INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the alpina Smart Home WiFi Camera. This Full HD 1080p outdoor surveillance camera is designed to provide reliable security monitoring with features such as audio and motion detection, and night vision. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your camera to ensure optimal performance.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your alpina Smart Home WiFi Camera.

SETUP

1. Installation

The alpina Smart Home WiFi Camera is designed for wall mounting. Choose a suitable outdoor location that provides the desired surveillance coverage and has access to a power outlet.

1. Mark the drilling points on the wall using the camera's mounting bracket as a template.
2. Drill holes at the marked points.
3. Insert wall plugs (if necessary) into the drilled holes.
4. Secure the mounting bracket to the wall using the provided screws.
5. Attach the camera securely to the mounted bracket.

2. Power Connection

Connect the camera to a power source using the provided power adapter. The camera operates on 5 Volts and consumes 1 Watt of power.

- Plug the small end of the power adapter into the camera's power input port.
- Plug the other end of the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
- Ensure the connection is secure and protected from weather elements if installed outdoors.

3. App Installation and Pairing

The camera connects wirelessly via Wi-Fi and is compatible with smartphones and Amazon Alexa. Download the alpina Smart Home app (or a compatible smart home app) to your smartphone.

1. Download the official alpina Smart Home app from your smartphone's app store (iOS or Android).
2. Create an account or log in if you already have one.
3. Follow the in-app instructions to add a new device. Select your camera model.
4. Ensure your smartphone is connected to the same 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network that the camera will use.
5. The app will guide you through the pairing process, which typically involves scanning a QR code on the camera or listening for an audio prompt.
6. Once paired, you can name your camera and configure its settings.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Live View

Access real-time video footage from your camera through the alpina Smart Home app.

- Open the alpina Smart Home app on your smartphone.
- Select your camera from the device list to view the live feed.
- You can typically zoom, take screenshots, or manually record from this screen.

Motion Detection

The camera features a motion sensor that can detect movement and trigger alerts or recordings.

- In the app, navigate to your camera's settings.
- Find the "Motion Detection" or "Activity Zones" section.
- Enable motion detection and adjust sensitivity levels as needed.

Night Vision

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Camera

- Before cleaning, disconnect the camera from its power source.

- Gently clean the camera lens with a microfiber cloth designed for optics.
- Ensure no moisture enters the camera's internal components.

Firmware Updates

TROUBLESHOOTING

Solution: Clean the camera lens. Ensure there is adequate lighting. Check your internet connection speed, as low bandwidth can affect streaming quality. Adjust video resolution settings in the app if available.

Problem: Night vision not working

Solution: Ensure the camera is in a dark environment for night vision to activate. Check for any obstructions blocking the infrared LEDs. Verify night vision settings in the app.

Problem: Motion detection alerts are too frequent or not triggering

Solution: Adjust the motion detection sensitivity in the app. Define specific activity zones to reduce false alerts. Ensure notifications are enabled on your smartphone and in the app.

Problem: Two-way audio is not working

Solution: Check the microphone and speaker permissions for the app on your smartphone. Ensure the camera's microphone and speaker are not obstructed. Adjust volume settings in the app.
