1. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section guides you through the initial setup and installation process for Grand Theft Auto V (GTA 5) on your PlayStation 5 console.

1.1 System Requirements

- **Platform:** PlayStation 5
- **Storage:** Minimum 95 GB available space
- **Internet Connection:** Required for updates, online features, and PlayStation Plus subscription for online multiplayer.

1.2 Disc Installation

1. Insert the Grand Theft Auto V game disc into your PlayStation 5 console's disc drive.
2. The console will automatically begin the installation process. Follow any on-screen prompts.
3. Ensure your console is connected to the internet to download any necessary game updates or patches. This may take some time depending on your internet speed.
4. Once installation and updates are complete, the game icon will appear on your PlayStation 5 home screen.

1.3 Digital Download (if applicable)

If you purchased a digital version, download the game from the PlayStation Store. Ensure sufficient storage space and a stable internet connection.

2. OPERATING THE GAME

Learn how to navigate and play Grand Theft Auto V.

2.1 Starting the Game

- Select the Grand Theft Auto V icon from your PlayStation 5 home screen.
- Choose between Story Mode for the single-player campaign or Grand Theft Auto Online for multiplayer experiences.

2.2 Basic Controls (PlayStation 5 DualSense Controller)

Action	Button/Stick
Move Character	Left Analog Stick
Camera Control	Right Analog Stick
Run/Sprint	X (hold to sprint)
Jump/Climb	Square
Enter/Exit Vehicle	Triangle
Shoot/Attack	R2
Aim	L2
Open Weapon Wheel	L1 (hold)
Open Phone	Up D-Pad
Pause Menu	Options Button

2.3 Saving Progress

Grand Theft Auto V features an auto-save system that regularly saves your progress. You can also manually save your game by sleeping in a safehouse bed or using your in-game phone's 'Quick Save' option.

2.4 Grand Theft Auto Online

To access Grand Theft Auto Online, you will need an active PlayStation Plus subscription. GTA Online allows you to explore Los Santos with other players, participate in missions, races, and various activities.

3. MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures optimal performance and longevity of your game.

- **Disc Care:** If using a physical disc, handle it by the edges. Store it in its case when not in use to prevent scratches. Clean with a soft, lint-free cloth if necessary, wiping from the center outwards.
- **Console Updates:** Ensure your PlayStation 5 system software is always up to date. This can improve game compatibility and performance.
- **Game Updates:** Allow the game to download and install all available updates. These often include bug fixes, performance improvements, and new content.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically check your PlayStation 5's storage to ensure sufficient free space. Delete old game data or unused applications if storage becomes low.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their solutions.

4.1 Game Not Launching or Freezing

- **Restart Console:** Fully power off your PlayStation 5, wait 30 seconds, then power it back on.
- **Check Disc:** If using a disc, ensure it is clean and free of scratches.
- **Reinstall Game:** If the issue persists, try deleting the game data from your console and reinstalling it.

4.2 Online Connectivity Issues

- **Check Internet Connection:** Verify your PlayStation 5 is connected to the internet and that your network is functioning correctly.
- **PlayStation Network Status:** Check the official PlayStation Network status page for any service outages.
- **Router Restart:** Restart your internet router/modem.
- **PlayStation Plus:** Ensure your PlayStation Plus subscription is active for GTA Online.

4.3 Graphics or Performance Problems

- **Console Updates:** Ensure your PS5 system software and the game itself are fully updated.
- **Game Settings:** Adjust in-game graphics settings if available, though PS5 versions are optimized.
