## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Alpswolf LED Lantern Camping Flashlight. This versatile and durable device is designed to provide reliable illumination in various outdoor and emergency situations. With its multiple lighting modes, rechargeable battery, and robust construction, it is an essential tool for camping, hiking, power outages, and more. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and maintenance of your new lantern.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- Do not look directly into the LED light when it is on, as it may cause temporary vision impairment.
- Keep the device away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the lantern, as this may void the warranty and pose a safety risk.
- Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed when not charging to maintain water resistance.
- Keep out of reach of children.

- USB-A to USB-C Charging Cable (1 unit)
- User Manual (this document)

Note: Batteries are included and integrated into the device.

## 4. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Alpswolf LED Lantern Camping Flashlight is packed with features to enhance your outdoor and emergency experiences:

- **Ultra Bright and Versatile Lighting:** Offers up to 1000 lumens and 360° illumination. Features 6 lighting modes, including a red emergency light, making it ideal for camping, power outages, or emergencies.
- **USB Rechargeable with Power Bank Function:** Equipped with a 4000mAh battery, this lantern can charge your phones, radios, or GPS devices on the go, ensuring you stay connected.
- **IPX4 Waterproof and Drop Resistant:** Constructed from shock-resistant material with an IPX4 waterproof rating, it can withstand heavy rain, wind, and accidental drops, handling outdoor challenges with ease.
- **Portable and Lightweight:** Weighing only 0.8 lbs (per piece) and with a compact size of 6.93 x 3.15 inches, it is easy to pack, carry, or stash in a backpack.
- **Two-Way Hanging Hooks:** Features a handle and two-way hook for easy hanging on backpacks, tents, tree branches, or car roofs, freeing your hands. It can also be hung high for emergency signaling.

## 5. SETUP

Your Alpswolf LED Lantern Camping Flashlight comes ready to use with an integrated rechargeable battery. Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the device.

### 5.1 Initial Charging

1. Locate the charging port cover on the side of the lantern.
2. Gently lift the rubber cover to expose the USB charging ports.
3. Connect the provided USB-A to USB-C cable to the lantern's USB-C input port.
4. Plug the USB-A end of the cable into a compatible USB power source (e.g., wall adapter, power bank, computer USB port).
5. The indicator lights will show the charging status. A full charge typically takes about 4 hours.
6. Once fully charged, disconnect the cable and securely close the rubber cover to maintain water

resistance.

*Note: A USB-C to USB-C cable will not be recognized by the AlpsWolf device for charging. Please use a USB-A to USB-C cable.*

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The AlpsWolf LED Lantern features a single button for easy operation and cycling through its various lighting modes.

### 6.1 Power On/Off and Mode Selection

1. **To Turn On:** Press the power button once. The lantern will typically start in its brightest flashlight mode.
2. **To Cycle Modes:** Press the power button repeatedly to cycle through the 6 available lighting modes:
  - Flashlight High
  - Flashlight Low

- Lantern High (360° illumination)
- Lantern Low (360° illumination)
- Red Light (steady)
- Red Flash Light (emergency signal)

3. **To Turn Off:** Hold the power button down for approximately 2-3 seconds. This allows you to turn off the device directly without cycling through all modes.

## 6.2 Using as a Power Bank

1. Open the rubber cover to expose the USB ports.
2. Connect your device's charging cable to the USB-A output port on the lantern.
3. The lantern will begin charging your device.
4. Monitor your device's charging status. Disconnect when charging is complete.
5. Securely close the rubber cover after use.

## 6.3 Hanging the Lantern

The lantern features a sturdy handle and a two-way hook for convenient hanging:

- Use the integrated handle for easy carrying or to hang from a small hook.
- Extend the metal hook from the top of the lantern to hang it from tent loops, tree branches, or backpack straps.

## 7. CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

---

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your Alpswolf LED Lantern, follow these charging guidelines:

- Always use the provided USB-A to USB-C charging cable.
- Charge the lantern fully before long periods of storage.
- Avoid overcharging by disconnecting the charger once the battery indicator shows full.
- The 4000mAh battery provides several hours of light depending on the mode used (typically 3-6 hours).

## 8. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Alpswolf LED Lantern:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the lantern with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the lantern in a cool, dry place when not in use. If storing for extended periods, charge the battery every 3-6 months to maintain battery health.
- **Water Resistance:** Always ensure the rubber cover for the charging ports is fully sealed to maintain IPX4 water resistance.

## 9. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lantern does not turn on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the lantern fully using the provided USB-A to USB-C cable.
Device not charging from lantern (power bank function).	Lantern battery is low or depleted.	Ensure the lantern is sufficiently charged.
Lantern not charging.	Incorrect charging cable used (USB-C to USB-C).	Use the provided USB-A to USB-C cable.
Light modes are not cycling correctly.	Button not pressed firmly or quickly enough.	Press the power button firmly and release quickly to cycle. Hold for 2-3 seconds to turn off.
