2.2 App Installation and Bluetooth Connection

- 1. Download the "Marklife" app from the Google Play Store (for Android) or the Apple App Store (for iOS).
- 2. Ensure your phone's Bluetooth is turned on.
- 3. Open the "Marklife" app. **Important:** Connect to the label maker via the app, not directly through your phone's Bluetooth settings.
- 4. Within the app, navigate to the connection interface and select the P12 model (default name is P12) to establish a Bluetooth connection.



3. OPERATION

3.1 Loading Label Paper

The P12 Label Maker supports various sizes of thermal label paper, including continuous and pre-cut labels. To load paper:

- 1. Open the label compartment cover.
- 2. Insert the label roll with the printing surface facing up, ensuring it feeds smoothly through the printer mechanism.
- 3. Close the cover securely.




Image: The Marklife P12 Label Maker in use, demonstrating its compact size and the label editing interface on a smartphone.






Image: This image illustrates the thermal printing technology of the Marklife P12, emphasizing that no ink is required and highlighting the print head.

4.2 Cleaning and Storage

- Regularly clean the print head with a soft, lint-free cloth, slightly dampened with rubbing alcohol if necessary. Ensure the device is turned off before cleaning.
- Store the label maker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- When not in use, the P12's magnetic suction function allows it to be easily attached to metallic surfaces like refrigerators, saving space.




Image: The Marklife P12 label maker demonstrating its space-saving magnetic suction feature, attached to a refrigerator.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device won't connect via Bluetooth.	 Not connected through the app. Bluetooth not enabled on phone. Printer is off or low battery. Interference from other devices. 	 Ensure you connect within the "Marklife" app, not phone settings. Verify phone Bluetooth is on. Charge the label maker and turn it on. Restart both the label maker and your phone. Try connecting in a different location.
Labels are blank or faded.	Label paper loaded incorrectly.Print head is dirty.Using non-thermal paper.	 Ensure the thermal side of the paper is facing the print head. Clean the print head as described in the Maintenance section. Use only thermal label paper designed for the P12.
Label paper jams frequently.	Paper not loaded correctly.Debris in the paper path.	 Re-load the label paper, ensuring it is aligned properly and not creased. Inspect the paper path for any obstructions and carefully remove them.
