

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Initial Placement

- Plug the receiver into a standard electrical socket in a central location where the sound can be easily heard.
- Position the transmitter at a height accessible to your dog, typically near the door they will use to go outside. It can be mounted on a wall, door, or floor using the provided adhesive tape or screws.




This image shows the simple installation process of the transmitter using adhesive tape, with a dog observing.

2. Pairing Transmitters with Receivers

Follow these steps to pair your transmitters with the receivers:

- 1. Plug the receiver into a socket.
- 2. Press the "Forward" or "Backward" button on the receiver to select your desired melody.
- 3. Press and hold the "Volume" button on the receiver for 5 seconds until it makes a "Ding" sound and the receiver indicator flashes.
- 4. Touch the transmitter quickly within 8 seconds after step 3. The receiver will make a "Ding-Ding" sound, and the indicator will flash, confirming successful pairing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Adjusting Volume

The receiver offers five volume levels. To adjust the volume:

• Press the volume button on the side of the receiver to cycle through the available volume levels (0 dB, 65 dB, 85 dB, 100 dB, 110 dB).

• Once you have selected your desired volume, press the transmitter button to confirm the adjusted volume level.

2. Changing Ringtones

You can choose from 55 different ringtones:

- Press the "Forward" or "Backward" button on the receiver to cycle through the available melodies.
- The selected melody will play. Once you find a preferred melody, it will be saved automatically due to the power failure memory function.

3. Training Your Dog

Consistent training is key to success. Here are some tips:

- Place the transmitter near the door your dog uses to go outside.
- Whenever you take your dog out for potty breaks, guide their paw or nose to press the button.
- Immediately open the door and praise your dog when they press the button.
- Repeat this process consistently. Your dog will soon associate pressing the button with going outside.

MAINTENANCE

Replacing the Transmitter Battery

The transmitter uses a 23A battery. To replace it:

- 1. Carefully remove the trigger button from its mounted position on the wall. Handle it gently to avoid damage.
- 2. Using a screwdriver, carefully unscrew the three screws on the back of the trigger button. Set these screws aside for later use.
- 3. Open the back cover of the trigger button. Inside, you'll find the old 23A battery.
- 4. Remove the old battery and replace it with a new one, ensuring the correct polarity.
- 5. Securely close the back cover, ensuring it snaps into place. It's essential to ensure the back cover seals correctly to

- protect the new battery.
- 6. Reinstall the three screws to secure the back cover.
- 7. Once the new battery is installed and the back cover is securely in place, reinstall the trigger button on the wall. Make sure it's firmly mounted.

Cleaning

Wipe the surfaces of the transmitters and receivers with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Receiver lights up but no sound: Check the volume level. Press the volume button on the receiver to increase the sound.
- Transmitter not triggering receiver:
 - Ensure the transmitter battery is not depleted. Replace the battery if necessary (refer to "Replacing the Transmitter Battery" section).
 - Verify that the transmitter and receiver are properly paired (refer to "Pairing Transmitters with Receivers" section).
 - Check the distance between the transmitter and receiver. While designed for a wide range, extreme distances or thick walls can interfere with the signal.
- False triggers: Ensure the transmitter is installed in a location protected from extreme weather conditions if placed outdoors. The product operates reliably between 23°F and 104°F; exceeding this range may cause false triggers.
