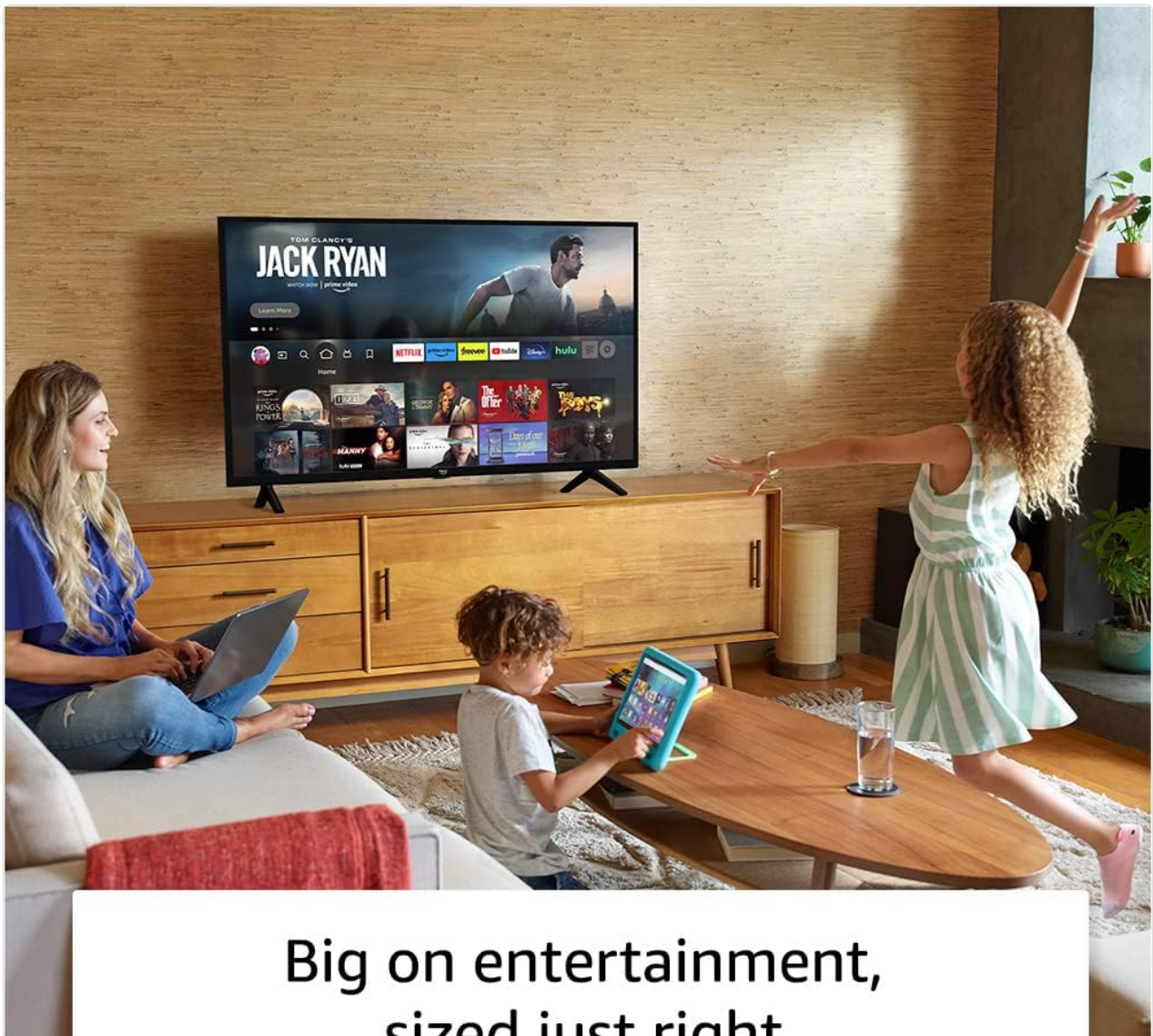
SETUP

1. Attaching the TV Stand

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align each TV leg with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure each leg using the provided 4 screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

2. Connecting Power and Devices

- Connect the power cord to the TV's power input and then to a wall outlet.
- For external devices (e.g., cable box, game console), use the HDMI ports. The TV has 2 standard HDMI 1.4 inputs and 1 HDMI ARC input for audio equipment.
- An Ethernet port is available for wired internet connection.
- A USB 2.0 port is available for connecting compatible USB devices.
- A Digital Optical Audio Port is available for audio output.

3. Initial Setup and Remote Pairing

1. Insert the 2 AAA batteries into the Fire TV Alexa Voice Remote.
2. Turn on the TV. The remote should automatically pair. If not, press and hold the Home button on the remote for 10 seconds until the LED indicator flashes amber.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to connect to your Wi-Fi network, sign in with your Amazon account, and complete the initial setup.

OPERATING YOUR FIRE TV

Navigation and Interface

The Fire TV interface provides quick access to live TV, video games, music, and streaming services. Navigate using the directional pad and select button on your Fire TV Alexa Voice Remote.

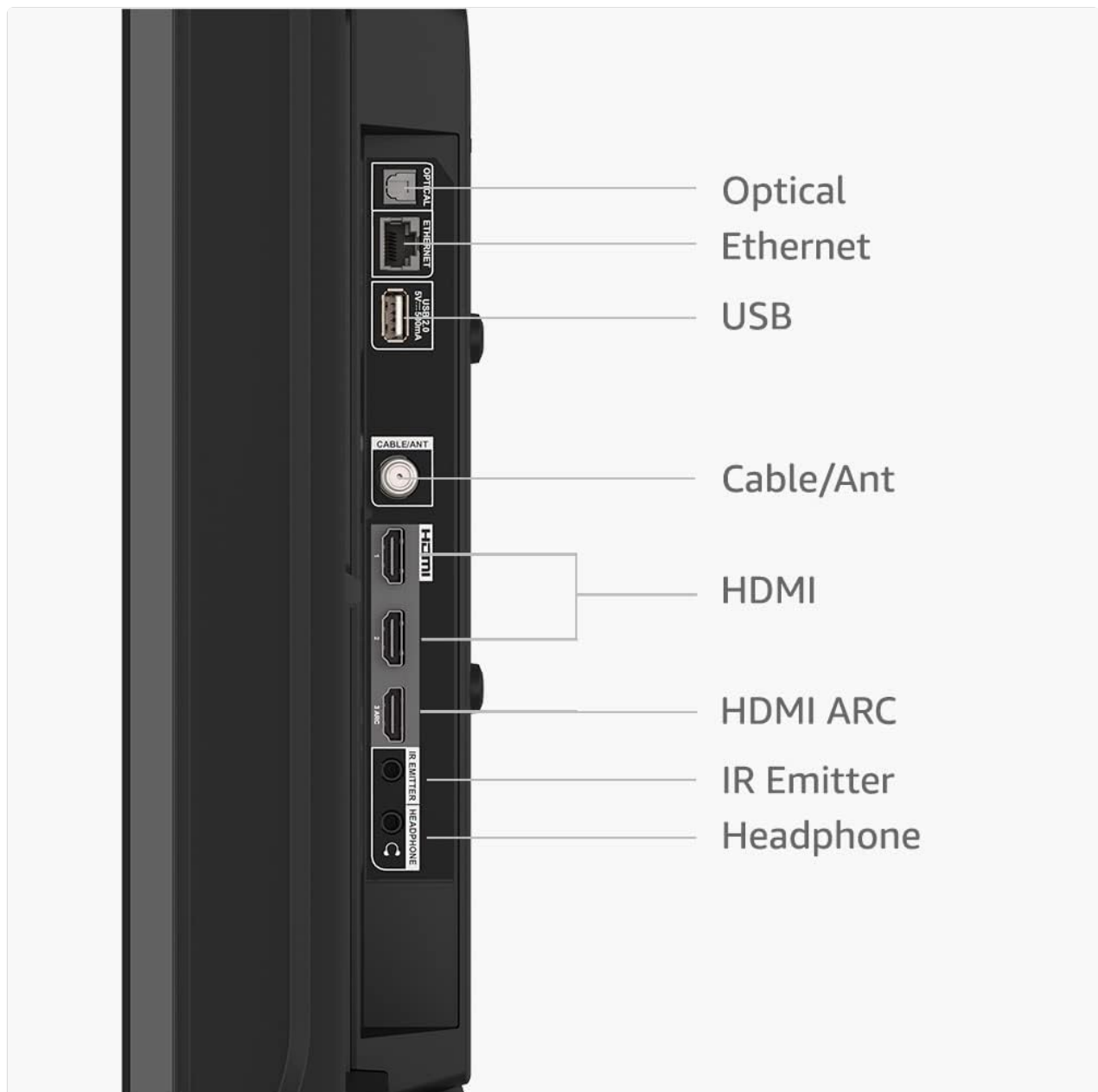


Image: The Fire TV home screen displaying a selection of popular streaming applications.

Alexa Voice Remote

Use the Fire TV Alexa Voice Remote to control your TV with voice commands. Press the microphone button and speak your command to find content, get information, or control smart home devices.

- "Alexa, open Netflix"
- "Alexa, play The Marvelous Mrs. Maisel"
- "Alexa, turn up the volume"

Streaming Content

Stream over 1 million movies and TV episodes with subscriptions to services like Netflix, Prime Video, Disney+, and more. Free content is also available through apps like YouTube, Freevee, and Pluto TV.

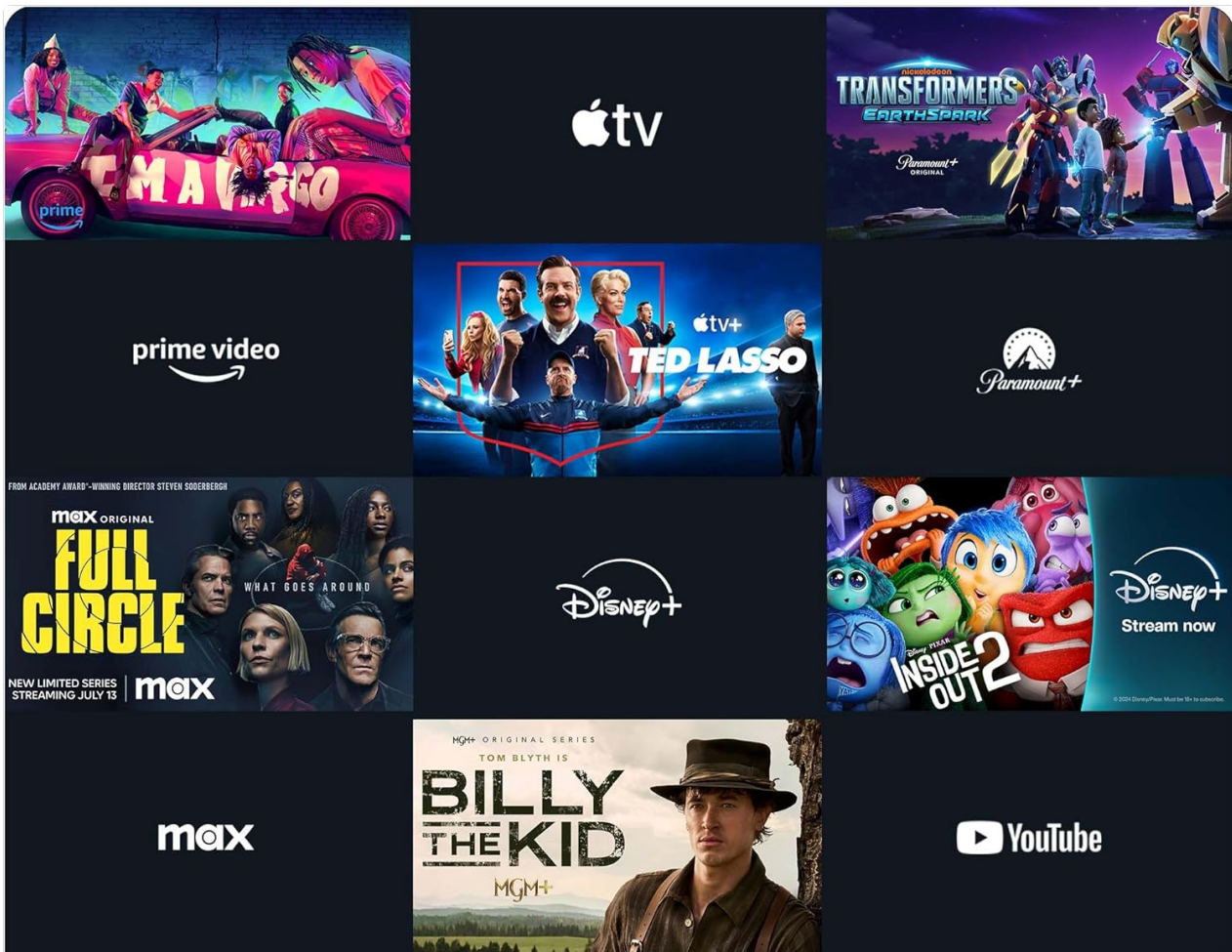

CONNECTIVITY

Your Fire TV offers various connectivity options for a versatile entertainment experience.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your TV

To clean the screen, gently wipe with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

Software Updates

Your Fire TV automatically receives software security updates to ensure optimal performance and security. These updates are guaranteed for at least four years after the device is last available for purchase as a new unit. You can check for updates manually in the TV's settings menu.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify that the correct input source is selected on the TV. Check all HDMI cable connections. For sound issues, ensure volume is not muted and external audio systems are properly connected.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Replace the AAA batteries in the remote. If the issue persists, try re-pairing the remote by holding the Home button for 10 seconds.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues:** Restart your Wi-Fi router and the TV. Ensure the TV is within range of your router. Check Wi-Fi settings on the TV to ensure the correct network is selected and password entered.
- **App Not Working:** Try restarting the app. If that doesn't work, clear the app's cache and data in the TV settings, or uninstall and reinstall the app.


