Gevril West Village Automatic Watch Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on your purchase of the Gevril West Village Automatic Watch. This timepiece combines classic design with Swiss precision, featuring a Sellita SW200 automatic movement. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your watch to ensure its longevity and accurate performance.

SETUP

Initial Winding

Your Gevri West Village watch is equipped with a Swiss automatic movement. It is powered by the motion of your wrist. If the watch has stopped or has not been worn for an extended period, it may require manual winding to initiate operation.

1. Ensure the crown is in position 1 (fully pushed in).
2. Turn the crown clockwise approximately 30-40 times. This will build up a power reserve to start the watch.
3. The second hand should begin to move smoothly.

Setting the Time and Date

The crown on the side of the watch is used to set both the time and date.

1. **Position 1 (Normal Operating Position):** Crown fully pushed in.
2. **Position 2 (Date Setting Position):** Gently pull the crown out one click. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement.
3. **Position 3 (Time Setting Position):** Pull the crown out a second click. The second hand will stop. Turn the crown to set the hour and minute hands. To ensure accurate time setting, synchronize with a reliable time source. Push the crown back to Position 1 once the time is set.

Important: Always push the crown back to Position 1 after setting to maintain water resistance.

OPERATING YOUR AUTOMATIC WATCH

Your Gevril West Village watch is powered by a Swiss Sellita SW200 automatic movement. This means it does not require a battery. The movement is self-winding, relying on the natural motion of your wrist to keep it wound. When fully wound, the watch has a power reserve that allows it to continue running for a period even when not worn.

Power Reserve

A typical power reserve for this movement is approximately 38 hours. If the watch is not worn for more than this period, it will stop. To restart it, either manually wind it as described in the "Initial Winding" section or wear it for several hours to allow the automatic rotor to wind the mainspring.

Exhibition Case Back

The watch features an exhibition case back, allowing you to view the intricate workings of the Swiss automatic movement. This transparent back is sealed to maintain water resistance.

MAINTENANCE

Water Resistance

Your Gevri West Village watch is water resistant to 100 meters (10 ATM / 300 feet). This rating makes it suitable for swimming and snorkeling, but not for diving. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in to maintain water resistance. Do not operate the crown while the watch is submerged in water.

- Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperature changes.
- After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch with fresh water and dry it thoroughly with a soft cloth.

Cleaning and Care

To maintain the appearance of your watch:

- Wipe the case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth.
- For the genuine Italian leather strap, avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals, as these can cause damage or discoloration.
- Periodically check the strap for wear and tear.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Gevri West Village watch, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Watch has stopped:**

As an automatic watch, it requires motion to stay wound. If it has stopped, manually wind it by turning the crown clockwise 30-40 times while in Position 1. Alternatively, wear the watch for several hours to allow the automatic rotor to wind it.

- **Date not changing or changing at the wrong time:**

Ensure the time is set correctly for AM/PM. The date typically changes around midnight. If it changes at noon, you need to advance the time by 12 hours. Avoid setting the date manually between 9 PM and 3 AM to prevent damage to the date mechanism.

- **Water inside the watch:**

If moisture appears inside the watch, immediately take it to an authorized service center. This indicates a breach in water resistance, which can lead to significant damage to the movement.

- **Watch running too fast or too slow:**

Automatic movements can be affected by magnetism or physical shocks. If your watch's accuracy deviates significantly, it may require demagnetization or regulation by a professional watchmaker.
