INTRODUCTION

The Smith & Wesson Calibrator Watch (Model SWW877BL-BRK) is a precision quartz timepiece designed for an active lifestyle. It features a durable construction with a stainless steel case back, a scratch-resistant hardened mineral glass crystal, and a comfortable black rubber strap with blue stitching. This watch is built to offer reliability and a bold, sophisticated look, suitable for various outdoor activities.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Precision Quartz Movement:** Ensures accurate timekeeping.
- **Durable Construction:** Stainless steel case back for enhanced longevity.
- **Scratch-Resistant Crystal:** Hardened mineral glass protects the watch dial.
- **Water Resistance:** Rated up to 50 meters (164 feet), suitable for showers, swimming, fishing, and water sports. *Note: Not suitable for diving.*
- **Comfortable Strap:** Black rubber strap with blue stitching for a secure and stylish fit.
- **Day Display:** Integrated day of the week sub-dial.

SETUP AND INITIAL USE

Setting the Time and Day

1. **Pull out the Crown:** Gently pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) to the first click position to set the day, or to the second click position to set the time.
2. **Set the Time:** Rotate the crown to move the hour and minute hands clockwise until the desired time is displayed. Ensure to account for AM/PM if setting the day as well.
3. **Set the Day:** The watch features a day display. Rotate the crown to adjust the day of the week.
4. **Push in the Crown:** Once the time and day are set, push the crown back into its normal operating position. The watch will begin to run.

OPERATING THE WATCH

The Smith & Wesson Calibrator Watch operates as a standard analog quartz watch. Its primary function is accurate timekeeping. The sub-dials provide additional information, including the day of the week.

Water Resistance Guidelines

This watch is water resistant up to 50 meters (5 ATM). This rating means it is suitable for everyday use and can

withstand splashes, rain, showering, swimming, and fishing. However, it is not designed for high-impact water sports or diving. Avoid operating the crown or pushers when the watch is wet or submerged to prevent water ingress.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and strap regularly with a soft, damp cloth. For the rubber strap, mild soap and water can be used, then rinse thoroughly and dry. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Replacement:** The watch uses 1 CR2 battery. When the watch stops running, it indicates the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Water Resistance Check:** If the watch is frequently exposed to water, it is advisable to have its water resistance seals checked periodically by a professional.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not running	Dead battery	Replace battery (professional service recommended).
Time is incorrect	Crown pulled out; Time not set correctly	Push crown in fully; Re-set time as per "Setup" section.
Condensation under crystal	Water ingress; Extreme temperature change	Immediately take to a professional watch repair service. Do not attempt to dry it yourself.
Strap discomfort	Strap too tight/loose; Skin irritation	Adjust strap for comfortable fit; Clean strap thoroughly; Consult a doctor if irritation persists.
