1. INTRODUCTION

The TechniSat HD-S 261 is a compact digital satellite receiver designed for the reception of unencrypted (Free-to-Air) television and radio programs via satellite (DVB-S/S2). This device provides a high-definition viewing experience and includes a range of features to enhance your media consumption.

2. SETUP

2.1 Physical Connections

Before operating the device, ensure all necessary cables are securely connected. Refer to the diagram below for proper connection points.

- **HDMI:** For connecting to a television with an HDMI input for high-definition video and audio.
- **TV SCART:** For connecting to older televisions or video equipment using a SCART cable.
- **S/PDIF (Coaxial):** For connecting to an audio amplifier or home theater system for digital audio output.

2.2 Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, the receiver will guide you through an initial setup process. The device comes with a pre-installed channel list for Astra 19.2 degrees, simplifying the setup for many users. The user interface is designed for ease of use, allowing for quick configuration.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Basic Operation

The TechniSat HD-S 261 can be controlled using the included remote control or the local control buttons located on the top front panel of the device.

3.2 Electronic Program Guide (EPG)

The integrated EPG provides a comprehensive overview of TV and radio programs. You can access program information for up to seven days in advance, allowing you to plan your viewing schedule effectively.

3.3 USB Media Playback

The HD-S 261 features a built-in USB media player. Connect a USB storage device to the USB port to play various media files, including videos, MP3 audio files, and JPEG image files directly on your television.

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the receiver. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation slots on the device are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- **Software Updates:** The device supports software updates via the LAN connection. Periodically check the manufacturer's website for available updates to ensure your receiver has the latest features and bug fixes.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TechniSat HD-S 261, consider the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Check if the power cable is securely connected to the receiver and the power outlet. Ensure the outlet is functional.
- **No Signal:** Verify that the LNB IN cable from your satellite dish is correctly connected. Check your satellite dish alignment if necessary.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Ensure the HDMI or SCART cable connecting the receiver to your TV is properly connected. Confirm your TV input is set to the correct source (e.g., HDMI 1, AV).
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Check the batteries in the remote control and replace them if necessary. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the receiver's IR sensor.
- **Frozen Picture/Unresponsive:** Try restarting the receiver by unplugging it from the power outlet for a few seconds and then plugging it back in.
