INTRODUCTION

3. **Attach Tabletop:** Place your chosen tabletop onto the assembled frame. Secure the tabletop to the frame using the provided mounting hardware. Ensure the tabletop is centered and stable.
4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cable into the control box, and then plug the control box into a standard electrical outlet. Ensure the cable is routed safely to avoid tripping hazards.
5. **Adjust Feet:** Level the desk by adjusting the plastic feet at the bottom of the stand. This ensures stability and prevents wobbling.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Desk does not move.	Power cable disconnected, motor overload, control panel issue.	Check power connections. Unplug and replug the power cord. Reduce load if overloaded. Contact support if problem persists.
Anti-collision system triggers frequently.	Obstruction, sensitive setting.	Ensure no objects are in the path of the desk. Refer to control panel manual for sensitivity adjustment (if available).
Unusual noise during operation.	Loose components, motor issue.	Check all screws and bolts for tightness. Ensure the desk is level. If noise persists, contact customer support.
Desk wobbles.	Uneven floor, loose connections.	Adjust the leveling feet at the bottom of the stand. Ensure all frame connections are tight.
