1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Thank you for purchasing the Mitsubishi Electric MR-MZ54H-C 540L 6-Door French Door Refrigerator. This appliance is designed to provide efficient and reliable food storage with advanced features for optimal freshness. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your new refrigerator to ensure safe and proper use.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- Ensure the refrigerator is properly grounded.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Unplug the refrigerator before cleaning or performing maintenance.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

1. Remove all packaging materials, including tape and protective films.
2. Check for any damage during transit. Report any damage to your dealer immediately.

3.2 Placement

- Place the refrigerator on a firm, level floor.
- Ensure adequate clearance around the unit for proper ventilation (at least 5 cm on sides and back, 10 cm on top).
- Avoid direct sunlight or heat sources.

3.3 Power Connection

- Connect the power cord to a dedicated, grounded wall outlet.
- Do not use extension cords or adapter plugs.
- Allow the refrigerator to stand for at least 2-3 hours before plugging it in to allow refrigerants to settle.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features independent temperature controls for different compartments.

- **Refrigerator Compartment:** Typically set between 2°C and 6°C.
- **Freezer Compartment:** Typically set between -18°C and -24°C.
- Refer to the control panel on the front of the unit or inside the refrigerator for specific adjustment instructions.

4.2 Food Storage Guidelines

- **Refrigerator:** Store fresh foods, dairy, and beverages. Use crisper drawers for fruits and vegetables.
- **Freezer:** Store frozen foods. Ensure packages are sealed to prevent freezer burn.

5. MAINTENANCE

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Power cord unplugged; Temperature setting too high; Door not closed properly	Check power connection; Adjust temperature; Ensure door is fully closed
Unusual noise	Refrigerator not level; Items vibrating inside; Compressor noise (normal)	Level the unit; Rearrange items; Consult service if noise is excessive
Water on floor	Drain tube clogged; Excessive humidity; Door left open	Clear drain tube; Reduce humidity; Ensure door is closed
