SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Connect to Host Device:** Identify the appropriate port on your computer or device. The Mport 60 features a 2-in-1 connector that supports both USB-A and USB-C ports.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device not recognized by computer.	Loose connection, incompatible port, or power issue.	Ensure the hub is firmly connected to your computer's USB-A or USB-C port. Try connecting the hub to a different USB port on your computer. Restart your computer.
Connected USB devices are not working.	Device not properly connected, power issue, or device driver issue.	Ensure USB devices are firmly inserted into the hub's ports. Try connecting the USB device directly to your computer to verify its functionality. If the device requires external power, ensure it is connected.
Ethernet connection is not working.	Loose cable, router/modem issue, or network settings.	Ensure the Ethernet cable is securely connected to both the hub and your router/modem. Check your router/modem for proper operation. Verify network settings on your computer.
Slow data transfer speeds.	Overloaded hub, host port limitations, or cable quality.	Avoid connecting too many high-bandwidth devices simultaneously. Ensure your host device's USB port supports the desired speed. Use high-quality USB cables for connected devices.
