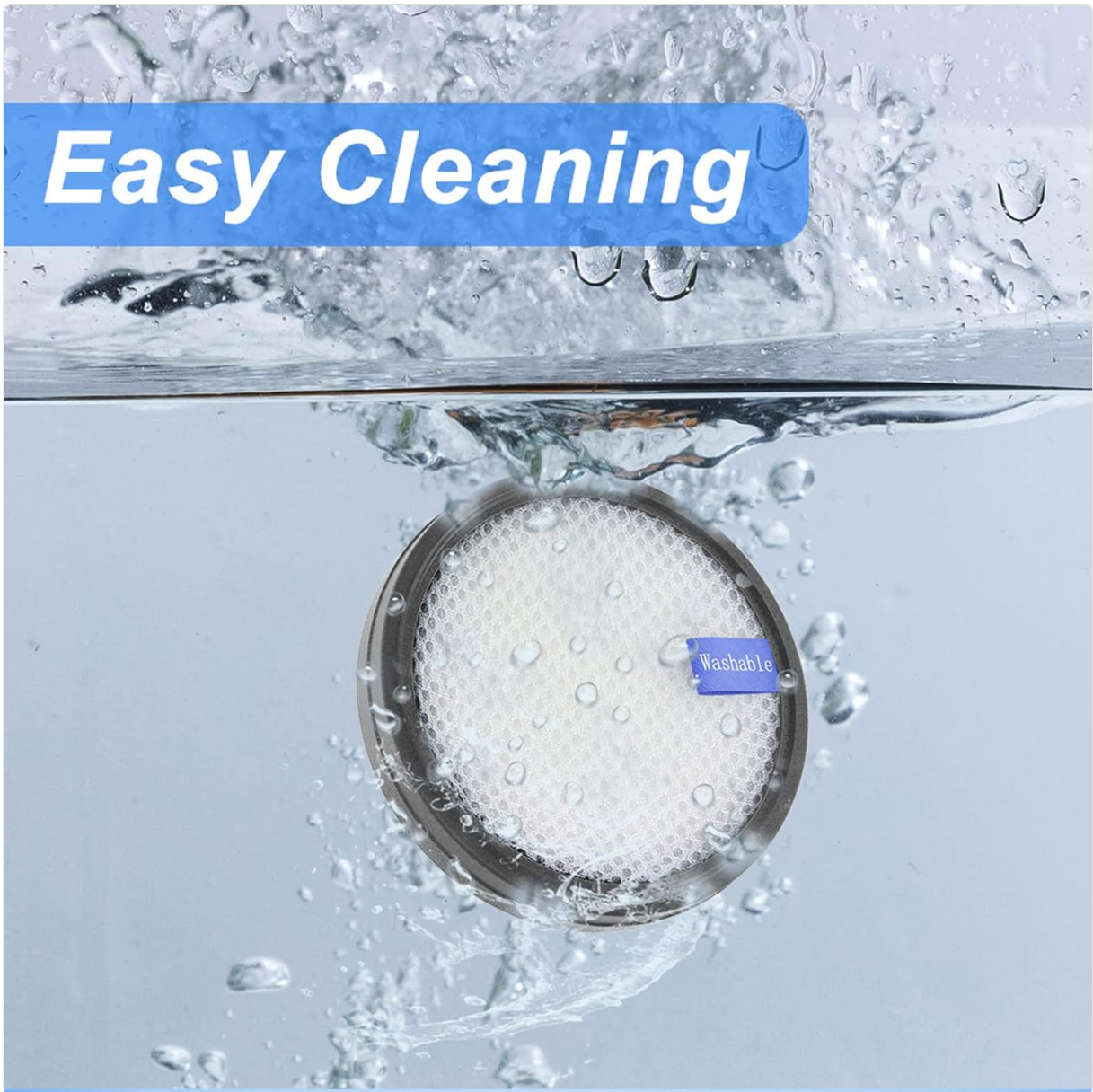


Image: The filter sponge being rinsed under running water, demonstrating the easy cleaning process.

## Filter Replacement

For best performance and to maintain effective filtration, it is recommended to replace the filter every 2-3 months, depending on usage frequency and the amount of debris collected. Regular replacement helps prevent reduced suction and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your vacuum cleaner's performance, consider the following filter-related troubleshooting steps:

- **Reduced Suction:** If your vacuum's suction power decreases, the filter may be clogged. Remove and clean the filter thoroughly. Ensure it is completely dry before reinstallation. If suction does not improve, consider replacing the filter.
- **Unusual Odors:** Persistent odors from the vacuum cleaner can indicate a dirty or improperly dried filter. Clean the filter and ensure it is fully dry. If odors persist, replace the filter.
- **Dust Escaping:** If dust appears to be escaping from the vacuum, check that the filter is correctly installed and seated snugly in the dust bin. Also, inspect the filter for any damage or tears that might compromise its effectiveness.

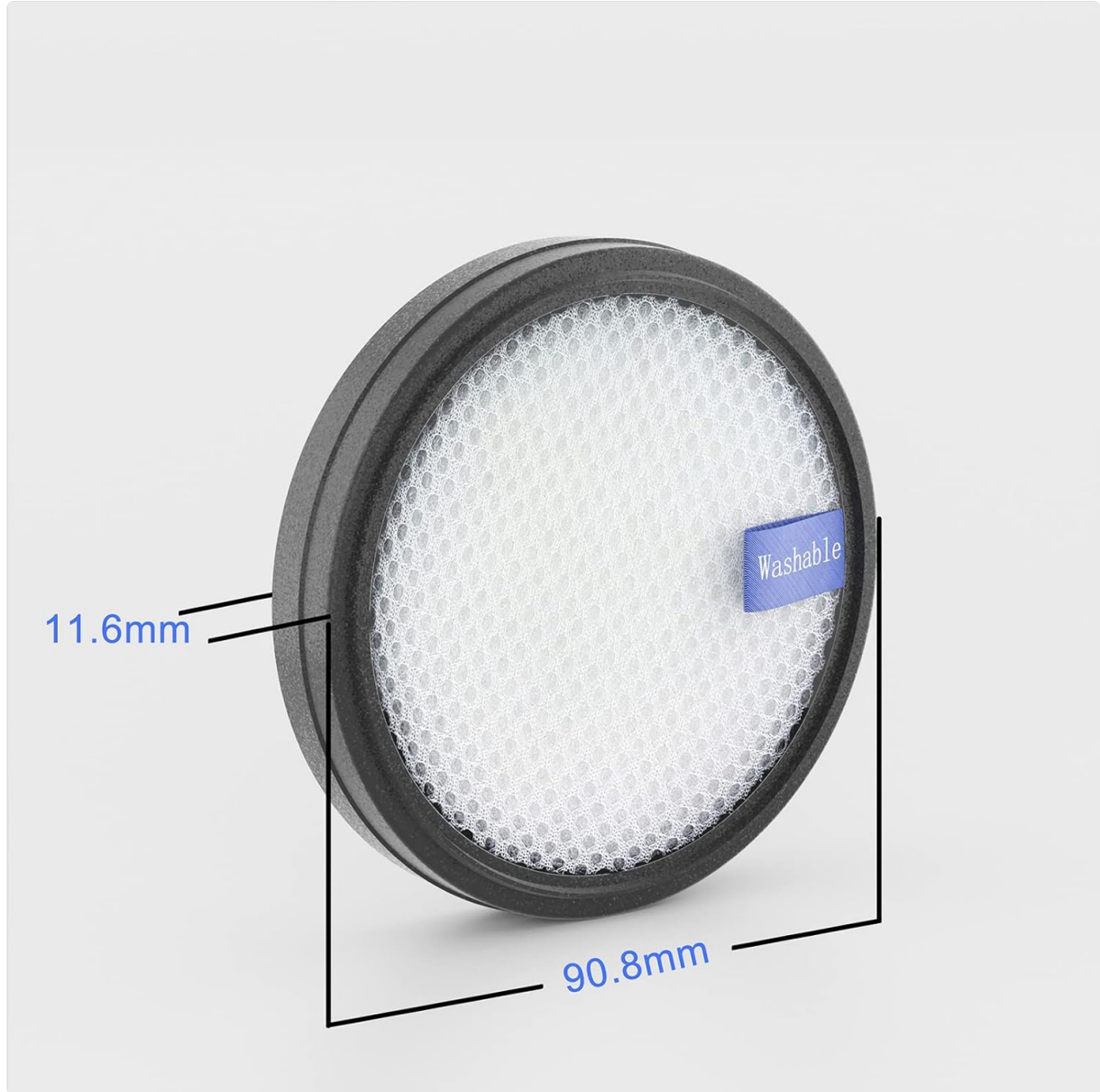


Image: The filter with its approximate dimensions (90.8mm diameter, 11.6mm thickness) indicated.
