Your guide to installation, operation, and maintenance.

1. Introduction

The Hunter Universal Receiver 3 Speed (Model 99814) is designed to add remote control functionality to your ceiling fan. This receiver is compatible with most major brands of pull chain ceiling fans and works seamlessly with Hunter's Handheld Control (99813) or Wall Control (99815), sold separately. It enables convenient adjustment of fan speed (low, medium, high) and light dimming (requires dimmable bulbs).

This receiver can be installed and used in both indoor and covered outdoor ceiling fan applications. It offers a control range of up to 75 feet, providing flexibility in operation.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening the package, verify that all components are present:

- 1 x Hunter Universal Receiver (Model 99814)
- 5 x Wire Caps

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the Hunter Universal Receiver involves electrical wiring and should only be performed by a qualified electrician or an individual with a thorough understanding of electrical systems. Always ensure power is disconnected at the circuit breaker before beginning any installation work.

3.1. Pre-Installation Checks

- Ensure the ceiling fan is compatible with a universal receiver.
- Confirm that the receiver's dimensions (approximately 5.87 x 3.86 x 2.32 inches) will fit within the fan's canopy.
- Have the necessary tools ready (e.g., screwdriver, wire strippers, electrical tape).




Image: A side view of the Hunter Universal Receiver with measurements indicating its height (4.5 inches) and width (2.1 inches).

3.2. Wiring Instructions

Detailed wiring diagrams and step-by-step instructions are typically provided in the comprehensive user manual available for download from the manufacturer's website or included with the product. It is crucial to follow these specific instructions for safe and correct installation.

In general, the receiver will connect between the household wiring and the ceiling fan motor and light kit. The included wire caps are used to secure electrical connections. Ensure all connections are tight and properly insulated.

3.3. Pairing with Remote Control

After installation, the receiver must be paired with a compatible Hunter Universal Wall Control (99815) or Handheld Control (99813). Refer to the instructions provided with your specific remote control for the pairing procedure. This typically involves a sequence of power cycling and button presses to establish communication between the remote and the receiver.

4. OPERATING THE RECEIVER

Once installed and paired, the receiver allows you to control your ceiling fan and light using the paired remote control. The functions typically include:

- Fan Speed Control: Adjust the fan speed to low, medium, or high settings.
- Light Control: Turn the light on/off. If dimmable bulbs are installed, the remote will also allow dimming functionality.

The receiver is designed to operate reliably within a range of up to 75 feet from the paired remote control.

5. MAINTENANCE

The Hunter Universal Receiver is designed for long-term, maintenance-free operation. No user-serviceable parts are inside. To ensure optimal performance and longevity:

- · Keep the receiver dry and away from excessive moisture.
- Do not expose the receiver to extreme temperatures.
- Avoid physical damage or impact to the unit.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the receiver if installed in a confined space.

For cleaning, gently wipe the exterior with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Hunter Universal Receiver, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

• No Response from Remote:

- Ensure the remote control has fresh batteries.
- Verify that the receiver is properly powered (check circuit breaker).
- Attempt to re-pair the remote control with the receiver according to your remote's instructions.
- Check all electrical connections to the receiver for tightness and proper insulation.

• Intermittent Operation:

- Ensure the remote control is within the 75-foot operating range.
- Check for potential interference from other electronic devices.
- Verify stable power supply to the fan and receiver.

• Fan or Light Not Functioning:

- Confirm that the fan and light themselves are in working order (e.g., test with pull chains if applicable, check light bulbs).
- Re-check all wiring connections to ensure they match the installation diagram.
