# X-PRO X9 125cc Dirt Bike Instruction Manual

Model: DB-K01

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your X-PRO X9 125cc Dirt Bike. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the vehicle to ensure proper use and to prevent injury or damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING: Operating this dirt bike can be dangerous. Always wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, eye protection, gloves, and protective clothing. Read and understand all warnings and instructions before use.**

- Always wear a DOT-approved helmet, eye protection, and protective clothing.
- Never operate the dirt bike under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Perform pre-ride inspections before each use.
- Do not carry passengers. This dirt bike is designed for a single rider.
- Operate only on designated off-road areas.
- Keep hands and feet away from moving parts.
- This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm (Proposition 65 warning).

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon unpacking, verify that all components are present:

- X-PRO X9 125cc Dirt Bike (main unit)
- Handlebar
- Front Wheel
- Front Fender
- Number Plate
- Brake components (if not pre-assembled)

- Tool Kit (may vary)
- Instruction Manual

## 4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Some assembly is required for the X-PRO X9 125cc Dirt Bike. If you lack mechanical experience, seek assistance from a qualified technician or an experienced individual. Refer to any available assembly videos for visual guidance.

### 4.1 General Assembly Steps

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the dirt bike and all components from its packaging. Inspect for any shipping damage.
2. **Handlebar Installation:** Attach the handlebar to the triple clamps using the provided handlebar brackets. Ensure all bolts are tightened securely to specifications.
3. **Front Wheel Installation:** Install the front wheel, ensuring the brake rotor aligns correctly with the caliper. Secure the axle nut.
4. **Brake System:** Connect and adjust the brake system. Ensure proper function and fluid levels (if hydraulic).
5. **Fender and Number Plate:** Mount the front fender and number plate.
6. **Final Checks:** Double-check all fasteners for tightness. Ensure cables and hoses are routed correctly and not pinched.

## 5. PRE-RIDE CHECKS

Before each ride, perform the following checks:

- **Tire Pressure:** Ensure tires are inflated to the recommended 20 PSI.
- **Fuel Level:** Check fuel level. Use premium gasoline (91 octane or higher) and avoid fuel containing ethanol, as it can damage the engine.
- **Oil Level:** Verify engine oil is at the correct level.
- **Brakes:** Test front and rear brakes for proper function and responsiveness.
- **Chain Tension:** Inspect chain for proper tension and lubrication.
- **Fasteners:** Check all nuts, bolts, and fasteners for tightness.
- **Controls:** Ensure throttle, clutch (if applicable), and shifter operate smoothly.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 6.1 Starting the Engine

1. Turn the fuel valve to the ON position.

2. Engage the choke fully (cold engine).
3. Kick-start the engine.
4. Once the engine starts, gradually disengage the choke to half, then fully off as the engine warms up. If the engine stalls, it may be due to the choke being fully closed too soon, especially at higher altitudes.
5. Allow the engine to warm up for a few minutes before riding.

## 6.2 Riding

The X-PRO X9 features a 4-speed transmission for versatile riding. Practice shifting in a safe, open area before attempting challenging terrain. The 17-inch front and 14-inch rear wheels are designed to adapt to various terrains, providing increased ground clearance and improved traction.

## 7. MAINTENANCE


Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your dirt bike.

### 7.1 Engine Oil Changes

- **Initial Oil Change:** Change the engine oil after the first hour of use or first ride. This removes manufacturing debris.
- **Recommended Oil:** Use full synthetic 10W-40 motorcycle oil. For the first few changes, petroleum-based oil is recommended before switching to synthetic.
- **Regular Changes:** Refer to the maintenance schedule in the full owner's manual for subsequent oil change intervals.

## 7.2 General Maintenance Schedule

- **Chain:** Clean, lubricate, and adjust chain tension regularly.
- **Brakes:** Inspect brake pads, discs, and fluid levels (if hydraulic). Adjust as needed.
- **Air Filter:** Clean or replace the air filter periodically, especially when riding in dusty conditions.
- **Spark Plug:** Inspect and clean or replace the spark plug as needed.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check and tighten all nuts and bolts.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your X-PRO X9 dirt bike, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **Engine Not Starting:**

- Check fuel level and ensure the fuel valve is open.
- Verify the choke is set correctly for a cold start.
- Inspect the spark plug for fouling or damage.
- Ensure the kill switch is in the RUN position.

- **Engine Running Poorly:**

- Check for proper fuel type (premium, no ethanol).
- Inspect the air filter for blockage.
- A carburetor issue may require professional adjustment or replacement.

- **Brake Issues:**

- Check brake pad wear.
- Inspect brake fluid level (if hydraulic) and check for leaks.
- Ensure brake cables are properly adjusted.

For persistent issues, contact X-PRO customer support or a qualified mechanic.




Figure 9.1: Illustration of the X-PRO X9's cradle type steel tube frame, emphasizing its strength and durability.
