# Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker Machine User Manual

Model: IGLICEB26RD | Brand: Igloo

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker Machine is a compact and portable appliance designed to produce ice quickly and efficiently. It is capable of producing up to 26 pounds of ice per day, with ice ready in as little as 7 minutes per cycle. The unit features a transparent viewing window, a 2-pound ice basket, and an LED-lighted control panel for easy operation. Users can select between small and large ice cube sizes. Indicator lights notify when to add water or when the ice basket is full.

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unpacking, please ensure all components are present and undamaged:

- Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker Machine

- Ice Basket
- Ice Scoop

### 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, tape, and any protective film.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit. Maintain at least 4 inches (10 cm) of space from walls and other objects for optimized airflow.

3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker, including the water reservoir, ice basket, and ice scoop, with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the

specifications of your unit (120 Volts).

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Adding Water

Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill. Use cold water for best ice production results.

### 4.2 Powering On and Selecting Ice Size

Press the **POWER** button to turn on the unit. The ice maker will begin its cycle. To select the desired ice cube size (Small or Large), press the **SELECT** button. The corresponding indicator light (S or L) will illuminate.

## 4.3 Ice Production

The ice maker will produce 9 ice cubes per cycle, with the first batch typically ready in 7 to 15 minutes, depending on the selected size and ambient temperature. The unit can produce up to 26 pounds of ice in 24 hours.

## 4.4 Indicator Lights

- **ADD WATER:** This light illuminates when the water reservoir is low and needs refilling. The ice production will pause until water is added.
- **ICE FULL:** This light illuminates when the ice basket is full. The ice production will pause until ice is removed from the basket.

The ice maker is not a freezer. Ice will melt if left in the basket. It is recommended to transfer ice to a freezer for storage once the basket is full.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ice maker.

1. **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, drain any remaining water from the reservoir. Wipe the interior with a soft cloth.
2. **Weekly Cleaning:** For thorough cleaning, unplug the unit. Remove the ice basket. Clean the water reservoir and ice-making components with a solution of water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly. Ensure the small strainer at the bottom of the reservoir is clear of debris.
3. **Descaling:** Over time, mineral deposits may accumulate. To descale, mix a solution of water and vinegar (1:1



ratio) or a commercial descaling agent. Pour into the reservoir and run a few cycles without ice production (refer to the full manual for specific descaling instructions). Drain and rinse thoroughly with clean water multiple times.

- 4. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- 5. **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, ensure it is completely dry inside and out. Store in a cool, dry place.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; "ADD WATER" light on.	Fill water reservoir.
Ice maker not producing ice.	Ice basket is full; "ICE FULL" light on.	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice cubes are small or misshapen.	Water temperature too warm; mineral buildup.	Use colder water; perform descaling.
Unit is noisy.	Normal operation sounds (compressor, water pump).	Ensure proper ventilation; check for obstructions.
Ice melts quickly in basket.	Ice maker is not a freezer.	Transfer ice to a freezer for storage.

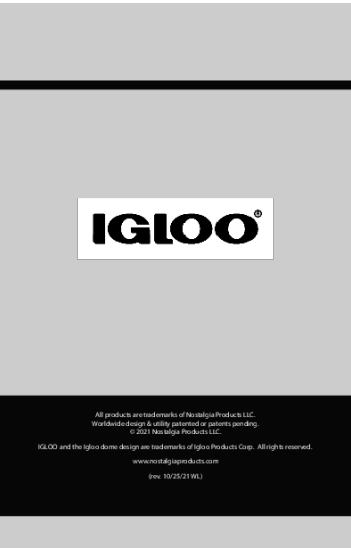
