FEATURES

- **Advanced 3395 Sensor:** Equipped with a top-of-the-line 3395 sensor, offering up to 26000 CPI resolution, 650 IPS tracking speed, and 50G acceleration for precise and responsive tracking.
- **Ultra Custom Style:** Features replaceable magnetic back shells, allowing for personalized aesthetics and easy customization. Includes both solid and honeycomb pink shells, along with a solid black shell.
- **Triple-Mode Connectivity:** Supports three connection methods: 2.4G wireless, Bluetooth 5.0, and wired USB-C connection. Bluetooth mode supports connection to two devices.
- **Long Battery Life:** Integrated 580mAh high-density lithium battery provides up to 61 hours of continuous usage with the backlight off.
- **Programmable Buttons:** Six programmable buttons allow for customization of DPI settings, button functions, RGB lighting modes, and macro settings via dedicated software.

- **Lightweight Design:** Weighs approximately 3.03 ounces for comfortable and agile movement during extended gaming sessions.

SETUP

1. Charging the Mouse

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the mouse. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the mouse's USB-C port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The mouse's indicator light will show charging status.

2. Connecting the Mouse

The RAZEAK Syww 8 mouse offers three connection modes:

Wired Connection:

1. Connect the USB-C end of the provided cable to the mouse.
2. Connect the USB-A end of the cable to an available USB port on your computer.
3. The mouse will be automatically recognized and ready for use. This mode also charges the mouse.

2.4G Wireless Connection:

1. Locate the USB receiver, which is typically stored in a compartment under the removable top shell of the mouse.
2. Insert the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer. For optimal signal, use the provided USB extension receiver to place the receiver closer to the mouse.
3. Turn on the mouse using the power switch located on the bottom of the mouse.
4. The mouse should automatically connect to the receiver.

Bluetooth 5.0 Connection:

1. Turn on the mouse using the power switch.
2. Press and hold the Bluetooth pairing button (refer to the mouse diagram in the manual for exact location, usually on the bottom or side) until the indicator light flashes, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your computer or device, open Bluetooth settings and search for new devices.
4. Select "RAZEAK Syww 8" or a similar name from the list of available devices to pair. The mouse supports two Bluetooth connections (BT1 and BT2), allowing you to switch between two paired devices.
5. Once paired, the indicator light will become solid.

3. Software Installation (Optional)

To unlock the full customization potential of your RAZEAK Syww 8 mouse, including DPI settings, button remapping, RGB lighting effects, and macro programming, download the official software from the RAZEAK website. Follow the on-screen instructions for installation.

OPERATING THE MOUSE

DPI Adjustment

The mouse features adjustable DPI levels to suit different tasks and preferences. You can cycle through default DPI settings using the dedicated DPI button (usually located behind the scroll wheel). The default adjustable DPI levels are 400, 800, 1600, 3200, 5000, and 26000. Each DPI level may correspond to a specific LED color for easy identification.

For advanced DPI customization and to set specific DPI values, use the RAZEAK software.

Button Functions

The mouse has 6 programmable buttons. Their functions can be customized using the RAZEAK software to assign macros, keyboard shortcuts, or other commands.

RGB Lighting

The mouse features customizable RGB lighting. You can switch between different lighting modes or turn the lighting off using a button combination (refer to software or quick start guide for specific combinations) or through the RAZEAK software.

Battery Life Indicator

The mouse is equipped with a 580mAh battery. A full charge provides approximately 61 hours of usage with the RGB lighting turned off. The software or an indicator light on the mouse may provide information on the current battery level.

Built for Playing

Enjoy up to 61-hours of uninterrupted wireless gameplay on a single charge. (PS: when RGB light off)

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean your mouse, use a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the surface of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, ensuring no moisture enters the internal components.

Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the mouse in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure the mouse is turned off to conserve battery life.

Battery Care

To prolong the life of the built-in lithium battery, avoid fully discharging it frequently. Charge the mouse regularly, and if storing for a long time, ensure it has a partial charge (around 50%).

Replacing Mouse Shells

The RAZEAK Syww 8 mouse features magnetically attached top shells for easy replacement. To change a shell:

1. Gently lift the current top shell from the mouse. It is held in place by magnets.
2. Align the new shell with the mouse body and lower it into place. The magnets will secure it.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mouse not responding (Wired)	Loose cable connection; Faulty USB port.	Ensure USB-C cable is securely connected to both mouse and computer. Try a different USB port.
Mouse not responding (2.4G Wireless)	Low battery; USB receiver not connected; Mouse too far from receiver; Interference.	Charge the mouse. Ensure USB receiver is properly inserted. Move mouse closer to receiver. Try a different USB port for the receiver.
Mouse not responding (Bluetooth)	Low battery; Not paired; Bluetooth disabled on device; Interference.	Charge the mouse. Re-pair the mouse with your device. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your computer/device. Reduce distance between mouse and device.
DPI or button functions not changing	Software not installed or configured; Incorrect button press.	Install and configure the RAZEAK software. Ensure you are pressing the correct DPI button. Check software settings for button assignments.
RGB lighting not working	RGB turned off; Software settings; Low battery.	Check if RGB is enabled via software or button combination. Charge the mouse.
Mouse not charging	Faulty cable or port; Mouse not turned on (for some charging methods).	Try a different USB-C cable or USB port. Ensure the mouse is connected in wired mode for charging.
