- No external console required
- 300 video games built-in
- 2.5-inch color display with LED illuminated buttons
- 3.5mm headphone port for private listening (headphones not included)

- Powered by 3 AAA batteries (not included)
- Compact and portable design, ideal for travel

SETUP

1. Installing Batteries

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the Go Gamer Classic.

2. Using a small Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 3 AAA batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and secure it with the screw.

2. Powering On/Off

- To power on the device, slide the power switch located on the top edge to the 'ON' position.
- To power off, slide the power switch to the 'OFF' position.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Game Selection

- Once powered on, the device will display a list of available games.
- Use the **D-pad** (directional pad) to navigate through the game list.
- Press the **START** button to select and begin playing a game.

2. In-Game Controls

- Use the **D-pad** for movement or direction.
- Use the **A** and **B** buttons for actions specific to each game (e.g., jump, shoot, confirm).
- Press the **RESET** button to return to the main game selection menu.

3. Volume Control

- A volume control switch is located on the side of the device.
- Slide the switch to adjust the sound level or mute it completely.

4. Headphone Use

- Plug standard 3.5mm headphones (not included) into the headphone port on the top edge of the device for private audio.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the console. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place when not in use. Remove batteries if storing for extended periods to prevent leakage.
- **Battery Care:** Replace all batteries at the same time. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Device does not power on:** Ensure batteries are correctly installed and are not depleted. Replace with fresh AAA batteries if necessary.
- **No sound:** Check the volume control switch on the side of the device. Ensure it is not set to the lowest position or muted.
- **Screen is blank or frozen:** Try turning the device off and then on again. If the issue persists, remove and reinsert the batteries.
- **Game not responding:** Press the **RESET** button to return to the game selection menu and choose another game.
