## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Huffy Ford F150 Platinum 6V Kids Ride-On Truck, Model 17581. This ride-on vehicle is designed for children aged 3-7 years, with a maximum weight capacity of 65 lbs. It features LED headlights, engine sounds, a maximum speed of 2.5 MPH, and forward/reverse driving capabilities. The vehicle is equipped with durable tires for various surfaces and includes a 6V battery with a wall charger. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and operation to ensure safe and correct use.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always supervise children during operation.
- Ensure the child wears a helmet and appropriate safety gear.
- Do not operate near streets, cars, steep inclines, swimming pools, or other bodies of water.
- Operate only on flat, dry surfaces.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 65 lbs.
- Regularly inspect the vehicle for damage or loose parts before each use.
- Only use the provided charger and battery.

### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 6V Battery Charger
- Instruction Manual

### 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Huffy Ford F150 Ride-On Truck. Refer to the included physical product manual for detailed diagrams and specific part identification.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, flat surface.
2. **Wheel Assembly:** Attach the wheels according to the instructions in the physical manual, ensuring all fasteners are securely tightened.
3. **Steering Wheel Installation:** Connect the steering column and attach the steering wheel. Ensure it is properly aligned and secured.
4. **Seat Installation:** Secure the seat to the vehicle frame.
5. **Battery Connection:** Connect the battery terminals as indicated in the manual. Ensure a secure connection.
6. **Initial Charge:** Before first use, fully charge the 6V battery for the recommended duration (typically 8-12 hours). Refer to the charging section for details.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Controls Overview

- **Power Button:** Located on the dashboard. Press to turn the vehicle ON/OFF.
- **Forward/Reverse Switch:** Located on the dashboard. Toggle to select forward or reverse driving mode.
- **Accelerator Pedal:** Press the foot pedal to move the vehicle. Release to brake.
- **Steering Wheel:** Turn left or right to steer the vehicle.
- **Horn/Engine Sounds:** Buttons on the steering wheel activate horn and engine sounds.
- **LED Headlights:** The vehicle features working LED headlights that illuminate during operation.

### 5.2. Driving the Vehicle

1. Ensure the battery is fully charged.
2. Have the child sit securely in the seat.

3. Press the power button to turn on the vehicle.
4. Select the desired direction (Forward or Reverse) using the switch.
5. Press the accelerator pedal to begin moving. The vehicle has a maximum speed of 2.5 MPH.
6. Release the accelerator pedal to stop.

### 5.3. Special Features

- **Functional Tailgate:** The rear tailgate can be opened and closed, providing a usable truck bed for carrying small items.
- **Opening Doors:** The vehicle features opening and closing doors for realistic entry and exit.




Figure 5.2: The rear of the ride-on truck with its tailgate lowered, revealing a textured truck bed.

### 5.4. Charging the Battery

- Locate the charging port on the vehicle.
- Plug the provided 6V wall charger into a standard electrical outlet.
- Connect the charger to the vehicle's charging port.
- Charge the battery for 8-12 hours for a full charge. Do not overcharge.
- Disconnect the charger once charging is complete.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1. General Care

- Clean the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Store the vehicle in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery fully every 3 months to prolong its lifespan.

### 6.2. Battery Care

- Always use the charger supplied with the vehicle.
- Do not allow the battery to completely drain before recharging.
- Keep the battery and charger away from water and extreme temperatures.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem                            | Possible Cause  | Solution                                    |
|------------------------------------|---|---|
| Vehicle does not move.             | Battery is low or dead.                                 | Charge the battery fully.                   |
|                                    | Battery connection is loose.                            | Check and secure battery terminals.         |
|                                    | Forward/Reverse switch is in neutral or wrong position. | Ensure switch is set to Forward or Reverse. |
| Vehicle moves slowly.              | Battery is low.   | Charge the battery fully.                   |
|                                    | Overloaded vehicle.                                     | Reduce weight to below 65 lbs.              |
| Charger light does not illuminate. | Charger not properly plugged in.                        | Check wall outlet and charger connection.   |
|                                    | Faulty charger or battery.                              | Contact customer support for replacement.   |





