Hupro Premium Humidifier Model 777 User Manual

Your guide to optimal use and care.

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Hupro Premium Humidifier Model 777. This device is designed to enhance the air quality in your home or bedroom by maintaining optimal humidity levels. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the humidifier to ensure safe and efficient use.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always place the humidifier on a firm, flat, water-resistant surface.
- Do not place the humidifier near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Keep the humidifier out of reach of children and pets.
- Unplug the humidifier before filling, cleaning, or moving it.
- Do not immerse the base unit in water or other liquids.
- Use only clean, cool tap water. Distilled or demineralized water is recommended to prevent mineral buildup.
- Do not add essential oils directly into the water tank. Use the designated aroma box if available.
- Ensure the power cord is not damaged or pinched.
- If the unit emits unusual sounds, smells, or smoke, unplug it immediately and contact customer support.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your Hupro Premium Humidifier Model 777.

Main Unit Features:

- **Water Tank:** Holds water for humidification.
- **Base Unit:** Contains the ultrasonic transducer and electronic components.
- **Mist Nozzle:** Directs the mist output.
- **Control Panel:** Digital display with touch controls for various functions.
- **Aroma Box:** Small compartment for adding essential oils (located at the base).

Remote Control:

- **ON/OFF:** Powers the unit on or off.
- **MIST LEVEL:** Adjusts the mist output intensity.
- **HUMIDITY%:** Sets the desired humidity level.
- **TIMER:** Sets the operating duration.

- **WARM/ANION:** Activates warm mist or anion function.
- **AUTO:** Engages automatic humidity control.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials from the box. Ensure all components are present.
2. **Remove Internal Packaging: Important:** Open the unit and remove any internal styrofoam spacers or protective materials from inside the water tank and base. Failure to do so will prevent proper operation.
3. **Placement:** Place the humidifier on a flat, stable, and water-resistant surface at least 6 inches away from walls and furniture.
4. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the top cover. Fill the water tank with clean, cool tap water. Do not exceed the maximum fill line. Replace the top cover securely.
5. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet. The unit will enter standby mode.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off:

- Press the **ON/OFF** button on the control panel or remote control to turn the humidifier on or off. The digital display will illuminate.

Adjusting Mist Level:

- Press the **MIST LEVEL** button (on remote) or the **HUMIDITY/°C** button (on control panel, usually cycles through mist levels with repeated presses) to cycle through the 5 available mist intensity settings. The mist level indicator on the display will change.

Setting Desired Humidity:

- Press the **HUMIDITY%** button (on remote) or the **HUMIDITY/°C** button (on control panel, after cycling through mist levels) to set your desired humidity level. The unit will automatically adjust its output to maintain this level.

Warm Mist / Anion Function:

- Press the **WARM/ANION** button to activate or deactivate the warm mist function or the anion function, depending on the model's specific capabilities.

Timer Function:

- Press the **TIMER** button to set the desired operating time (e.g., 1-12 hours). The humidifier will automatically turn off once the set time has elapsed.

Auto Mode:

- Press the **AUTO** button (on remote) to enable automatic humidity control. In this mode, the humidifier will automatically adjust its mist output to maintain a comfortable humidity level based on the ambient conditions.

Using the Aroma Box:

- Locate the small aroma box at the base of the unit.
- Pull out the tray and add a few drops of your preferred essential oil onto the aroma pad.

- Slide the tray back into place. The humidifier will diffuse the scent along with the mist.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning is essential for optimal performance and hygiene.

Daily Maintenance:

- Empty and rinse the water tank daily.
- Wipe the inside of the water tank and the base unit with a clean, dry cloth.
- Ensure no water collects under the bucket, as this can prevent the unit from working.

Weekly Cleaning:

- **Unplug the unit** before cleaning.
- **Descaling the Water Tank:** Fill the tank with a mixture of equal parts white vinegar and water. Let it sit for 30 minutes, then rinse thoroughly.
- **Cleaning the Transducer:** Use the provided cleaning brush to gently clean the ultrasonic transducer (the small metal disc in the base unit). Do not scrub aggressively.
- **Cleaning the Aroma Box:** Remove the aroma pad and rinse it with water. Allow it to air dry before reinserting.
- Wipe all exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.

Storage:

- Before storing, ensure the unit is completely dry.
- Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No mist output	No water in tank; Unit not properly assembled; Transducer dirty; Internal styrofoam not removed.	Refill water tank; Ensure tank is correctly seated; Clean transducer; Verify all internal packaging is removed.
Unusual noise	Water level too low; Unit not on a flat surface; Foreign object in base.	Refill water tank; Place on a stable surface; Check for and remove any obstructions.
White dust around unit	Hard water used.	Use distilled or demineralized water. Clean unit regularly.
Error Code (e.g., "EF")	Specific malfunction or sensor issue.	Refer to the specific error code section in your printed manual if available, or contact Hupro customer support for assistance.
Unit shuts off unexpectedly	Water tank empty; Desired humidity reached; Timer expired.	Refill water tank; Adjust desired humidity or timer settings.
