3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 System Requirements

- Operating System: Windows XP/Vista/7/8/10/11, macOS, Linux
- Available USB-A Port

3.2 Connecting the Keyboard

1. Locate the USB-C port on the back of the T-TGK321 keyboard.
2. Connect the smaller USB-C end of the provided cable into the keyboard's USB-C port.
3. Connect the larger USB-A end of the cable into an available USB-A port on your computer.
4. Your operating system will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. The keyboard is plug-and-play and ready for use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The T-Dagger ARENA T-TGK321 is a 60% mechanical keyboard, meaning it has a compact layout without a dedicated number pad, function row, or navigation cluster. Many of these functions are accessed via the **Fn** (Function) key combinations.

4.1 Function (Fn) Key Combinations

The keyboard features two **Fn** keys (Fn1 and Fn2) to access secondary functions printed on the keycaps. Hold down the **Fn** key and press the desired key to activate its secondary function.

Combination	Function
Fn + 1 (!) to 0 (~)	F1 to F10 keys
Fn + - (=)	F11
Fn + = (+)	F12

Combination	Function
Fn + P	Print Screen (PRTSC)
Fn + [({})	Home
Fn +] ({})	End
Fn + ; (:)	Insert
Fn + ' (")	Delete
Fn + , (<)	Page Up (PGUP)
Fn + . (>)	Page Down (PGDN)
Fn + W/A/S/D	Arrow Keys (W=Up, A=Left, S=Down, D=Right)

Note: Some functions may vary slightly depending on your operating system or specific software.

4.2 RGB Lighting Control

The T-TGK321 features 18 pre-set RGB lighting effects with adjustable brightness and speed. You can also customize lighting on a key-by-key basis.

- **Fn + MR:** Cycle through 18 different lighting effects.
- **Fn + ↑ (Up Arrow):** Increase brightness.
- **Fn + ↓ (Down Arrow):** Decrease brightness.
- **Fn + ← (Left Arrow):** Decrease effect speed.
- **Fn + → (Right Arrow):** Increase effect speed.
- **Fn + Esc:** Reset to default lighting settings.

For key-by-key customization, refer to the advanced software (if available) or specific instructions provided by T-Dagger support.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your T-Dagger ARENA T-TGK321 keyboard.

5.1 Cleaning

- Disconnect the keyboard from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a can of compressed air to remove dust and debris from between the keycaps.
- Wipe the keycaps and keyboard surface with a soft, slightly damp, lint-free cloth. Avoid excessive moisture.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents.

5.2 Storage

- Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the keyboard.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Keyboard not responding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the keyboard and the computer. ◦ Try connecting the keyboard to a different USB port on your computer. ◦ Restart your computer. ◦ Test the keyboard on another computer to rule out system-specific issues.
Keys not registering or double-typing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Clean the affected key with compressed air to remove any debris. ◦ Ensure no liquid has spilled on the keyboard. ◦ Update your operating system's drivers.
RGB lighting not working or stuck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Press Fn + ↑ to increase brightness. ◦ Press Fn + MR to cycle through lighting modes. ◦ Press Fn + Esc to reset lighting to default. ◦ Ensure the keyboard is receiving sufficient power from the USB port.
Some Fn key combinations not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure you are pressing the correct Fn key (Fn1 or Fn2) for the desired function. ◦ Some functions may require specific software or operating system settings.
