

INITIAL SETUP AND FAMILIARIZATION

Vehicle Overview

Familiarize yourself with the interior and exterior components of your Blazer. This includes the dashboard layout, control panel, seating adjustments, and exterior lighting. Understanding the location and function of these elements is crucial for safe and efficient operation.

Key Fob and Door Locks

- **Lock/Unlock:** Press the lock or unlock button on the key fob to secure or open the vehicle doors.

- **Braking:** Apply steady pressure to the brake pedal for smooth deceleration. Use the parking brake when parked on inclines.
- **Transmission:** Select the appropriate gear (P, R, N, D, L) using the gear selector. Refer to the manual for specific driving modes.

Infotainment System

Your Blazer is equipped with an infotainment system for audio, communication, and navigation. Use the touchscreen or steering wheel controls to access features such as radio, Bluetooth connectivity, and available navigation services. Consult the dedicated infotainment manual for detailed instructions.

Climate Control

Adjust the temperature, fan speed, and air distribution using the climate control panel. The system can be set to automatic mode for optimal comfort or manually adjusted as desired. Ensure vents are clear of obstructions for efficient operation.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Scheduled Maintenance

Adhering to the recommended maintenance schedule is vital for your vehicle's performance and safety. Refer to the maintenance schedule section in this manual for service intervals for oil changes, tire rotations, and other inspections.

Fluid Checks

- **Engine Oil:** Check oil level regularly using the dipstick. Add recommended oil type if low.
- **Coolant:** Ensure coolant level is between MIN and MAX marks when the engine is cool.
- **Brake Fluid:** Verify brake fluid level is within the specified range. Low levels may indicate a problem.

- **Windshield Washer Fluid:** Keep the reservoir filled for clear visibility.

Tire Care

Maintain correct tire pressure as specified on the tire placard located on the driver's side door jamb. Rotate tires according to the maintenance schedule to ensure even wear and extend tire life. Inspect tires regularly for damage or excessive wear.

Cleaning Your Vehicle

Regular cleaning, both interior and exterior, helps preserve your vehicle's appearance and value. Use appropriate cleaning products for different surfaces. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage finishes.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Warning Lights

If a warning light illuminates on your dashboard, consult this manual immediately to understand its meaning and recommended action. Some lights may indicate a minor issue, while others require immediate attention from a qualified service technician.

Engine Not Starting

- **Battery:** Check battery terminals for corrosion and ensure connections are secure. A weak battery may require a jump start.
- **Fuel:** Verify there is sufficient fuel in the tank.
- **Immobilizer:** Ensure the correct key fob is present in the vehicle.

Flat Tire

If you experience a flat tire, safely pull over to a level area away from traffic. Refer to the manual for instructions on using the spare tire or tire repair kit, if equipped. Contact roadside assistance if you are unable to change the tire yourself.
