1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your TracFone Nokia C100 smartphone. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your device's capabilities.

The Nokia C100 is a prepaid smartphone designed for ease of use, featuring a long-lasting battery and powered by Android 12. Key features include face unlock, an 8MP rear camera, and a 5.45-inch HD+ display.

2. GETTING STARTED

2.1. What's in the Box

- TracFone Nokia C100 Smartphone
- Charger
- Charging Cable
- Activation Guide

2.2. Charging the Device

1. Connect the charging cable to the USB-C port on your phone.
2. Plug the other end of the cable into the charger, then plug the charger into a power outlet.
3. Allow the phone to charge completely before first use. A full charge typically takes approximately 4 hours.

2.3. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side of the phone) until the Nokia logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Power off' from the options on the screen.

2.4. Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, the device will guide you through the initial setup process:

1. **Language Selection:** Choose your preferred language.
2. **Wi-Fi Connection:** Connect to a Wi-Fi network for faster setup and software updates.
3. **Google Account:** Sign in with your Google account or create a new one. This is necessary to download apps from the Google Play Store.
4. **Data & Privacy:** Review and accept the terms and conditions.
5. **Security:** Set up a screen lock (PIN, pattern, or password) and Face Unlock for enhanced security.
6. **TracFone Activation:** Follow the instructions in the included Activation Guide to activate your TracFone service. This phone is locked to the TracFone network.

3. BASIC OPERATION

3.1. Navigation

- **Touchscreen:** Tap to select, swipe to scroll, pinch to zoom.
- **Home Screen:** Access your apps and widgets.
- **Notifications:** Swipe down from the top of the screen to view notifications and quick settings.
- **App Drawer:** Swipe up from the bottom of the home screen to access all installed applications.

3.2. Making Calls

1. Tap the **Phone** icon on your home screen.
2. Enter the phone number using the keypad or select a contact.
3. Tap the **Call** button to initiate the call.

3.3. Sending Messages

1. Tap the **Messages** icon.
2. Tap **Start chat** or the '+' icon to compose a new message.
3. Enter the recipient's phone number or select from your contacts.
4. Type your message and tap the **Send** button.

3.4. Connecting to Wi-Fi

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Internet**.
2. Toggle **Wi-Fi On**.
3. Select your desired Wi-Fi network from the list and enter the password if prompted.

3.5. Using the Camera

1. Tap the **Camera** icon.
2. Frame your shot using the screen.
3. Tap the **Shutter** button to take a photo.
4. Switch between front and rear cameras using the camera toggle icon.

3.6. Face Unlock

Face Unlock allows you to unlock your phone using facial recognition.

1. Go to **Settings > Security > Face unlock**.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to register your face.
3. Ensure you are in a well-lit area when registering and using Face Unlock.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

4.1. Cleaning Your Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or aerosol sprays.
- Do not expose the phone to excessive moisture.

4.2. Battery Management

- To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures.
- Close unused apps running in the background.
- Reduce screen brightness and set a shorter screen timeout.
- Use the provided charger and cable for optimal charging.

4.3. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your device has the latest features and security enhancements.

1. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to check for and install updates.

4.4. Storage Management

The phone has 32GB of internal memory, expandable up to 256GB with a microSD card (sold separately).

- To manage storage, go to **Settings > Storage**.
- You can clear cached data, uninstall unused apps, or move files to a microSD card to free up space.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1. Common Issues

- **Device Not Powering On:**
 - Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power

on.

- Press and hold the Power button for at least 10-15 seconds to perform a forced restart.

- **Slow Performance or Apps Crashing:**

- Close unnecessary background applications.
- Clear app caches (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache).
- Ensure you have sufficient free storage space.
- Restart the device.

- **Connectivity Issues (Wi-Fi/Cellular):**

- Toggle Wi-Fi or Cellular Data off and on.
- Restart your phone.
- For Wi-Fi, try forgetting the network and reconnecting.
- Ensure your TracFone service is active and has sufficient balance/data.

- **Camera Not Working:**

- Restart the phone.
- Clear the Camera app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > Camera > Storage & cache).

5.2. Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data from your phone and restore it to its original factory settings. Back up important data before proceeding.

1. Go to **Settings > System > Reset options**.
2. Select **Erase all data (factory reset)**.
3. Confirm your decision and enter your PIN/pattern/password if prompted.

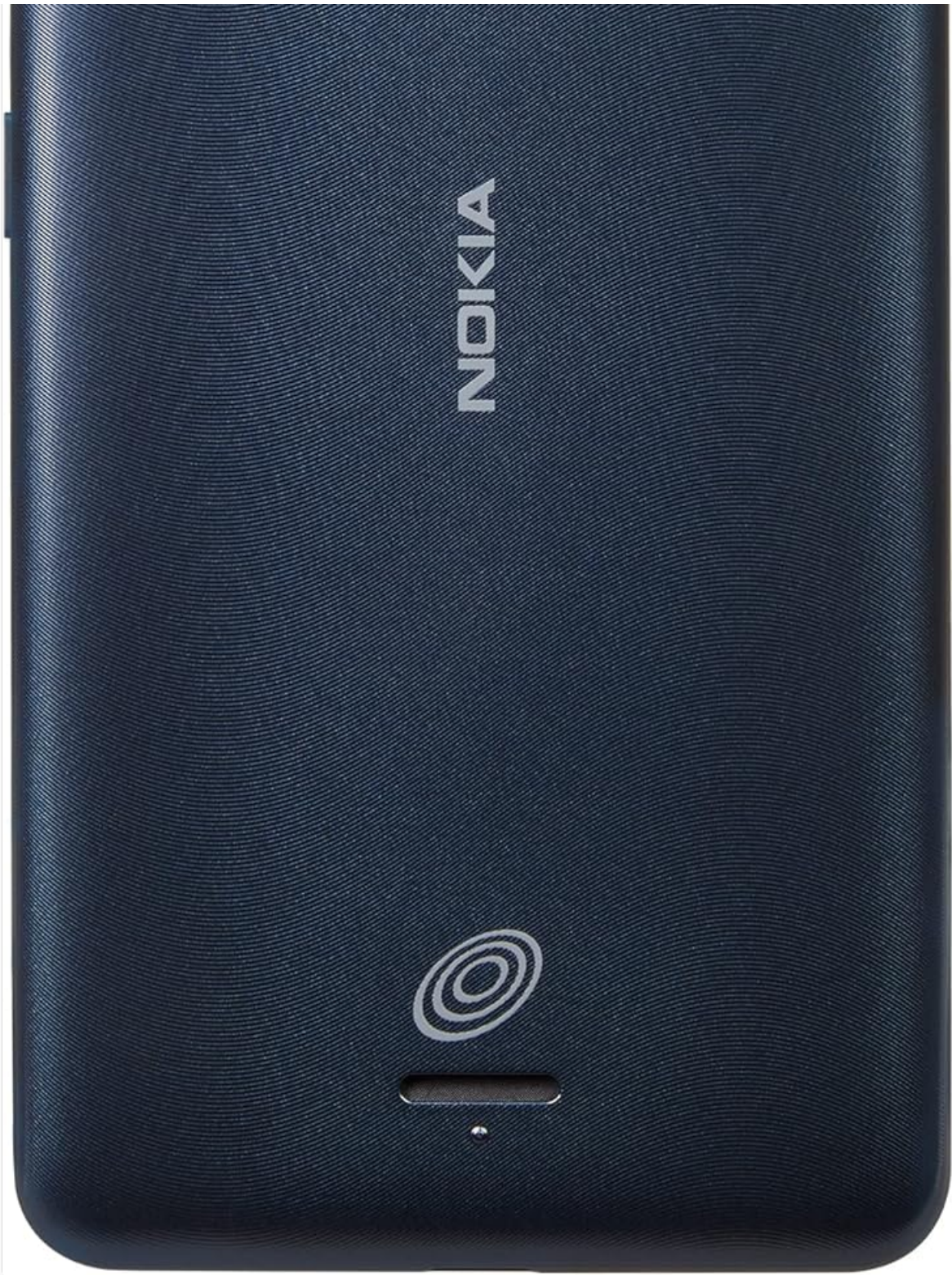


Image 6.1: Back view of the TracFone Nokia C100 smartphone.
