3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Headphones

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The LED indicator will show the charging status. A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours.
4. Once fully charged, the headphones provide up to 40 hours of playtime.

4.2 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off and fully charged.
2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3-5 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.

4. Select "ZIHNIC PN 9" from the list of devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly.
6. The headphones will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when powered on, if within range (up to 10 meters).

4.3 Wired Connection

You can use the headphones with a wired connection when the battery is low or with non-Bluetooth devices.

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the audio jack on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end to the 3.5mm audio output of your device.
3. In wired mode, Bluetooth and ANC functions may operate differently or be unavailable depending on the headphone's power status.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for 2-3 seconds until the LED indicator lights up.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for 3-5 seconds until the LED indicator turns off.

5.2 Active Noise Cancellation (ANC)

The ANC feature reduces ambient noise, allowing for a more focused listening experience.

1. **Turn ANC On:** Locate the ANC button (often marked with 'ANC' or a similar icon) on the earcup. Press it once to activate ANC. The ANC indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Turn ANC Off:** Press the ANC button again to deactivate ANC. The ANC indicator light will turn off.

5.3 Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function button (often the Power button or a dedicated play/pause button) once.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up button or a dedicated 'Next' button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Down button or a dedicated 'Previous' button.

5.4 Call Management

The built-in microphone allows for hands-free calls.

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- **Voice Assistant:** Double-press the Multi-function button to activate your device's voice assistant (Siri, Google Assistant, etc.).

5.5 Volume Control

- **Volume Up:** Press the Volume Up (+) button.

- **Volume Down:** Press the Volume Down (-) button.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.
- Avoid getting moisture into any openings.

6.2 Storage

- When not in use, store the headphones in their protective carrying case to prevent damage.
- The headphones feature a foldable design for compact storage.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your headphones, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair with device.	Make sure the headphones are in pairing mode (LED flashing blue/red). Turn off and on your device's Bluetooth. Move headphones closer to the device.
No sound.	Check the volume level on both the headphones and your connected device. Ensure the headphones are properly paired or the 3.5mm cable is securely connected.
ANC is not effective.	Ensure the ANC feature is activated (ANC indicator light is on). ANC is most effective against low-frequency, constant noise.
Sound quality is poor.	Ensure the headphones are within Bluetooth range. Try disconnecting and reconnecting. Check the audio source quality.
