More Accurate GPS

COROS VERTIX 2 can talk to all five major satellite systems (GPS, GLONASS, Galileo, QZSS, and Beidou) at the same time. It even offers Dual Frequency satellite communication.

VERTIX 2 brings huge improvements to GPS plotting when navigating between tall buildings, deep within the forest, or alongside rock walls, overcoming the challenge.

SETUP

Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your COROS VERTIX 2. Connect the provided charging cable to the watch and a USB power source. The watch display will indicate charging status.

Pairing with the COROS App

- 1. Download the COROS app from your device's app store.
- 2. Open the app and create an account or log in.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions in the app to pair your VERTIX 2 watch. This typically involves enabling Bluetooth on your phone and selecting the watch from the list of available devices.
- 4. Once paired, the app will guide you through initial settings and profile setup.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Display and Controls

The COROS VERTIX 2 features a 1.4-inch always-on memory LCD touchscreen and physical buttons for navigation and control. The digital dial allows for easy scrolling through menus and data fields.



GPS and Navigation

The VERTIX 2 supports simultaneous communication with all major satellite systems (GPS, GLONASS, Galileo, QZSS, and Beidou) and features dual-frequency capability for enhanced accuracy in challenging environments. It offers robust on-wrist navigation with offline landscape and topo maps.

Monitor your heart rate 24/7, track sleep patterns, and utilize Heart Rate Variability (HRV) measurements to assess your body's stress levels and recovery status.



Connectivity and Storage

The VERTIX 2 offers 32 GB of onboard storage for data, workouts, routes, and music. It also features Wi-Fi connectivity for faster data transfer and accessory pairing.

The watch can also control Insta360™ action cameras (Insta360 One X2 and OneR) and GoPro devices, allowing for remote photo and video capture.



MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Regularly clean your watch and strap with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. Ensure the charging ports are free of debris.

Water Resistance

The COROS VERTIX 2 is rated for 10 ATM water resistance, meaning it can withstand pressures equivalent to a depth of 50 meters. It is suitable for swimming and showering, but not for high-velocity water sports or deep-sea diving.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Watch Not Turning On/Charging

- Ensure the charging cable is securely connected to both the watch and the power source.
- Try a different USB port or power adapter.
- Clean the charging contacts on the watch and cable.

GPS Inaccuracy

- Ensure you are in an open area with a clear view of the sky.
- Allow the watch sufficient time to acquire a GPS signal before starting an activity.
- Sync your watch with the COROS app regularly to update satellite data.

Connectivity Issues (Bluetooth/Wi-Fi)

- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your smartphone and the watch is within range.
- Restart both your watch and smartphone.
- Forget the device in your phone's Bluetooth settings and re-pair.




