1. INTRODUCTION

This open-ear headset is designed to provide a comfortable and safe audio experience, allowing you to stay aware of your surroundings while enjoying clear sound. Featuring Bluetooth 5.3 connectivity and an ENC noise-cancelling boom microphone, it is ideal for various applications including office work, business calls, driving, and online learning.

2. SETUP

2.1 Package Contents

Upon opening the package, please ensure all items are present:

- TOHUNZO BH628 Wireless Bone Conduction Headphones
- Charging Cable (USB)
- User Manual (this document)

2.2 Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours.

1. Connect the charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end of the charging cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB

wall adapter).

3. The indicator light will show the charging status. It will typically turn off or change color once fully charged.

LONG BATTERY LIFE

Thanks to the 500mAh built-in battery, the earphones can be fully charged in 2 hours and last for 6-10 hours




Image 2.1: Charging and Battery Life.

2.3 Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your headphones to a device (smartphone, tablet, computer):

1. Ensure the headphones are charged and powered off.
2. Press and hold the power button until the indicator light flashes, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "TOHUNZO BH628" from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the indicator light on the headphones will stop flashing or change to a steady light.

The headphones utilize Bluetooth 5.3 technology for a stable connection up to 15 meters (49 feet).

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the power button for approximately 3 seconds until you hear a power-on prompt.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the power button for approximately 5 seconds until you hear a power-off prompt.

3.2 Basic Controls

The headphones feature touch controls for various functions:

- **Play/Pause:** Single tap the multi-function button.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Use the dedicated volume buttons (if present) or control via your connected device.
- **Next Track:** Double tap the multi-function button.
- **Previous Track:** Triple tap the multi-function button.
- **Answer/End Call:** Single tap the multi-function button during an incoming call or active call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the multi-function button for 2 seconds during an incoming call.
- **Activate Voice Assistant (Siri/Google Assistant):** Quickly tap the function key twice.

3.3 Microphone Usage

The TOHUNZO BH628 features a dual microphone system with an adjustable boom microphone and ENC (Environmental Noise Cancelling) technology for clear conversations.

- Position the boom microphone close to your mouth for optimal voice pickup.
- The ENC technology actively reduces background noise, ensuring your voice is heard clearly even in loud environments.

3.4 Wearing the Headphones

The open-ear, bone conduction design provides a comfortable and painless wearing experience, even for extended periods.

- Place the headphones so the bone conduction transducers rest on your cheekbones, just in front of your ears.
- The flexible band should wrap around the back of your head.
- The lightweight design (approximately 1.35 oz / 38g) and ergonomic fit ensure comfort, even when wearing glasses.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Ensure the charging port is dry before charging.

4.2 Storage

- Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the headphones.

4.3 Water Resistance

The TOHUNZO BH628 headphones are waterproof. While they can withstand splashes and sweat, avoid prolonged submersion in water to ensure longevity.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TOHUNZO BH628 headphones, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; device too far.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing indicator). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Move device closer to headphones (within 15 meters). Forget previous pairings on your device and try again.
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low on headphones or device; not connected properly.	Increase volume on both headphones and connected device. Reconnect Bluetooth.
Poor call quality.	Microphone not positioned correctly; excessive background noise.	Adjust the boom microphone closer to your mouth. Ensure ENC is active. Move to a quieter environment if possible.


